St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview No. 22 St. Norbert College (7-1) at UW-Stevens Point (5-4)
Saturday, December 13, 2014 - 7 p.m.
Berg Gym (1,200) - Stevens Point, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert plays its fifth and final non-conference game against the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference this season when it travels to central Wisconsin to face UW-Stevens Point.

The Series:

UW-Stevens Point leads St. Norbert 13-11 in the all-time series, which began in 1978-79. The last three meetings have come in NCAA Division III Tournament play. The Green Knights claimed a 71-57 win over the Pointers in the on March 7, 2008 at Berg Gym. Stevens Point topped St. Norbert 71-58 in the second round on March 6, 2010 at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere and a 79-69 decision on March 4, 2011 at Berg Gym.

Last Meeting:

UW-Stevens Point defeated St. Norbert 79-69 on March 4, 2011 in the first round of the NCAA Division III Tournament at Berg Gym in Stevens Point. The Pointers led 36-33 at halftime before pulling away in the second half. Erin Baganz led St. Norbert with 19 points, while Krista Pelky added 15 and Jamie Kuhl 14. Stevens Point got 20 points from Britta Petersen, while Cassie Bandow had 15 points and Andrea Flease had six points and dished out 14 assists.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 616-278 in her 38th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 945-475 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 616 wins ranks 10th all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history. Only Elizabethtown's Yvonne Kauffman (42 years, 1971-2002) has spent more time coaching women's basketball at one school.

UW-Stevens Point coach Shirley Egner (UW-La Crosse, 1980) is 479-203 in her 26th season in Stevens Point.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game at 7-1 overall. The Green Knights, ranked No. 22 in the most recent D3hoops.com Top 25 poll, have been idle since a 58-38 win over Grinnell this past Saturday at Schuldes Sports Center in De Pere.

Sophomore guard Brianna Byrne leads the Green Knights in scoring at 12.0 points per game. Sophomore guard Jill Kleiman is the only other St. Norbert player to average in double figures at 10.1 points per game. Senior forward Tasha Giese is averaging 8.9 points and a teamhigh 5.8 rebounds per game. Sophomore center Mallory Nickerson is coming off the bench to average 7.9 points per game. Junior center Heidi Van Sistine is averaging 7.5 points and 4.6 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 64.0 points per game, and is shooting 43.1 percent from the floor, 27.7 percent on 3-pointers and 70.1 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 47.2 points per game while shooting 33.6 percent from the floor, 27.6 percent on 3-pointers and 72.0 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point enters the game 5-4 overall and 2-1 in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The Pointers are coming off a 64-51 home win over UW-Stout on Wednesday.

Junior forward Allie Miceli is leading the Pointers in scoring at 11.8 points per game. Senior forward Kaitlyn Jacobs is averaging 9.8 points and a team-high 7.2 rebounds per game. Junior center Joann Wolfenberg is averaging 8.3 points per game while shooting 59.5 percent from the floor.

Stevens Point is scoring an average of 59.0 points per game, and is shooting 38.6 percent from the floor, 27.0 percent on 3-pointers and 68.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 55.0 points per game while shooting 35.7 percent from the floor, 30.4 percent on 3-pointers and 69.3 percent at the free-throw line.

State School Snippets:

Saturday's game against UW-

Stevens Point will be the 155th time a Connie Tilley-coached team will face a Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference foe.

The Green Knights, who have scheduled all five of their non-conference games against the WIAC this season, are 3-1 so far this year against the league. St. Norbert beat UW-Stout 64-57 on Nov. 15, UW-Superior 76-46 on Nov. 16 and then No. 5-ranked UW-Oshkosh 62-50 on Nov. 29. St. Norbert, which lost 66-53 at UW-Eau Claire on Nov. 25, has at least one win against the WIAC for 12 consecutive seasons.

Under Tilley, the Green Knights are 73-81 all-time against the WIAC. Since the 2005-06 season, the Green Knights are 16-13 against the league.

Tilley Talk:

With a 64-41 win over Lake Forest on Nov. 19, St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley moved into sole possession of 10th place in Division III women's basketball history for career wins with 611.

Tilley, who now has 616 career wins, passed Susan Dunagan for 10th place in career wins. Dunagan, who retired after last season, coached at Roanoke from 1982 to 2014. Johns Hopkins coach Nancy Funk currently has 628 wins to stand in ninth place.

Tilley has wins over 79 different schools, including all nine Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference members. Her most wins against a single opponent have come against Lawrence (63), Ripon (56) and Beloit (52).

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert is 149-4 in its last 153 games when scoring at least 70 points. St. Norbert had a 60-game winning streak when scoring 70 points snapped in a 77-72 loss to Monmouth on Feb. 3, 2012. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 326-23 when scoring at least 70 points.

* - St. Norbert owns an impressive 149-37 record since the start of the 2007-08 season. The Green Knights have won at least 19 games in six of the last seven seasons, with four years with at least 20 wins. The 107 wins from 2008 to 2012 is the best five-year stretch in program history.
