St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview St. Norbert College (11-4, 10-0) vs. Monmouth College (3-12, 2-8) Saturday, January 23, 2016 - 3 p.m. Schuldes Sports Center (2,100) - De Pere, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert hosts Monmouth in its final home game in the month of January. The Green Knights currently lead Cornell by two games in the Midwest Conference standings with eight games remaining.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Monmouth 28-9 in a series begun in the 1986-87 season. The Green Knights have won 21 of the last 26 games in the series.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Monmouth 75-51 on Nov. 28, 2015 at Glennie Gym in Monmouth, Ill. The Green Knights led 40-27 at halftime and pulled away from there. Regan Carmichael led St. Norbert with 15 points and seven rebounds, while Stephanie Weigman added 14 points and Jill Kleiman 10. Katie Houston led the Scots with 19 points and seven rebounds.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 642-285 in her 39th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 970-482 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 642 wins ranks 10th all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history. Only Elizabethtown's Yvonne Kauffman (42 years, 1971-2012) has spent more time coaching women's basketball at one school.

Monmouth coach Kyle Wilson (Hanover, 2005) is 3-12 in his first season in Monmouth.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game with an 11-4 overall record and is unbeaten in the Midwest Conference with a 10-0 slate. The Green Knights, who have won their last four games, are coming off a 62-41 win over Carroll this past Wednesday.

The Green Knights are led in scoring by junior guard Regan Carmichael, who is averaging 11.6 points per game. She is also grabbing a team-high 5.2 rebounds per game. Junior guard Brianna Byrne is averaging 11.1 points per game, while senior guard Stephanie Weigman is averaging 9.9 points per game. Junior guard Jill Kleiman is averaging 7.7 points per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 68.7 points per game, and is shooting 43.0 percent from the floor, 34.3 percent on 3-pointers and 60.7 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 51.5 points per game while shooting 36.8 percent from the floor, 30.9 percent on 3-pointers and 67.8 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Scots:

Monmouth enters the game with a 3-12 overall record and a 2-8 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Scots have won two of their last three games, including a 72-68 road win last Saturday at Ripon. Monmouth also beat Lawrence 68-49 on Jan. 9 and dropped a 59-53 decision to Cornell on Jan. 12.

Senior guard Katie Houston leads the Scots in scoring at 16.2 points per game and is also grabbing a team-high 8.7 rebounds per game. Sophomore guard Kelsey Walsberg is averaging 12.3 points per game, while sophomore forward Tia Robertson is averaging 11.4 points per game.

Monmouth is scoring an average of 62.9 points per game and is shooting 40.4 percent from the floor, 32.4 percent on 3-pointers and 65.8 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 75.3 points per game while shooting 42.8 percent from the floor, 30.4 percent on 3-pointers and 69.7 percent at the free-throw line.

Handle With Care:

St. Norbert has taken 195 more field-goal attempts than its opponents this season thanks to taking good care of the basketball. St. Norbert has just 196 turnovers to its opponents' 309.

The Green Knights are currently third in Division III in fewest turnovers per game at 12.4 per game. St. Norbert is also second in assist-to-turnover ratio at plus-1.38.

UW-Oshkosh is the national leader at 11.7 turnovers per game. Thomas More leads in assist-to-turnover ratio at plus-1.87.

Additionally, junior guard Regan Carmichael is fourth nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio at plus-3.35 and junior guard Jill Kleiman is 23rd at plus-2.32.

Tilley Talk:

With a 64-41 win over Lake Forest on Nov. 19, 2014, St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley moved into sole possession of 10th place in Division III women's basketball history for career wins with 611.

Tilley, who now has 642 career wins, passed Susan Dunagan for 10th place in career wins. Dunagan coached at Roanoke from 1982 to 2014. Johns Hopkins coach Nancy Funk currently has 644 wins to stand in ninth place.

Tilley has wins over 79 different schools, including all eight Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference members. Her most wins against a single opponent have come against Midwest Conference foes Lawrence (66), Ripon (58) and Beloit (55).

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert is 164-4 in its last 168 games when scoring at least 70 points and has a 32-game winning streak when reaching the 70-point plateau. St. Norbert had a 60-game winning streak when scoring 70 points snapped in a 77-72 loss to Monmouth on Feb. 3, 2012. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 336-23 when scoring at least 70 points.

* - St. Norbert owns an impressive 175-44 record since the start of the 2007-08 season. The Green Knights have won at least 19 games in seven of the last eight seasons, with six years with at least 20 wins. The 107 wins from 2008 to 2012 is the best five-year stretch in program history.
