Tournament Overview:

The winner of the Midwest Conference Tournament will receive the league's automatic qualifier into the NCAA Division III Tournament. This is the 11th time in the last 17 seasons St. Norbert has hosted the tournament.

The Series:

- St. Norbert leads Ripon 61-27 in a series started during the 1975-76 season. The Green Knights have won 21 of the last 24 games in the series.
- St. Norbert leads Cornell 18-2 in an all-time series dating back to the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights topped the Rams in the Midwest Conference post-season championship game in 1984, 1986-88 and 2015.
- St. Norbert leads Grinnell 33-0 in an all-time series dating back to the 1992-93 season.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 650-285 in her 39th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 978-482 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 650 wins ranks tied for ninth all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history. Only Elizabethtown's Yvonne Kauffman (42 years, 1971-2012) has spent more time coaching women's basketball at one school.

Ripon coach Lauren Johnson (Clarke, 2008) is 26-43 in her third season in Ripon.

Cornell coach Brent Brase (Cornell College, 1990) is 133-139 in his 11th season in Mount Vernon.

Grinnell coach Dana Harrold (Dubuque, 2004) is 28-41 in her third season in Grinnell.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the tournament with a 19-4 overall record and finished the regular-season in the Midwest Conference unbeaten at 18-0. The Green Knights, who have won 46 of their last 47 games against Midwest Conference opponents, defeated conference runner-up Cornell 61-56 this - MORE -

Junior guard Regan Carmichael is averaging team-highs with 12.2 points and 5.2 rebounds per game. Junior guard Brianna Byrne is averaging 10.8 points per game, while senior guard Stephanie Weigman is averaging 10.5 points and 4.6 rebounds per game. Junior center Mallory Nickerson is averaging 7.8 points and 4.6 rebounds per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 71.0 points per game, and is shooting 44.3 percent from the floor, 34.2 percent on 3-pointers and 63.3 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 51.9 points per game while shooting 36.7 percent from the floor, 27.6 percent on 3-pointers and 69.5 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the tournament 14-9 overall after finishing fourth in the Midwest Conference at 10-8. The Red Hawks won their last three games to get into the tournament, including a 69-57 win over Knox this past Saturday.

Freshman center Maggie Oimoen leads the Red Hawks in scoring at 10.9 points per game. Junior forward Nicole Herkert is averaging 7.9 points and a team-high 6.0 rebounds per game. Junior guard Megan Jensen is averaging 7.6 points per game.

Ripon is scoring an average of 58.3 points per game, and is shooting 40.3 percent from the floor, 30.8 percent on 3-pointers and 66.0 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 57.9 points per game while shooting 34.9 percent from the floor, 27.4 percent on 3-pointers and 64.3 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Rams:

Cornell enters the tournament 19-4 overall after finishing the Midwest Conference schedule 15-3. The Rams had a 13-game winning streak snapped this past Saturday in a 61-56 home loss to St. Norbert.

Junior forward Diamond Boyd leads Cornell with 15.4 points and 8.7 rebounds per game. Senior forward Maggie Hogen is averaging 11.1 points and 8.0 rebounds per game, while senior guard Kellie Kuzmanic is averaging 10.9 points and 7.3 rebounds per game.

Cornell is scoring an average of 66.5 points per game and is shooting 39.4 percent from the floor, 31.3 percent on 3-pointers and 61.7 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 52.7 points per game while shooting 33.3 percent from the floor, 29.5 percent on 3-pointers and 63.4 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Pioneers:

Grinnell enters the tournament with a 15-8 overall record and a 12-6 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Pioneers, making their first tournament appearance since 2004, lost to Illinois College 67-60 this past Saturday.

Senior guard Alissa Hirsh leads the Pioneers in scoring at 14.3 points per game. Sophomore forward Kayla Morrissey is averaging 12.6 points per game, while junior forward Alex Neckopulos is collecting 9.2 points and 10.7 rebounds per game.

Grinnell is scoring an average of 63.3 points per game, and is shooting 39.3 percent from the floor, 28.5 percent on 3-pointers and 64.8 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 61.1 points per game while shooting 38.5 percent from the floor, 25.8 percent on 3-pointers and 70.7 percent at the free-throw line.

Handle With Care:

St. Norbert has taken 244 more field-goal attempts than its opponents this season thanks to taking good care of the basketball. St. Norbert has just 322 turnovers to its opponents' 463.

The Green Knights are currently 13th in Division III in fewest turnovers per game at 14.0 per game. St. Norbert is also fourth nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio at plus-1.25.

Thomas More leads in assist-toturnover ratio at plus-2.04 and fewest turnovers per game at 11.4.

Additionally, junior guard Regan Carmichael is ninth nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio at plus-2.53 and junior guard Jill Kleiman is 36th at plus-2.05.

among NCAA Division III women's basketball coaches. Johns Hopkins coach Nancy Funk currently has 650 wins to match Tilley's total.

Tilley has wins over 79 different schools, including all eight Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference members. Her most wins against a single opponent have come against Midwest Conference foes Lawrence (67), Ripon (59) and Beloit (56).

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert has qualified for the MWC Tournament 17 times in the last 18 years. In the 33 years since joining

the MWC for women's basketball in 1983-84, the Green Knights have qualified for the league's post-season 25 times - a league record.

- * St. Norbert is the first team since Beloit in 1997-98 to finish the MWC regular-season schedule unbeaten. The Buccaneers were 13-0 that season.
- * St. Norbert's scoring defense of 51.9 points per game is 20th in Division III. That mark also leads the Midwest Conference ahead of Cornell's 52.7 points allowed per game.
- * St. Norbert is 168-4 in its last 172 games when scoring at least 70 points and has a 36-game winning streak

when reaching the 70-point plateau. St. Norbert had a 60-game winning streak when scoring 70 points snapped in a 77-72 loss to Monmouth on Feb. 3, 2012. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 340-23 when scoring at least 70 points.

* - St. Norbert owns an impressive 182-44 record since the start of the 2007-08 season. The Green Knights have won at least 19 games in eight of the last nine seasons, with six years with at least 20 wins. The 107 wins from 2008 to 2012 is the best five-year stretch in program history.
