St. Norbert participates in its 13th NCAA Division III Tournament when it plays in the Central Regional at UW-Stevens Point's Berg Gym. The Green Knights open play with a first-round game Friday against defending national runner-up George Fox.

The Series:

St. Norbert has never faced George Fox or DePauw in women's basket-

UW-Stevens Point leads St. Norbert 15-11 in the all-time series, which began in 1978-79. The Pointers have won four of the last five meetings.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 652-285 in her 39th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 980-482 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 652 wins ranks ninth all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history. Only Elizabethtown's Yvonne Kauffman (42 years, 1971-2012) has spent more time coaching women's basketball at one school.

George Fox coach Michael Meek (Eastern Oregon, 1999) is 157-20 in his sixth season in Newburg.

UW-Stevens Point coach Shirley Egner (UW-La Crosse, 1980) is 508-219 in her 27th season in Stevens Point.

DePauw coach Kris Huffman (Northern Iowa, 1990) is 544-113 in her 23rd season in Greencastle.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its 13th NCAA Tournament appearance and is 9-16 all-time in the tournament. The Green Knights placed fourth when they hosted the Final Four in De Pere in 1985, and also advanced to the Sweet 16 in 1986, 1988 and 2003. St. Norbert made its most recent appearance last - MORE -

season, when it lost 72-61 to Luther at St. Thomas.

George Fox is making its 12th NCAA Tournament appearance and is 28-10 all-time in the tournament. The Bruins won the 2009 national championship and finished second in 2012 and 2015.

UW-Stevens Point is making its 11th NCAA Tournament appearance and is 23-9 all-time in the tournament. The Pointers won national titles in 1987 and 2002.

DePauw is making its 17th NCAA Tournament appearance and is 31-14 all-time in the tournament. The Tigers won national championships in 2007 and 2013.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the tournament with a 21-4 overall record. The Green Knights, who have won their last 14 games, clinched the Midwest Conference's automatic berth with a 56-53 win over Cornell this past Saturday in De Pere.

Junior guard Regan Carmichael, a first-team All-MWC selection, is averaging team-highs with 12.2 points and 5.3 rebounds per game. Junior guard Brianna Byrne, a second-team All-MWC honoree, is averaging 10.8 points per game. Senior guard Stephanie Weigman, also a first-team All-MWC pick, is averaging 10.3 points and 4.6 rebounds per game. Junior guard Jill Kleiman, a second-team All-MWC choice, is averaging 7.6 points per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 70.7 points per game, and is shooting 44.2 percent from the floor, 33.9 percent on 3-pointers and 64.1 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 51.7 points per game while shooting 36.3 percent from the floor, 27.5 percent on 3-pointers and 69.6 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Bruins:

George Fox enters the tournament 27-0 overall and ranked No. 2 in the D3hoops.com Top 25. The Bruins won the Northwest Conference Tournament with a 76-57 win over Puget Sound this past

Saturday.

Senior forward Justin Benner leads the Bruins with an average of 17.3 points and 6.7 rebounds per game. Senior guard Sammy Naluai is averaging 11.7 points per game. Sophomore forward Kaitlin Jamieson is averaging 9.7 points and 6.6 rebounds per game, while Junior guard Anjenae Torregano is averaging 8.1 points per game.

George Fox is scoring an average of 75.7 points per game, and is shooting 44.0 percent from the floor, 34.5 percent on 3-pointers and 65.6 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 58.1 points per game while shooting 38.2 percent from the floor, 31.6 percent on 3-pointers and 69.3 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Pointers:

UW-Stevens Point enters the tournament at 20-7 overall and ranked No. 20 in the D3hoops.com Top 25. The Pointers are coming off a 38-21 loss to UW-Oshkosh in the semifinals of the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Tournament last Thursday.

Junior guard Autumn Hennes leads the Pointers in scoring at 11.2 points per game. Junior guard Lauren Anklam is averaging 10.8 points per game, while junior forward Allie Miceli is averaging 10.6 points and a team-high 8.7 rebounds per game.

Stevens Point is scoring an average of 61.4 points per game, and is shooting 39.9 percent from the floor, 30.5 percent on 3-pointers and 69.9 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 54.7 points per game while shooting 38.9 percent from the floor, 26.7 percent on 3-pointers and 65.7 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Tigers:

DePauw enters the tournament 22-6 overall. The Tigers won the North Coast Athletic Conference Tournament with an 83-53 win over Allegheny this past Saturday.

Sophomore guard Emily Budde leads the Tigers in scoring at 13.7 points per game. Freshman guard

Maya Howard is averaging 10.1 points per game. Senior forward Abby Keller is scoring 8.1 points with a team-high 7.3 rebounds per game.

DePauw is scoring an average of 63.1 points per game, and is shooting 41.9 percent from the floor, 31.3 percent on 3-pointers and 72.1 percent at the freethrow line. Opponents are scoring an average of 49.0 points per game while shooting 35.0 percent from the floor, 28.9 percent on 3-pointers and 68.3 percent at the free-throw line.

Handle With Care:

St. Norbert has taken 249 more fieldgoal attempts than its opponents this season thanks to taking good care of the basketball. St. Norbert has just 349 turnovers to its opponents' 489.

The Green Knights are currently 14th in Division III in fewest turnovers per game at 14.0 per game. St. Norbert is also fifth nationally in assist-toturnover ratio at plus-1.24.

Thomas More leads the nation in assist-to-turnover ratio at plus-2.07 and fewest turnovers per game at 11.1.

Additionally, junior guard Regan

Carmichael is eighth nationally in assist-to-turnover ratio at plus-2.59 and junior guard Jill Kleiman is 25th at plus-2.14.

St. Norbert is 15th in Division III in assists per game at 17.4.

Tilley Talk:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley has 652 career wins to sit in ninth place alltime in wins among NCAA Division III women's basketball coaches. Johns Hopkins coach Nancy Funk currently has 650 wins to trail Tilley's total by two.

Tilley has wins over 79 different schools, including all eight Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference members. Her most wins against a single opponent have come against Midwest Conference foes Lawrence (67), Ripon (59) and Beloit (56).

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert is the first team since Beloit in 1997-98 to finish the MWC regular-season schedule unbeaten and then win the conference tournament. The Buccaneers were 13-0 that season.

- * St. Norbert's scoring defense of 51.7 points per game is 20th in Division
- * St. Norbert is 10th nationally in scoring margin at plus-19.0 points per game.
- * The Green Knights are shooting 44.2 percent from the floor this season, which is currently good for the 16thbest mark in Division III.
- * St. Norbert is 169-4 in its last 173 games when scoring at least 70 points and has a 36-game winning streak when reaching the 70-point plateau. St. Norbert had a 60-game winning streak when scoring 70 points snapped in a 77-72 loss to Monmouth on Feb. 3, 2012. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 341-23 when scoring at least 70 points.
- * St. Norbert owns an impressive 184-44 record since the start of the 2007-08 season. The Green Knights have won at least 19 games in eight of the last nine seasons, with seven years with at least 20 wins. The 107 wins from 2008 to 2012 is the best five-year stretch in program history.
