St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview NCAA DIVISION III TOURNAMENT - CENTRAL REGIONAL

Tournament Overview:

St. Norbert participates in its 14th NCAA Division III Tournament when it plays in the Central Regional at the historic Washington University Field House. The Green Knights face Washington in the first round. Wheaton (Ill.) and Rose-Hulman are the other two teams in the regional. Friday's winners meet in the second round on Saturday.

The Series:

Washington leads St. Norbert 1-0 in a series begun in the 2002-03 season. The Bears topped the Green Knights 83-65 in the 2003 NCAA Division III Tournament in a Sweet 16 game played at Hardin-Simmons in Abilene, Texas. Washington led 48-37 at halftime and was powered by Hallie Hutchens' 23 points and 11 rebounds. Jennifer Rudis and Laura Crowley added 13 points apiece. St. Norbert was led by Abbey Johnson, who totaled 19 points and six rebounds. Rachael Dombrowski added 11 points for the Green Knights.

St. Norbert has never faced Wheaton or Rose-Hulman in women's basketball.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 672-291 in her 40th season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 1,000-488 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 672 wins ranks seventh all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history. Only Elizabethtown's Yvonne Kauffman (42 years, 1971-2012) has spent more time coaching women's basketball at one school.

Washington coach Nancy Fahey (Wisconsin, 1981) is 735-132 in her 31st season in St. Louis. Fahey is fourth all-time in wins in NCAA Division III history.

Wheaton coach Kent Madsen (Westmont, 1988) is 147-42 in his seventh season in Wheaton.

Rose-Hulman coach Jon Prevo (Indiana State, 1986) is 146-141 in his 11th season in Terre Haute.

NCAA Tournament Appearances:

St. Norbert is making its 14th NCAA Tournament appearance and is 9-17 all-time in the tournament. The Green Knights placed fourth when they hosted the Final Four in De Pere in 1985, and also advanced to the Sweet 16 in 1986, 1988 and 2003. St. Norbert is making its fourth consecutive NCAA Tournament trip.

Washington is making its 29th NCAA Tournament appearance and is 66-25 all-time in the tournament. The Bears, making their 28th consecutive NCAA Tournament trip, won national championships in 1998, 1999, 2000, 2001 and 2010.

Wheaton is making its 11th NCAA Tournament appearance and is 5-10 all-time in the tournament.

Rose-Hulman is making its first NCAA Tournament appearance.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the NCAA Tournament 20-5 overall. The Green Knights came through the Midwest Conference Tournament as the No. 2 seeding, defeating host Cornell 59-54 in the championship game this past Saturday. St. Norbert has won 18 of its last 19 games.

Senior guard Regan Carmichael is averaging a team-high 12.4 points per game. Senior guard Brianna Byrne is scoring an average of 11.8 points per game. Both Carmichael and Byrne were first-team All-MWC selections. Senior center Mallory Nickerson is averaging 7.2 points per game. Senior guard Jill Kleiman, a second-team All-MWC choice, is averaging 6.9 points per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 64.9 points per game, and is shooting 42.4 percent from the floor, 34.9 percent on 3-pointers and 66.2 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 48.8 points per game while shooting 33.1 percent from the floor, 29.1 percent on 3-pointers and 67.0 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Bears:

Washington enters the NCAA Tournament 23-2 overall. The Bears

won the University Athletic Association title after rallying from nine points down with 47 seconds left to stun Chicago 77-75 this past Saturday.

Sophomore forward Madeline Homoly leads the Bears with averages of 14.1 points and 6.6 rebounds per game. Junior guard Natalie Orr is averaging 10.9 points per game. Senior guard Jenn Dynis is averaging 10.4 points per game, while senior forward Zoe Vernon is averaging 10.2 points per game.

Washington is scoring an average of 77.6 points per game and is shooting 46.3 percent from the floor, 35.0 percent on 3-pointers and 72.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 62.4 points per game while shooting 38.5 percent from the floor, 33.7 percent on 3-pointers and 69.1 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Thunder:

Wheaton enters the NCAA Tournament 23-4 overall. The Thunder won the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin regular-season and tournament championships. Wheaton beat Illinois Wesleyan 66-62 last Saturday in the CCIW Tournament title game.

Senior guard Katie McDaniels leads the Thunder at 19.8 points per game. Junior guard Kelly Lawson is averaging 12.1 points per game. Senior guard Chantal Meacham is averaging 9.0 points per game, while senior guard Ellie Zeller is averaging 7.9 points per game.

Wheaton is scoring an average of 78.0 points per game and is shooting 45.7 percent from the floor, 34.3 percent on 3-pointers and 70.3 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 59.3 points per game while shooting 34.5 percent from the floor, 29.2 percent on 3-pointers and 72.1 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Fightin' Engineers:

Rose-Hulman enters the NCAA 24-3 overall. The Fightin' Engineers won the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference regular-season and tournament titles. Rose-Hulman defeated Transylvania 50-40 this past Saturday to win the

Sophomore forward Ally Bromenschenkel leads Rose-Hulman at 12.7 points and 6.4 rebounds per game. Junior guard Alyzia Dilworth is averaging 8.2 points per game, while senior forward Josie Schmidt is averaging 8.1 points per game.

Rose-Hulman is scoring an average of 60.3 points per game and is shooting 39.4 percent from the floor, 26.6 percent on 3-pointers and 67.7 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 45.7 points per game while shooting 31.1 percent from the floor, 27.8 percent on 3-pointers and 66.3 percent at the free-throw line.

Byrne Bullets:

Senior guard Brianna Byrne enters the game with 1,220 career points after scoring 26 points in this past weekend's Midwest Conference Tournament. Byrne is sixth in career scoring at St. Norbert.

Julie Schill is in fifth place at St. Norbert in career scoring with 1,260 points from 1998 to 2001.

Byrne became just the 15th player in the history of the St. Norbert women's

basketball program to reach the 1,000-point plateau during a 69-47 win over Randolph on Dec. 17.

Defense Discussion:

St. Norbert enters the NCAA Division III Tournament ranked No. 9 nationally in scoring defense at 48.8 points per game.

The Green Knights have allowed more than 58 points just twice this season and have yielded 50 points just three times in their last 15 games.

St. Norbert is also 21st nationally in field-goal percentage defense at 33.1 percent.

The Green Knights face a potent Washington offense that is 14th nationally in scoring offense (77.6 points per game) and fifth in field-goal percentage (46.1).

Tilley Talk:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley has 672 career wins to sit in seventh place all-time in wins among NCAA Division III women's basketball coaches.

Tilley passed Southern Maine's Gary Fifield for the No. 7 spot on the list with a 72-48 win over Monmouth on

Jan. 14. Fifield won 660 games at Southern Maine from 1988-2015.

Tilley has wins over 81 different schools, including all eight Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference members. Her most wins against a single opponent have come against Midwest Conference foes Lawrence (69), Ripon (61) and Beloit (58).

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert is 177-4 in its last 181 games when scoring at least 70 points and has a 43-game winning streak when reaching the 70-point plateau. St. Norbert had a 60-game winning streak when scoring 70 points snapped in a 77-72 loss to Monmouth on Feb. 3, 2012. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 349-23 when scoring at least 70 points.

* - St. Norbert owns an impressive 204-50 record since the start of the 2007-08 season. The Green Knights have won at least 19 games in nine of the last 10 seasons, with eight years with at least 20 wins. The 107 wins from 2008 to 2012 is the best five-year stretch in program history.
