St. Norbert College Green Knights Women's Basketball Preview

St. Norbert College (5-4) at Ripon College (13-5)

Tuesday, January 30, 2018 - 7:30 p.m.
 Willmore Center (1,200) - Ripon, Wisconsin

Game Overview:

St. Norbert heads to Ripon as the Green Knights face the Red Hawks for the only time this season. It is the second game for St. Norbert since returning to play this past Saturday.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Ripon 64-28 in a series started during the 1975-76 season. The Green Knights have won 24 of the last 28 games in the series.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert dispatched Ripon 70-49 on Feb. 24, 2017 in the semifinals of the Midwest Conference Tournament at Small Multi-Sport Center in Mount Vernon, Iowa. The Green Knights led 34-27 at halftime before pulling away with a 10-point third-quarter edge. Regan Carmichael led St. Norbert with 17 points, while Brianna Byrne added 14 points. Eleanore Mueller led the Red Hawks with 13 points, while Nicole Herkert added 11 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 677-296 in her 41st season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 1,005-493 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 676 wins ranks seventh all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history. Only Elizabethtown's Yvonne Kauffman (42 years, 1971-2012) has spent more time coaching women's basketball at one school.

Ripon coach Lauren Johnson (Clarke, 2008) is 56-56 in her fifth season in Ripon.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 5-4 overall. The Green Knights returned to action with a 62-49 loss at Cornell this past Saturday in their first game

Sophomore forward Sarah Wiseman is averaging 13.1 points per game. Sophomore forward Sarah Neumann is averaging 11.0 points and 6.2 rebounds per game. Freshman guard Liz Edinger is averaging 10.1 points and 4.6 assists per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 58.7 points per game, and is shooting 39.7 percent from the floor, 34.8 percent on 3-pointers and 64.7 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 53.9 points per game while shooting 35.8 percent from the floor, 24.8 percent on 3-pointers and 70.4 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the game 13-5 and is 10-1 in the Midwest Conference. The Red Hawks have won eight consecutive games after a 74-49 win at Illinois College this past Saturday.

Junior center Maggie Oimoen leads the Red Hawks with 12.9 points and 7.1 rebounds per game. Senior guard Emma McDonald is averaging 11.8 points and 4.9 rebounds per game, while senior center Eleanore Mueller is averaging 8.9 points and 5.5 rebounds per game.

Ripon is scoring an average of 64.2 points per game and is shooting 40.3 percent from the floor, 34.3 percent on 3-pointers and 58.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 53.6 points per game while shooting 33.3 percent from the floor, 29.3 percent on 3-pointers and 67.8 percent at the free-throw line.

Tilley Talk:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley has 677 career wins to sit in seventh place all-time in wins among NCAA Division III women's basketball coaches.

Tilley passed Southern Maine's Gary Fifield for the No. 7 spot on the list with a 72-48 win over Monmouth on Jan. 14, 2017. Fifield

won 660 games at Southern Maine from 1988-2015.

Tilley trails Elizabethtown's Yvonne Kauffman by 12 games for sixth place on the list. Kauffman went 689-328 in 42 seasons (1971-2012).

Tilley has wins over 81 different schools, including all eight Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference members. Her most wins against a single opponent have come against Midwest Conference foes Lawrence (70), Ripon (61) and Beloit (58).

D is for Defense:

St. Norbert is yielding a stingy 53.9 points per game, the second-best mark in the Midwest Conference. Ripon has the top mark at 53.6 points per game.

The Green Knights held Lawrence to 21 points in a 66-21 win on Dec. 6. That was the lowest point total allowed to a St. Norbert opponent since a 107-21 win over Northland on Nov. 15, 2013.

That total matches the second-lowest allowed in school history. The Green Knights' scoring defense record came in a 100-12 win over Concordia-Wisconsin on Jan. 16, 1981.

Jump Shots:

* - St. Norbert is 179-4 in its last 183 games when scoring at least 70 points and has a 44-game winning streak when reaching the 70-point plateau. St. Norbert had a 60-game winning streak when scoring 70 points snapped in a 77-72 loss to Monmouth on Feb. 3, 2012. Under Connie Tilley, St. Norbert is 351-23 when scoring at least 70 points.

* - St. Norbert owns an impressive 209-55 record since the start of the 2007-08 season. The Green Knights have won at least 19 games in nine of the last 10 seasons, with eight years with at least 20 wins. The 107 wins from 2008 to 2012 is the best five-year stretch in program history.
