Tournament Overview:

The winner of the Midwest Conference Tournament will receive the league's automatic qualifier into the NCAA Division III Tournament. The Green Knights are also making their 27th MWC Tournament/Championship appearance since joining the league in 1983-84, and it is also the last for retiring coach Connie Tilley.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Ripon 66-29 in a series started during the 1975-76 season. The Green Knights have won 26 of the last 31 games in the series.

St. Norbert leads Monmouth 32-11 in a series begun in the 1986-87 season. The Green Knights have won 25 of the last 32 games in the series.

St. Norbert leads Lake Forest 49-23 in a hotly contested series begun in the 1983-84 season. The Green Knights have won 19 of the last 23 games in the series.

Last Meetings:

Ripon topped St. Norbert 67-58 on Jan. 19, 2019 at Willmore Center in Ripon. The game was tied 24-24 at halftime. Sarah Ratajczyk led St. Norbert with 14 points while Macie Zurfluh added 12 points. Shannon Sorbo topped the Red Hawks with 12 points.

Monmouth defeated St. Norbert 68-64 in overtime this past Saturday at Glennie Gym in Monmouth, Ill. Olivia DeCleene led the Green Knights with 18 points, while Liz Edinger added 15 points. Carley Turnbull led the Scots with 26 points.

St. Norbert defeated Lake Forest 70-56 on Jan. 16, 2019 at Mulva Family Fitness & Sports Center in Ripon. The Green Knights outscored the Foresters 28-12 in the fourth quarter. Sarah Ratajczyk had 22 points while Olivia DeCleene added 17 points for St. Norbert. Hannah Hiland led the Foresters with 28 points.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Connie Tilley (UW-La Crosse, 1974) is 693-310 in her 42nd season in De Pere. Combining her softball and volleyball coaching tenures with the Green Knights, Tilley is 1,019-507 at St. Norbert. Tilley's 693 wins is sixth all-time for the most triumphs in NCAA Division III history.

Ripon coach Lauren Busalacchi (Clarke, 2008) is 77-67 in her sixth season in Ripon.

Monmouth coach Kyle Wilson (Hanover, 2005) is 36-60 in his fourth season in Monmouth.

Lake Forest coach Tamlyn Tills (UW-La Crosse, 1982) is 125-135 in her 11th season in Lake Forest.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the tournament with an 11-14 overall record and a 10-7 record in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights tied for fourth place with Knox but had the tiebreaker on the Prairie Fire. St. Norbert is coming off a 68-64 overtime loss at Monmouth this past Saturday.

Junior guard Macie Zurfluh tops the Green Knights in scoring with 13.3 points per game. Senior center Sarah Ratajczyk is averaging 10.4 points and 8.3 rebounds per game and is shooting 67.8 percent from the field. Sophomore guard Olivia DeCleene is averaging 9.6 points per game, while senior guard Christine Olijnyk is averaging 8.8 points per game.

St. Norbert is scoring an average of 62.5 points per game, and is shooting 40.7 percent from the floor, 28.8 percent on 3-pointers and 64.6 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 60.6 points per game while shooting 40.4 percent from the floor, 30.9 percent on 3-pointers and 66.9 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the tournament 17-8 overall and won the Midwest Conference title with a 16-2 mark. The Red Hawks, who have won 14 of their last 15 games, defeated Knox 60-57 in overtime this past Saturday.

Senior center Maggie Oimoen leads the Red Hawks with averages of 14.6 points and 7.7 points per game. Sophomore guard Jesi Nay nets 8.0 points per game, while sophomore forward Natalie Geiger is averaging 7.8 points per game. Junior guard Alyassa Burgess is totaling 6.6 points and 6.1 rebounds per game.

Ripon is scoring an average of 59.6 points per game, and is shooting 41.1 percent from the floor, 28.5 percent on 3-pointers and 60.2 per-

cent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 53.6 points per game while shooting 33.8 percent from the floor, 23.9 percent on 3-pointers and 64.6 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Scots:

Monmouth comes into the tournament with an 18-7 overall record and a 13-5 ledger to finish in second place in Midwest Conference play. The Scots defeated St. Norbert 68-64 in overtime this past Saturday.

Junior guard Becca Gallis is averaging a team-high 17.1 points per game. Sophomore guards Carley Turnbull is averaging 15.8 points per game, while sophomore guard Shayne Smith is netting 15.2 points per game. Freshman guard Kaitlyn Osmulski is averaging 7.0 points per game.

Monmouth is scoring an average of 67.9 points per game and is shooting 44.4 percent from the floor, 35.4 percent on 3-pointers and 69.5 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 60.7 points per game while shooting 38.6 percent from the floor, 32.8 percent on 3-pointers and 62.8 percent at the free-throw line.

About the Foresters:

Lake Forest heads into the tournament 13-12 overall and finished in third place in the Midwest Conference at 12-6. The Foresters defeated Grinnell 72-54 this past Saturday.

Sophomore guard Kelsey Burton leads the Foresters at 14.1 points and 7.2 rebounds per game. Senior forward Hannah Hiland is averaging 13.2 points and 6.5 rebounds per game, while sophomore guard Jaianna Brooks is averaging 9.0 points per game. Junior guard Zaria Sydnor is averaging 8.9 points per game.

Lake Forest is scoring an average of 68.1 points per game, and is shooting 39.8 percent from the floor, 33.9 percent on 3-pointers and 72.6 percent at the free-throw line. Opponents are scoring an average of 66.0 points per game while shooting 38.2 percent from the floor, 28.9 percent on 3-pointers and 67.3 percent at the free-throw line.

The 2018-19 season will be Tilley's 42nd and last with the Green Knights after announcing on Jan. 4 her intention to retire at the end of the season.
