# Game Overview:

St. Norbert will play its final game of the 2008 season when it hosts Illinois College. Admission will be free for the game at Minahan Stadium.

## The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 15-1 series lead over Illinois College. The Green Knights won the first nine meetings in the series before the Blueboys won 41-40 on Nov. 10, 2001 at Jacksonville, Ill. St. Norbert has won the last six meetings and is 8-0 all-time in the series at Minahan Stadium.

## The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 90-16 in his tenth season in De Pere.

Illinois College coach Garrett Campbell (CSU-Fullerton, 1998) is 4-5 in his first season in Jacksonville.

# Last Meeting:

St. Norbert trailed 17-10 at halftime before rallying to beat Illinois College 31-24 at England Field in Jacksonville, Ill. Illinois College led 14-0 after the first quarter before the Green Knights rallied.

A.J. Phillips put up 400 all-purpose yards, including 157 yards rushing on 30 carries and one touchdown. Cody Craig completed 16 of 33 passes for 242 yards.

Joe Reed completed 23 of 48 passes for 363 yards and two touchdowns as the Blueboys put up 430 yards of total offense.

#### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert improved to 6-3 overall and 6-2 in the Midwest Conference with a 42-21 win over Beloit College this past Saturday at Strong Stadium in Beloit. The Green Knights put up 341 yards of total offense on the Buccaneers.

St. Norbert is averaging 373.1 yards per game of total offense, which rates third in the Midwest Conference. Sophomore running back Dante Sims has the team rushing lead with 635 yards in 126 carries with eight touchdowns. Sophomore quarterback Bryan Stoppenbach is the leading passer with 971 yards on 69-for-112 passing with nine touchdowns and four interceptions. Senior wide receiver Jeremy Gezella is the leading receiver with 32 catches for 615 yards and five touchdowns.

Defensively, St. Norbert is allowing 302.9 yards per game, which is fourth in the MWC. The Green Knights are allowing 103.7 yards rushing per game and 199.2 yards passing per game.

#### **About the Blueboys:**

Illinois College enters Saturday's game at 4-5 overall and 4-4 in the Midwest Conference. The Blueboys had won two games in a row prior to suffering a 78-17 loss at home to Monmouth College this past Saturday.

The Blueboys feature the secondbest offense in the Midwest Conference, averaging 404.1 yards per game of total offense. Quarterback Mitch Niekamp has thrown a whopping 400 times this season, completing 231 for 2,739 yards with 29 touchdowns and 16 interceptions. Michael Jennings has set a Midwest Conference record with 91 receptions, which have gone for 1,136 yards and 14 touchdowns. Matt Williamson is the lead ing rusher with 535 yards on 107 carries. Illinois College has just five rushing touchdowns this season.

Illinois College is eighth in the Midwest Conference in total defense, allowing 390.8 yards per game. Opponents are rushing for 206.2 yards per game. The Blueboys are averaging 31.2 points per game while allowing 36.7 points per game.

#### **Record Watch:**

Sophomore quarterback Bryan Stoppenbach has completed 61.6 percent of his passes this season, connecting on 69 of 112 passes. Stoppenbach is within striking distance of the season record for completion percentage, which is currently held by Luke Ott's 62.0 percent success rate set in 2001.

Rob Berger also has an outside change to break his own school record for gross punting average in a season. Berger averaged 39.9 yards per punt as a freshman last season before averaging 38.5 yards per punt this season.

#### Sack Race:

St. Norbert has 20 quarterback sacks this year, the third straight year and the tenth time in 11 years the Green Knights have totaled at least 20 sacks in a season.

The Green Knights have allowed 31 quarterback sacks this season, which matches the most ever given up by a St. Norbert offense according to available records. St. Norbert allowed 31 sacks in 1992 and 30 in 1983.

#### **Quick Hitters**:

\* - Senior running back A.J. Phillips went over 200 career points with a touchdown against Beloit and now has 204 for his collegiate career. Phillips also has 5,567 allpurpose yards for his career.

\* - St. Norbert is averaging 187.9 yards passing per game. The Green Knights have not averaged less than 200 yards passing per game since netting just 142.9 yards per game in 1998.

\* - St. Norbert has scored 335 points this season, and has never scored less than 381 in a season under Jim Purtill.

\* - St. Norbert leads the Midwest Conference in penalties with 73.

\* - St. Norbert opponents are 4for-16 on fourth downs this season, the best since opponents were just 1-for-18 in 1998.
