Game Overview:

St. Norbert begins its quest for its ninth Midwest Conference championship in the last 10 years when it faces Grinnell in both teams' conference opener.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 13-1 lead in the all-time series, which began in 1986. Grinnell's only win in the series came in a 49-28 win in 1998 in De Pere, a year when the Pioneers went 10-0. The Green Knights are 9-0 against Grinnell under Jim Purtill.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 84-14 in his tenth season in De Pere.

Grinnell coach Max Hawsey (Austin, 1996) is 1-0 in his first season in Grinnell.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert beat Grinnell 35-13 last Sept. 8 at Rosenbloom Stadium in Grinnell, Iowa for its ninth consecutive win in the series.

The Green Knights led 28-7 at halftime en route to the win. Cody Craig completed 20 of 33 passes for 234 yards and four touchdowns. Judd O'Connell caught seven passes for 114 yards, while Joe Brogni rushed for 114 yards on 26 carries.

St. Norbert held a 326-188 advantage in total offense.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert lost its season opener to Wartburg College 44-20 this past Saturday in Waverly, Iowa. The Green Knights trailed 23-13 at halftime before the host Knights scored two touchdowns early in the third quarter to pull away.

The Green Knights amassed 229 yards of total offense, with 115 coming on the ground. Todd Sheedy had a team-high 47 yards on four carries, while Rob Berger had 37 yards rushing with a long carry of 39 yards. Berger and Bryan Stoppenbach split the quarterback duties. Stoppenbach was 6-for-11 for 70 yards with one touchdown and one interceptions. Berger was 2-for-8 for 44 yards, one touchdown and two interceptions. Jeremy Gezella caught four passes for 69 yards and two touchdowns.

Defensively, St. Norbert yielded 381 yards including 313 through the air. Wartburg averaged just 1.7 yards per run against St. Norbert, getting 68 yards on 40 carries.

About the Pioneers:

Grinnell won its season opener for the first time since 2005, beating former Midwest Conference rival Cornell 26-25 at Cornell.

Freshman do-everything quarterback Mike Bogard completed 18 of 29 passes for 181 yards, rushed for 114 yards on 17 carries and also made all four of his field-goal attempts in his first collegiate game. Grinnell totaled 355 yards of total offense, including 174 yards rushing. Joey Snyder caught seven passes for 69 yards.

Defensively, the Pioneers allowed 313 yards to Cornell with 245 coming on the ground. Brett Maloney and Ryan Boehm had 11 tackles apiece against the Rams.

Big Return:

Scott Wuensch returned a fumble 95 yards for a touchdown just prior to halftime in last Saturday's 44-20 loss to Wartburg.

The scoop and run turned out to be a St. Norbert record for longest fumble return. Ryan Glor returned a fumble 72 yards for a touchdown against Knox on Sept. 30, 1995.

During Jim Purtill's nine-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 48 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Despite Wuensch's touchdown, St. Norbert fell to 23-1 under Purtill when scoring a defensive touchdown.

Stable Signalcallers:

Bryan Stoppenbach's start at quarterback against Wartburg made him just the fifth player to start at the position in the 10-year coaching tenure of Jim Purtill.

Tim Pierret started all 11 games in 1999, posting a 9-2 mark. Luke Ott started every game in 2000 and 2001, going 18-3. Ryan Hartman started for each game from 2002 to 2004, posting a 29-4 mark. Cody Craig was also a three-year starter, going 28-4 from 2005 to 2007.

Dating all the way back to the 1991 season, the Green Knights have started just eight different quarterbacks in those 17 seasons. Steve Stratton started 35 games from 1991 to 1994, Bill Bierowski eight games from 1992 to 1995 and Dan Luedtke 19 games from 1994 to 1997.

Only two starts have been missed at the quarterback position in that stretch due to injury.

Streak Stuff:

St. Norbert began Jim Purtill's tenure in Midwest Conference play with 25 consecutive league wins, losing the 2001 season finale. Following an 8-1 league season in 2002, St. Norbert reeled off 19 straight league wins before losing to Monmouth 28-20 on Sept. 17, 2005 in De Pere.

Since the loss to Monmouth, St. Norbert has won 25 consecutive league games, with the Green Knights going a solid 44-1 in league play from 2003 to the present.

St. Norbert's league-record 26game conference winning streak started in the 1997 finale and went to the penultimate regular-season game in 2001.

In 23 years in the Midwest Conference, St. Norbert has won 12 football championships.
