#### **Game Overview:**

St. Norbert looks to continue its Midwest Conference-record 27-game conference winning streak when it hosts Lake Forest College at Minahan Stadium.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 22-2 lead in the all-time series, which began in 1984. St. Norbert had won 15 straight games in the series before the Foresters shocked St. Norbert 17-0 in the 2002 season finale at Minahan Stadium. The Foresters' only other win in the series came in 1986.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 86-14 in his tenth season in De Pere.

Lake Forest coach Brent Becker (Knox, 1998) is 15-18 in his fourth season in Lake Forest.

#### **Last Meeting:**

St. Norbert beat Lake Forest 36-6 last Sept. 22 in Lake Forest, Ill. The Foresters jumped out to a 6-0 lead before the Green Knights tallied 36 unanswered points.

Cody Craig completed 20 of 34 passes for 246 yards and two touchdowns, while Judd O'Connell caught eight passes for 119 yards and one score. The Green Knights had 424 yards of total offense.

Lake Forest was held to 149 yards of total offense.

#### **About the Green Knights:**

St. Norbert won a record 27th consecutive Midwest Conference game with a 44-18 win over Lawrence this past Saturday in Appleton.

Senior wide receiver Jeremy Gezella was named Midwest Conference Offensive Player of the Week after catching six passes for 176 yards and two touchdowns. Sophomore quarterback Bryan Stoppenbach completed 14 of 18 passes for 214 yards and two touchdowns. Sophomore running back Dante Sims rushed 17 times for 104 yards. The Green Knights posted 490 yards of total offense.

Senior running back A.J. Phillips leads St. Norbert with 197 yards rushing on 45 carries. Stoppenbach is the leading passer, completing 67.5 percent of his passes for 343 yards and four touchdowns. Gezella has 14 catches for 288 yards and five touchdowns.

Defensively, St. Norbert is allowing 37 yards rushing per game and an average of 1.2 yards per carry. The Green Knights are eighth against the run in Division III.

#### **About the Foresters:**

Lake Forest enters the St. Norbert game with a 1-2 overall record and a 1-1 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Foresters picked up their first win of the season this past Saturday with a 28-23 win over Illinois College.

Brock Stenberg is Lake Forest's leading rusher with 234 yards on 53 attempts and one touchdown. Geoff Sobey has completed 32 of 55 passes for 321 yards with two touchdowns and five interceptions. Will Christensen is the leading receiver with 16 catches for 108 yards and one touchdown.

Lake Forest is averaging 281.3 yards of total offense per game, including 115.7 yards per game rushing. Defensively, the Foresters are yielding 285.7 yards per game including 138.7 on the ground.

#### First 100 Games:

St. Norbert head coach Jim Purtill has completed the first 100 games of his coaching tenure, posting an 86-14 mark. The Green Knights are also 79-3 in Midwest Conference games under Purtill.

In the previous 100 games prior to Purtill's arrival, St. Norbert was 53-47. The Green Knights went 6-1 in the last seven games of 1988 and 8-3 in 1989, and then were 39-43 from 1990 to 1998.

#### **Two Points:**

Sophomore defensive back Ernest James scored St. Norbert's first defensive extra point in 11 years against Lawrence.

Jon Herger blocked Lawrence's point-after try and the ball caromed right to James at the 10-yard line. James sprinted untouched 90 yards into the end zone for the two points.

James' deuce was the Green Knights' first since Jason Joanis returned a defensive extra point against UW-Oshkosh in 1997.

#### **Quick Hitters:**

- \* Senior running back A.J. Phillips needs 69 yards to reach 5,000 all-purpose yards for his career. He currently has 4,931.
- \* Twelve different players have caught passes and five different players have thrown a pass so far this season.
- \* St. Norbert has allowed 16 sacks this season, the most in the Midwest Conference.
