Game Overview:

The stakes are high as St. Norbert carries a 29-game conference winning streak into this Saturday's Midwest Conference game with Monmouth College. The Green Knights are shooting for their ninth Midwest Conference championship in the last 10 seasons. St. Norbert brings the nation's top scoring offense against a Monmouth defense that is leading the country in total defense.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 19-3 series lead over Monmouth in a series that began in 1975. St. Norbert is 10-1 all-time at home in the series. The Green Knights have won 10 of the last 11 games in the series, the lone blemish a 28-20 Monmouth win on Sept. 17, 2005 at Minahan Stadium.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 88-14 in his tenth season in De Pere.

Monmouth coach Steve Bell (Bemidji State, 1991) is 62-24 in his ninth season in Monmouth.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert beat Monmouth 42-28 last Oct. 6 at Bobby Woll Memorial Field in Monmouth, Ill. The game was tied 21-21 early in the third quarter before the Green Knights scored three straight touchdowns to put the game away.

St. Norbert's Cody Craig passed for a career-high 349 yards in the game, completing 24 of 40 passes with two touchdowns. A.J. Phillips caught eight passes for 103 yards and one touchdown. Chris Manlick also returned an interception 100 yards for a touchdown in the first quarter.

Monmouth was paced by thenfreshman quarterback Alex Tanney, who threw 56 passes and completed 30 for a career-high 405 yards and three touchdowns.

St. Norbert outgained Monmouth 479-478 in total offense.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert extended its record with its 29th consecutive Midwest Conference win with a 62-24 defeat of Knox College in Galesburg, Ill.

The Green Knights are averaging 402 yards of total offense per game. Sophomore quarterback Rob Berger leads the team in rushing and passing yardage. Berger has 332 yards rushing on just 23 carries, an average of 14.4 yards per carry, and is second in the conference in rushing yardage. Berger is 28-for-52 passing for 516 yards with five touchdowns and a rating of 161.24.

Senior wide receiver Jeremy Gezella leads the Green Knights in receiving with 18 catches for 361 yards and five touchdowns.

Defensively, St. Norbert is allowing 256.2 yards per game. The Green Knights are yielding 47.4 yards per game and 1.3 yards per carry on the ground.

About the Fighting Scots:

Monmouth enters play this weekend at 5-0 overall and 4-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Scots are coming off a 69-0 shellacking of Grinnell last weekend. Monmouth also beat current IIAC co-leader Loras 24-17 on the road opening weekend.

The Scots' offense runs through sophomore quarterback Alex Tanney. Tanney has completed 70.7 percent (123-for-174) of his passes this season for 1,324 yards with 21 touchdowns against three interceptions. Kyle Wantland has caught 30 passes for 331 yards and three touchdowns, while Noah Roseland leads the team in rushing with 282 yards on 77 attempts.

Opponents are averaging just 175.6 yards of total offense per game against the Monmouth defense, which leads the NCAA Division III. Marc Artozqui is the leading tackler with 41, while Anthony Goranson has 11.5 tacklesfor-loss and eight quarterback sacks.

Monmouth is outscoring its opponents 232-42 this season, including 100-3 in the second half.

Awesome Octobers:

The month of October usually brings change, but not much has changed during the tenth month of the year as far as St. Norbert football is concerned.

Since Jim Purtill took over the reins of the Green Knights in 1999, St. Norbert boasts a remarkable 40-0 record in the month of October. The Green Knights are 20-0 at Minahan Stadium in October under Purtill.

The Green Knights have won five games in October five times under Purtill, turning the trick in 1999, 2004 and 2005.

St. Norbert owns a 41-game overall winning streak in the month dating back to a 49-28 loss to Grinnell on Oct. 24, 1998 at Minahan Stadium.

Quick Strikes:

Both St. Norbert and Monmouth enjoy scoring points, and quickly.

This game will feature two of the nation's top four scoring offenses in Division III football. St. Norbert enters the game leading the NCAA Division in scoring offense at 48.8 points per game. Monmouth is fourth nationally in scoring at 46.4 points per game.

Through its first five games this year, St. Norbert has scored 30 offensive touchdowns. A total of 18 of those drives were completed in 2 minutes of possession or less. Six of St. Norbert's nine touchdowns against Knox came on drives of 1 minute 49 seconds or less.

Monmouth has scored 31 offensive touchdowns this season and also has had 18 scoring possessions of 2 minutes or less. The Scots scored nine touchdowns against Grinnell with seven of those coming in 1:49 or less. Four drives were completed in 49 seconds or less.

With a Purpose:

Senior running back A.J. Phillips topped a big milestone against Lake Forest on Sept. 27 when he went over the 5,000-yard mark for career all-purpose yardage.

Phillips has totaled 888 all-purpose yards this year to give him 5,341 career all-purpose yards. Phillips is averaging 177.6 all-purpose yards per game this season and currently rates 15th nationally in all-purpose yardage. Phillips averaged 189.5 yards per game as a junior in 2007.

Phillips' 38-yard punt return for a touchdown against Lake Forest was the first kick return for a score of his career.

Nifty Fifty:

Since head coach Jim Purtill arrived on the St. Norbert campus in 1999, the Green Knights have scored over 50 points in a game 25 times in his 102game coaching stint. In the 557 football games St. Norbert played prior to Purtill's arrival, the Green Knights scored at least 50 points in a game just 12 times.

The Green Knights scored over 50 points against Grinnell (55), Lake Forest (62) and Knox (63) this season. The Green Knights are averaging 48.8 points per game this season to lead the NCAA Division III. The Lake Forest and Knox games marked the first time in school history the Green Knights have scored at least 60 points in consecutive games.

St. Norbert has scored no fewer than 381 points in any of Jim Purtill's nine seasons. Prior to his arrival in 1999, St. Norbert's 289 points in 1989 was the most it had ever scored on one season.

St. Norbert has won 50 straight games when scoring at least 30 points dating back to a 41-40 loss to Illinois College on Nov. 10, 2001. St. Norbert is 160-10 all-time when scoring 30-ormore points and is 97-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is looking for its tenth consecutive season with at least eight wins. Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just twice - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 378-261-20 in 75 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .589. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league best record of 137-27, a winning percentage of .835.

Under Purtill's tenure, St. Norbert began Midwest Conference play with 25 consecutive league wins, losing the 2001 season finale. Following an 8-1 league season in 2002, St. Norbert reeled off 19 straight league wins before losing to Monmouth 28-20 on Sept. 17, 2005 in De Pere.

Since the loss to Monmouth, St. Norbert has won 29 consecutive league games, with the Green Knights going a solid 48-1 in league play from 2003 to the present.

The Green Knights have also won 29 consecutive road games in Midwest Conference action dating back to a 41-40 loss to Illinois College on Nov. 10, 2001.

In 23 years in the Midwest Conference, St. Norbert has won 12 football championships. In addition to St. Norbert, only four charter members of the MWC have won at least 10 football championships - Coe with 21, Ripon with 19, Lawrence with 16 and Cornell with 12.
