Game Overview:

St. Norbert looks to get back on track this week when Carroll University invades Minahan Stadium. The Green Knights must win out in the regular season ensure their tenth-consecutive eight-win season.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Carroll 21-8 in the all-time series, which began in 1935, with the 21 wins the second-most for the Green Knights against an opponent trailing the 23 all-time wins against Lake Forest. The Green Knights are 12-3 in the series since Carroll joined the Midwest Conference in 1992. St. Norbert has won 11 consecutive games in the series, starting in 1996.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 88-15 in his tenth season in De Pere.

Carroll coach Henny Hiemenz (Ithaca, 1999) is 13-13 in his third season in Waukesha.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert escaped Carroll with a 26-24 win last Oct. 13 at Schneider Stadium in Waukesha. The Green Knights' Steve Kraft intercepted a pass in St. Norbert territory inside two minutes remaining to preserve the victory.

Carroll outgained St. Norbert 347-273 in total offense. Cody Craig completed 19 of 33 passes for 179 yards with three touchdowns and two interceptions, while A.J. Phillips had 85 yards rushing on 21 carries.

Carroll's Bryce Crocker had 115 yards on 16 carries as the Pioneers held the ball for nearly 38 minutes. Chris Rogers completed 19 of 34 passes for 137 yards.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert had its record of 29 consecutive Midwest Conference wins snapped with a 31-22 loss to Monmouth at Minahan Stadium.

The Green Knights are averaging 401.7 yards of total offense per game. Sophomore quarterback Rob Berger leads the team in rushing and passing yardage. Berger has 417 yards rushing on just 37 carries. Berger is 35-for-76 passing for 629 yards and five touchdowns. Sophomore quarterback Bryan Stoppenbach has completed 39 of 62 passes for 481 yards and five touchdowns.

Senior wide receiver Jeremy Gezella leads the Green Knights in receiving with 22 catches for 431 yards and five touchdowns.

Defensively, St. Norbert is allowing 279.0 yards per game. The Green Knights are yielding 50.2 yards per game and 1.4 yards per carry on the ground.

About the Pioneers:

Carroll enters the game with a 4-2 overall record and a 3-2 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Pioneers beat Illinois College 42-12 this past Saturday after losses of 41-20 to Monmouth and 28-10 to Ripon.

Carroll's offense is averaging 379.0 yards per game. Joe Beckstrand leads the Pioneers in rushing with 359 yards on 73 carries, and rushed for a school-record 265 yards against Illinois College last week. Chris Casper leads Carroll through the air with 1,070, completing 93 of 168 passes with five touchdowns and 10 interceptions. Matt Cain has 24 receptions for 237 yards, while Mike Rubo has 21 receptions for 347 yards.

Defensively, Carroll is allowing just 245.0 yards per game including 90.4 yards per game on the ground. Opponents are averaging a 27 percent conversion rate on third-down opportunities.

Happy Homecomings:

St. Norbert's Homecomings have typically given alumni a cause to celebrate, with the Green Knights going 49-23-1 in the Fall Classics.

The Green Knights have enjoyed great Homecoming success since joining the Midwest Conference for football in 1984, going 21-3. St. Norbert has won 16 of its last 17 Homecoming contests. Since 1984, St. Norbert has beaten Ripon for Homecoming on six different occasions. The only MWC schools to spoil Homecoming was the Univ. of Chicago in 1985 (7-6 loss), Beloit in 1990 (16-10 loss) and Grinnell in 1998 (49-28 loss).

St. Norbert head coach Jim Purtill is 9-0 on Homecoming.

Two Points:

Prior to this season, St. Norbert had gone since 1997 without scoring a defensive extra point. This season the Green Knights have two, both by sophomore defensive back Ernest James.

James scored his second deuce of the season when he returned a blocked extra point against Monmouth about 90 yards. James also returned a defensive extra point in a similar fashion this season against Lawrence.

James is just the third player in NCAA Division III history to have two successful defensive extrapoint returns in the same season. Dan Fichter of Brockport State in 1990 and Shontez Jones of Greenville in 2000 both had two defensive extra points in the same year.

Quick Hitters:

- * Senior running back A.J. Phillips needs two points to reach 200 for his collegiate career. Phillips also has 5,499 all-purpose yards for his career.
- * St. Norbert is averaging 185.8 yards passing per game. The Green Knights have not averaged less than 200 yards passing per game since netting just 142.9 yards per game in 1998.
