Game Overview:

St. Norbert opens Midwest Conference play with a road trip to the Hawkeye State to face Grinnell College. The Green Knights are coming off a 42-35 overtime win at home over No. 17-ranked Wartburg College.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 14-1 lead in the all-time series, which began in 1986. Grinnell's only win in the series came in a 49-28 win in 1998 in De Pere, a year when the Pioneers went 10-0. The Green Knights are 10-0 against Grinnell under Jim Purtill.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 92-16 in his 11th season in De Pere.

Grinnell coach Max Hawsey (Austin, 1996) is 3-8 in his second season in Grinnell.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert topped Grinnell 55-7 last Sept. 13 at Minahan Stadium in De Pere. The Pioneers opened the scoring on a 12-yard touchdown pass from Mike Bogard to Robert Seer, but the Green Knights ended taking a 35-7 halftime lead.

St. Norbert outgained Grinnell 379-188, with Grinnell getting a minus-11 yards on the ground. Rob Berger rushed seven times for 138 yards and one touchdown and also passed for 75 yards on 6 of 10 passing. St. Norbert had

Bogard led Grinnell with 13 of 32 passing for 163 yards with one touchdown and three interceptions.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert got its 2009 season off to a solid start with a 42-35 overtime win over No. 17-ranked Wartburg College at Minahan Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights tied the game on the final play of regulation on Rob Berger's 8-yard touchdown pass to Jeremy Gezella. Berger's 7-yard scoring strike to John Weninger in overtime proved to be the difference.

The St. Norbert offense rolled up 527 yards of total offense in the win, including 210 yards rushing. Berger ended up with a school-record 443 yards of total offense, completing 28 of 37 passes for 317 yards and four touchdowns while also rushing 16 times for 126 yards and two touchdowns. Gezella hauled in 12 catches for 179 yards and two touchdowns.

Defensively, St. Norbert allowed 506 yards of total offense but forced four second-half Wartburg punts and then turned away the Knights on a first-and-goal from the St. Norbert 6 in overtime. Justin Baker finished with a team-high nine tackles, including a stop on fourthand-goal from the 2 to end the game.

About the Pioneers:

Grinnell opened its season with a 28-21 home loss to Cornell College, which went winless in 2008. The Pioneers led 14-9 at halftime before the Rams rallied with three second-half touchdowns.

Grinnell posted 287 yards of total offense against Cornell, with 105 coming on the ground. Mike Bogard completed 15 of 36 passes for 182 yards with two touchdowns and three interceptions. Bogard also led the Pioneers on the ground with 46 yards rushing on 14 attempts. Robert Seer had a team-high four receptions for 99 yards with two touchdowns.

Grinnell's defense allowed 383 yards with 193 on the ground.

Cornell had 22 first downs against Grinnell, with 13 via rushing.

Record Report I:

St. Norbert junior quarterback Rob Berger enjoyed a record-setting afternoon with his performance in a 42-35 overtime win over Wartburg this past Saturday.

Berger set a school record with 443 yards of total offense, gaining 317 yards passing and 126 yards rushing. Berger's mark clipped th previous record of 440 set by Dan Luedtke on Sept. 21, 1996 against Monmouth. He is the first player in St. Norbert history to pass for 300 yards and rush for 100 yards in the same game.

Berger's 28 pass completions also set a school record, topping Luke Ott's 27 completions against Hamline on Sept. 8, 2001. Berger completed just 40 passes in parttime duty during the entire 2008 season.

Berger's 75.7 percent completion percentage (28-for-37) in the game is the ninth-best in a game in school history.

Record Report II:

Senior wide receiver Jeremy Gezella tied a St. Norbert record with 12 receptions in the win over Wartburg.

It's the fifth time in school history a St. Norbert player has had 12 receptions in a game, but Gezella's feat marks the first time in 16 years it's happened. Current wide receivers coach Todd Bierowski had 12 receptions against UW-Oshkosh on Sept. 11, 1993.

Gezella's 179 receiving yards are his career high, topping 176 yards against Lawrence last season.

Offense Observations:

St. Norbert piled up 527 yards of total offense against Wartburg. The Green Knights passed for 317 yards and rushed for 210 yards on 70 plays, an average of 7.5 yards per play.

The yardage marked the highest offensive output for St. Norbert against a non-Midwest Conference opponent in 41 years. The Green

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is shooting for its 11th consecutive season with at least seven wins. Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just three times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005 and a 7-3 campaign in 2008.

The Green Knights have an alltime record of 382-263-20 in 75 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .589. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league best record of 140-29, a winning percentage of .829.

In 24 years in the Midwest Conference, St. Norbert has won 12 football championships. In addition to St. Norbert, only four charter members of the MWC have won at least 10 football championships -Coe with 21, Ripon with 19, Lawrence with 16 and Cornell with 12.

Quick Hitters:

* - Eight different players caught passes in St. Norbert's 42-35 overtime win over Wartburg this past Saturday.

* - Only three players - Rob Berger, John Weninger and Todd Sheedy - had rushing attempts against Wartburg.

* - During Jim Purtill's 10-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 52 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 25-1 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game seven different times.

* - St. Norbert has won 53 straight games when scoring at least 30 points dating back to a 41-40 loss to Illinois College on Nov. 10, 2001. St. Norbert is 163-10 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 100-2 all-time when scoring 40-ormore points.
