Game Overview:

St. Norbert College looks to remain unbeaten in 2009 when it hosts winless Knox College in a Midwest Conference game at Minahan Stadium.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 13-2 series lead over Knox. The Green Knights have won the last 10 meetings with the Prairie Fire, with Knox's last win coming in a 21-19 triumph in 1998 in Galesburg, Ill.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 95-16 in his 11th season in De Pere.

Knox coach Andy Gibbons (Culver-Stockton, 1990) is 47-84 in his 14th season in Galesburg.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert routed Knox 63-24 last Oct. 4 at the Knosher Bowl in Galesburg, Ill. The Green Knights scored touchdowns on nine of their first 12 possessions and led 35-10 at halftime.

Rob Berger rushed for 123 yards and four touchdowns on just five carries and completed 7 of 13 passes for 114 yards and one touchdown. St. Norbert rushed for 288 yards in the game and outgained Knox 479-305 in total offense.

Bill Meyer completed 13 of 25 passes for 151 yards and two touchdowns with one interception to lead Knox.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert improved to 4-0 overall and 3-0 in the Midwest Conference with a 35-14 win over Lake Forest College this past Saturday. The Green Knights have won 34 of their last 36 Midwest Conference games dating back to the 2005 season.

St. Norbert averages 385 yards of total offense per game. Junior quarterback Rob Berger leads St. Norbert in passing, completing 64 of 108 passes for 824 yards with eight touchdowns and three interceptions. Junior running back John Weninger leads St. Norbert on the ground with 298 yards rushing on 67 attempts with four touchdowns. Senior wide receiver Jeremy Gezella has hauled in 24 receptions for 410 yards and five touchdowns.

Opponents are averaging 308.5 yards per game of total offense. Junior linebacker Justin Baker leads St. Norbert defensively with a team-high 30 tackles. Junior linebacker Drew Oudenhoven has 25 tackles. Sophomore defensive lineman John Troyer has a team high three sacks.

About the Prairie Fire:

Knox enters the St. Norbert game with an 0-4 overall record and an 0-3 ledger in the Midwest Conference. The Prairie Fire was doused by Beloit 42-14 at home this past Saturday and lost its last road game 47-0 at Ripon on Sept. 19.

Knox is averaging 265.8 yards per game of total offense, with 191.2 yards per game coming via its option offense. Derek Mortensen leads the Prairie Fire in rushing with 178 yards on 36 carries with two touchdowns. Bill Meyer has 144 yards rushing on 68 carries and has competed 25 of 57 passes for 298 yards and two touchdowns

with four interceptions. Derek LaRosa is the leading receiver with seven catches for 89 yards.

Opponents are averaging 445.5 yards per game against the Knox defense, including 201 yards rushing per game.

Special Teams Rarity:

St. Norbert recorded a rare blocked field goal returned for a touchdown in last Saturday's 35-14 win over Lake Forest.

Dan Sjoquist blocked Lake Forest kicker Tim Gruzwalski's 37-yard field goal attempt, with the loose ball picked up by Justin Baker who ran 67 yards on the return for a touchdown.

St. Norbert had not returned a blocked field goal for a touchdown since Jason Leigl returned one 55 yards for a touchdown in a 70-13 win over Illinois College in 1997. Available records indicate no blocked field goal returns for touchdowns in school history prior to Leigl's.

In Jim Purtill's 11 seasons, St. Norbert has returned six blocked kicks for touchdowns, including five punts. The Green Knights last blocked a punt for a touchdown in a 49-0 win over Illinois College in 2006.

Nearing a Milestone:

St. Norbert head coach Jim Purtill is two wins shy of becoming the winningest football coach in school history.

Howard "Chick" Kolstad currently has the most win in St. Norbert gridiron coaching history, posting a 96-75-5 record in 19 seasons from 1960-78. St. Norbert operated as an independent in athletics during Kolstad's tenure, with the Green Knights defeating the likes of Western Illinois, Northern

Michigan, Mankato State, Ferris State, Hillsdale, St. Cloud State and several Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference members.

Purtill has fashioned a 95-16 overall record going into the Knox game, good for an .856 winning percentage. The Green Knights have captured eight Midwest Conference championships in his first 10 seasons and have appeared in seven NCAA Division III Playoffs.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is shooting for its 11th consecutive season with at least seven wins. Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as seven games just three times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005 and a 7-3 campaign in 2008.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 385-263-20 in 76 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .591. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league best record of 142-29, a winning percentage of .830.

In 24 years in the Midwest Conference, St. Norbert has won 12 football championships. In addition to St. Norbert, only four charter members of the MWC have won at least 10 football championships - Coe with 21, Ripon with 19, Lawrence with 16 and Cornell with 12.

Quick Hitters:

- * During Jim Purtill's 11-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 54 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 26-1 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game seven different times.
- * St. Norbert has won 55 straight games when scoring at least 30 points dating back to a 41-40 loss to Illinois College on Nov. 10, 2001. St. Norbert is 165-10 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 101-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
