Game Overview:

The stakes are high as St. Norbert College travels to west central Illinois to face No. 12-ranked Monmouth College. The Green Knights, winners of eight of the last 10 Midwest Conference championships, face the team that has won the other two league titles in that stretch. The game is also Monmouth's Homecoming.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 19-4 series lead over Monmouth in a series that began in 1975. The Green Knights have won 10 of the last 12 games in the series, but the two teams have split the last four meetings. St. Norbert has won the last five meetings at Monmouth dating back to 1998.

Due to the new schedule rotation, the 2010 St. Norbert-Monmouth game is scheduled for Oct. 2, 2010 in Monmouth, Ill.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 96-16 in his 11th season in De Pere.

Monmouth coach Steve Bell (Bemidji State, 1991) is 73-25 in his tenth season in Monmouth.

Last Meeting:

Monmouth beat St. Norbert 31-22 last Oct. 11 at Minahan Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights led 10-0 at the end of the first quarter and 15-13 at halftime before the Scots rallied for the win in the second half.

St. Norbert outgained Monmouth 400 to 393 in total offensive yardage, and the Green Knights picked up 243 yards rushing. Monmouth had 64 rushing yards but had a 329-yard passing day from Alex Tanney, who completed 28 of 43 passes for four touchdowns with one interception. The Scots also converted 12 of 19 third-down opportunities.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert improved to 5-0 overall and 4-0 in the Midwest Conference following a 56-13 rout of Knox College this past Saturday. The Green Knights have won 35 of their last 37 Midwest Conference games dating back to the 2005 season.

St. Norbert is averaging 398.2 yards of total offense per game. Junior quarterback Rob Berger leads St. Norbert in passing, completing 76 of 120 passes for 989 yards with 11 touchdowns and three interceptions. Junior running back John Weninger leads St. Norbert on the ground with 331 yards rushing on 76 attempts with five touchdowns. Senior wide receiver Jeremy Gezella has hauled in 29 receptions for 512 yards and six touchdowns.

Opponents are averaging 294.4 yards per game of total offense. Junior linebacker Justin Baker leads St. Norbert defensively with a team-high 36 tackles. Junior linebacker Drew Oudenhoven has 32 tackles. Sophomore defensive lineman John Troyer has a team-high three quarterback sacks.

About the Fighting Scots:

Monmouth enters the game ranked 12th in this week's D3football.com and AFCA Division III polls. The Scots are 5-0 overall and

4-0 in the Midwest Conference, and have won their last 16 league games.

Junior quarterback Alex Tanney leads Monmouth's no-huddle attack averaging 50.6 points and 512.6 yards of total offense per game. Tanney has 136 of 193 (70.5 percent) of his passes for 1,525 yards and 18 touchdown with one interception. Caleb Pratt is the leading rusher with 465 yards on 82 carries with five touchdowns. Matt Shepherd has caught 39 passes for 397 yards and four touchdowns, while Mike Blodgett has 32 catches for 389 yards and three touchdowns.

Monmouth has allowed just six points in four conference games this season and 26 overall on the year. Opponents are averaging 198 yards per game, including just 51.2 yards on the ground.

Perfection:

St. Norbert junior quarterback Rob Berger is coming off the best passing day percentage-wise in the history of the program following his performance this past Saturday against Knox.

Berger was 12-for-12 for 165 yards and three touchdowns in playing just over a half in the 56-13 win over the Prairie Fire. Berger's 100 percent completion rate marked the first time in school history a quarterback attempted more than 10 passes in a game and completed them all.

Dan Novotny completed 19 of 21 passes for 237 yards and four touchdowns in a 49-8 win over Lake Forest College on Oct. 8, 1988 for the previous best completion percentage in a game of 90.4.

The next closest percentage was when Ryan Hartman completed 24 of 29 passes (82.7 percent) against Carroll in 2003.

Earlier this season, Berger enjoyed a record-setting afternoon with his performance in a 42-35 overtime win over Wartburg on Sept. 5 at Minahan Stadium.

Berger set a school record with 443 yards of total offense, gaining 317 yards passing and 126 yards rushing. Berger's mark clipped th previous record of 440 set by Dan Luedtke on Sept. 21, 1996 against Monmouth. He became the first player in St. Norbert history to pass for 300 yards and rush for 100 yards in the same game.

Berger's 75.7 percent completion percentage (28-for-37) in the game was the ninth-best in a game in school history at the time.'

Berger completed just 40 passes during the entire 2008 season.

Battling It Out:

St. Norbert and Monmouth have met eight times when the two schools have both finished in the top two in the Midwest Conference standings. St. Norbert is 7-1 in those games.

St. Norbert topped Monmouth three straight times from 1987-89 in the Midwest Conference Championship game, when the conference had 12 teams and had divisional play. The Green Knights won 20-15 in 1987, 12-0 in 1988 and 17-6 in 1989.

The Green Knights and Scots wouldn't meet again with an eventual title on the line until 2003, when St. Norbert again prevailed 38-15 in De Pere. The following year St. Norbert went to Monmouth and won 55-19. Those two losses were the Scots only MWC setbacks those two seasons.

Monmouth broke through in 2005 with a 28-20 win at Minahan Stadium. The Scots had to travel to De Pere again in 2006 due to a scheduling quirk with St. Norbert winning 48-0. St. Norbert then topped Monmouth 42-28 at Monmouth in 2007 on its way to a 10-0 regular season.

Monmouth did beat St. Norbert 31-22 in De Pere last season, but the Green Knights finished third in the Midwest Conference standings.

Points A Plenty:

Both the St. Norbert and Monmouth offenses have displayed the ability over the last several seasons to score points, and 2009 is proving to be no exception.

Monmouth and St. Norbert are 1-2 in the Midwest Conference in scoring offense at 50.6 and 38.4 points per game, respectively. Monmouth's scoring offense is second in this week's NCAA Division III statistical rankings, just behind Wabash's 50.8 points per game. St. Norbert's scoring offense is 21st nationally.

Monmouth leads Division III in turnover margin at plus-3.4 per game and pass efficiency defense at 72.10 efficiency rating. The Scots are second in total offense at 512.6 yards per game and third in scoring defense at 5.2 points per game.

St. Norbert sophomore Logan Krueger is 15th in kickoff returns at 20.3 yards per returns.

Monmouth quarterback Alex Tanney is 15th in pass efficiency with a 166.58 rating and is 16th in total offense at 300.6 yards per game.

Nearing a Milestone:

St. Norbert head coach Jim Purtill is one win shy of becoming the winningest football coach in school history.

Howard "Chick" Kolstad currently has the most win in St. Norbert gridiron coaching history, posting a 96-75-5 record in 19 seasons from 1960-78. St. Norbert operated as an independent in

athletics during Kolstad's tenure, with the Green Knights defeating the likes of Western Illinois, Northern Michigan, Mankato State, Ferris State, Hillsdale, St. Cloud State and several Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference members.

Purtill has fashioned a 96-16 overall record going into the Monmouth game, good for an .857 winning percentage. The Green Knights have captured eight Midwest Conference championships in his first 10 seasons and have appeared in seven NCAA Division III Playoffs.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is shooting for its 11th consecutive season with at least seven wins. Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as seven games just three times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005 and a 7-3 campaign in 2008.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 386-263-20 in 76 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .592. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league best record of 143-29, a winning percentage of .831.

In 24 years in the Midwest Conference, St. Norbert has won 12 football championships. In addition to St. Norbert, only four charter members of the MWC have won at least 10 football championships - Coe with 21, Ripon with 19, Lawrence with 16 and Cornell with 12.

Ouick Hitters:

- * St. Norbert is facing its second ranked team of the 2009 season. The Green Knights topped then 17th-ranked Wartburg 42-35 in overtime on Sept. 5 at Minahan Stadium in De Pere.
- * St. Norbert is outscoring its opponents 106-37 in the first half, while Monmouth is outscoring its opponents 193-10 in the first half.
- * Monmouth is the most penalized team in the Midwest Conference this season at 62.6 penalty yards per game. St. Norbert has drawn the most opponent penalties this season with 41.
- * St. Norbert is a total plus-2 on the season in turnovers, while Monmouth is a whopping plus-18. The Scots have forced 12 opponent fumbles and have recovered 11.
- * During Jim Purtill's 11-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 54 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 26-1 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game seven different times.
- * St. Norbert has won 56 straight games when scoring at least 30 points dating back to a 41-40 loss to Illinois College on Nov. 10, 2001. St. Norbert is 166-10 all-time when scoring 30-ormore points and is 102-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
