#### Game Overview:

St. Norbert and Ripon engage in a battle for second place in the Midwest Conference standings this Saturday at Minahan Stadium in De Pere. The game is also St. Norbert's annual Homecoming affair.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert owns a 19-10 lead over Ripon in a hotly contested series that dates back to 1979. St. Norbert had won the last nine games in the series before the Red Hawks claimed a 19-7 win in Ripon last season.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 97-17 in his 11th season in De Pere.

Ripon coach Ron Ernst (Nebraska Wesleyan, 1980) is 123-59 in his 19th season in Ripon.

#### Last Meeting:

Ripon topped St. Norbert 19-7 last Oct. 25 at Ingalls Field in Ripon in a game that lasted just 2 hours 22 minutes. The Green Knights scored their lone touchdown on a 47-yard touchdown pass from Bryan Stoppenbach to Brian Peterson in the first quarter. St. Norbert would not score again as it lost four turnovers.

Ripon held possession of the ball for almost 39 minutes and rushed for 348 yards on 68 attempts. The Red Hawks outgained the Green Knights 454-309 in total offense.

#### **About the Green Knights:**

St. Norbert improved to 6-1 overall and 5-1 in the Midwest Conference with a 28-20 win over Carroll University this past Saturday in Waukesha. The Green Knights rallied from a 20-0 halftime deficit to post the win.

St. Norbert is averaging 395.6 yards of total offense per game. Junior quarterback Rob Berger leads St. Norbert in passing, completing 113 of 184 passes for 1,396 yards with 13 touchdowns and five interceptions. Junior running back John Weninger leads St. Norbert on the ground with 496 yards rushing on 112 attempts with eight touchdowns. Senior wide receiver Jeremy Gezella has hauled in 44 receptions for 752 yards and eight touchdowns.

Opponents are averaging 334.7 yards per game of total offense. Junior linebacker Drew Oudenhoven has a team-high 48 tackles. Junior linebacker Justin Baker has 46 tackles, while senior defensive back Dustin Gresen has 42 tackles. Sophomore defensive back Dan Sjoquist has a team-high four passes defensed, and sophomore defensive lineman John Troyer has three quarterback sacks.

#### **About the Red Hawks:**

Ripon enters the St. Norbert game with a 5-2 overall record and a 5-1 mark in the MWC. The Red Hawks dropped last week's game to Monmouth 35-13 at Ripon. Ripon also lost on Sept. 5 to UW-Oshkosh 40-16.

Ripon is among the national leaders in rushing offense at 257.4 yards per game. T.J. Pierce leads the Red Hawks with 668 yards on 128 carries with four touchdowns, while Matthew Miller has 488 yards on 105 attempts with seven touchdowns. Miller is Ripon's leading passer, completing 49 of 102 passes for 556 yards with four touchdowns and two interceptions. Craig Bednarek is the leading receiver with 18 receptions for 285 yards and four touchdowns. The Red Hawks are averaging 341.6 yards per game of total offense.

Defensively, Ripon is allowing 284 yards per game of total offense, and is yielding just 93.6 yards rushing per game. Ryan Anderson is the leading tackler with 73 and has 9 1/2 tackles for loss this season.

#### **Happy Homecomings:**

St. Norbert's Homecomings have typically given alumni a cause to celebrate, with the Green Knights going 50-24-1 in the Fall Classics.

The Green Knights have enjoyed great Homecoming success since joining the Midwest Conference for football in 1984, going 22-3. St. Norbert has won 17 of its last 18 Homecoming contests. Since 1984, St. Norbert has beaten Ripon for Homecoming on six different occasions. The only MWC schools to spoil Homecoming was the Univ. of Chicago in 1985 (7-6 loss), Beloit in 1990 (16-10 loss) and Grinnell in 1998 (49-28 loss).

St. Norbert head coach Jim Purtill is 10-0 on Homecoming.

#### **Minahan Memories:**

This Saturday's game could likely be the next-to-last game in the 71-year-old Minahan Stadium, with the new Schneider Stadium pegged for a September 2010 opening on De Pere's west side.

St. Norbert has played 297 games in the facility, starting with a 28-6 win over St. John's (Minn.) on Sept. 24, 1938. The stadium was formally dedicated in a 9-0 win over South Dakota State on Oct. 7, 1938 with NFL Hall of Famer Curly Lambeau the halftime speaker.

The Green Knights are 199-91-7 (.682 winning percentage) all-time at Minahan Stadium, and are 49-6 there all-time under Jim Purtill.

#### Nifty Fifty:

St. Norbert senior wide receiver Jeremy Gezella is six receptions shy of reaching the 50-catch plateau for the 2009 season. Gezella enters the Ripon game with 44 receptions for 752 yards.

If Gezella were to reach the 50-reception mark, he would have just the eighth such season in school history and only the fourth since

1989. Judd O'Connell caught 65 passes in 2007 and T.J. George had 52 receptions in 2004.

Gezella needs 248 yards to have a 1,000-yard receiving season. Only four such seasons have occurred in school history, with O'Connell setting a school record with 1,216 receiving yards in 2006.

#### Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is shooting for its 11th consecutive season with at least seven wins. Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as seven games just three times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005 and a 7-3 campaign in 2008.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 387-264-20 in 76 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .592. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league best record of 144-30, a winning percentage of .828.

In 24 years in the Midwest Conference, St. Norbert has won 12 football championships. In addition to St. Norbert, only four charter members of the MWC have won at least 10 football championships - Coe with 21, Ripon with 19, Lawrence with 16 and Cornell with 12.

#### **Quick Hitters:**

- \* During Jim Purtill's 11-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 54 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 26-1 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game seven different times.
- \* St. Norbert has won 56 straight games when scoring at least 30 points dating back to a 41-40 loss to Illinois College on Nov. 10, 2001. St. Norbert is 166-10 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 102-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
