Game Overview:

St. Norbert enters Saturday's game with Lake Forest needing a win to claim the outright Midwest Conference championship and a berth into the NCAA Division III Playoffs.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 24-2 lead in the all-time series, which began in 1984. St. Norbert had won 15 straight games in the series before the Foresters shocked St. Norbert 17-0 in the 2002 season finale at Minahan Stadium, and the Green Knights have won seven straight since. The Foresters' only other win in the series came in 1986.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 106-20 in his 12th season in De Pere.

Lake Forest coach Jim Catanzaro (Greenville, 2000) is 4-15 in his second season in Lake Forest.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert beat Lake Forest 35-14 on Sept. 26, 2009 at Farwell Field in Lake Forest, Ill. The Green Knights scored three second-quarter touchdowns to build a 28-6 halftime lead.

Rob Berger completed 11 of 19 passes for 112 yards with one touchdown with two interceptions. John Weninger rushed 15 times for 65 yards and one touchdown, while Berger added 46 yards on eight carries with one

 369-332 in total offense. Geoff Sobey
 completed 19 of 34 passes for 183
 yards and one interception. Brock
 Stenberg rushed 12 times for 113
 yards and one touchdown. Chris
 Carter caught 10 passes for 127
 yards and one score.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert improved to 6-3 over-
 all and 6-2 in the Midwest
 Conference with a 37-13 romp over
 Ripon this past Saturday. The Green
 Knights clinched a share of its 13th
 Midwest Conference championship
 in 26 years with the win, and can
 advance to the NCAA Division III
 playoffs for the ninth time along
 with an outright MWC title with a
 win this week.

Senior quarterback Rob Berger
 has completed 124 of 207 passes
 (59.9 percent) for 1,805 yards with
 22 touchdowns against 10 intercep-
 tions. Berger also has 537 rushing
 yards on 85 carries with six touch-
 downs.

Senior running back John
 Weninger leads the team in rushing
 with 768 yards on 187 carries with
 10 touchdowns. Weninger, who has
 scored a team-high 11 touchdowns,
 also has 29 receptions for 289 yards.
 Sophomore wide receiver Joe Green
 has a team-best 36 receptions for
 631 yards and six touchdowns.
 Junior wide receiver Logan Krueger
 has 29 receptions for 597 yards and
 six touchdowns.

Junior defensive back Ben Nantell
 has a team-high 64 tackles with four
 forced fumbles. Senior linebacker
 Justin Baker has 46 tackles, while
 sophomore defensive back Josh
 Vanden Heuvel has 45 stops. Junior
 defensive back Dan Sjoquist has 44
 stops and has blocked two kicks
 this year. Junior defensive lineman
 John Troyer has a team-high 9.5
 tackles for loss and three quarter-
 back sacks.

St. Norbert is averaging 435.9
 yards and 40.2 points per game,
 while opponents are netting 320.3
 yards and 17.9 points per game. The
 Green Knights are plus-16 in
 turnover margin to lead the

Midwest Conference in that category
 by 10 takeaways.

About the Foresters:

Lake Forest enters Saturday's
 game with a 2-7 overall record and
 are 2-6 in the Midwest Conference.
 The Foresters have won their last
 two games since an 0-7 start, beat-
 ing Lawrence 35-14 on Oct. 23
 before beating Knox 35-6 last
 Saturday.

Sophomore quarterback Pete
 Scaffidi rushed for 102 yards on 12
 carries against Knox and has 177
 yards on the year on 27 carries.
 Scaffidi has completed 48 of 89
 passes for 574 yards with seven
 touchdowns and seven intercep-
 tions. Senior quarterback Geoff
 Sobey has completed 85 of 153 pass-
 es for 785 yards and nine touch-
 downs with nine interceptions.

Junior wide receiver Kevin Davis
 has 39 receptions for 629 yards with
 11 touchdowns. Junior wide receiv-
 er Josh Kabala has 34 receptions for
 284 yards and one score.

Senior running back Brock
 Stenberg leads Lake Forest on the
 ground with 618 yards on 149 car-
 ries with one touchdown.

Lake Forest is averaging 289.8
 yards per game of total offense and
 is averaging 20.3 points per game.
 Opponents are averaging 387.0
 yards and 31.0 points per game.

Punt Patter:

St. Norbert and Ripon engaged in
 a rare statistical feat in the Green
 Knights 37-13 win last Saturday -
 neither team punted the ball.

It marked the first time since
 available records dating to 1978 St.
 Norbert and its opponent both have
 not punted in a game. It was also
 the first time a St. Norbert foe has
 not punted in a game since 1978.

St. Norbert has not punted in a
 game four times since 1978: in a 44-
 12 win over Grinnell on Oct. 3, 1992,
 a 54-7 win over Illinois College on
 Oct. 4, 2003 and a 48-13 win over
 Knox on Sept. 24, 2005.

last Saturday, a four-way tie for first was reduced to St. Norbert holding a one-game lead in the standings with one week left.

The Green Knights have clinched no worse than a share of their 13th MWC title in 26 years, and with a win would earn their ninth appearance in the NCAA Division III Playoffs.

St. Norbert also needs a win Saturday for its 12th consecutive season with at least seven wins. Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just three times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005 and a 7-3 campaign in 2008.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 396-267-20 in 76 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .594. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league best record of 154-32, a winning percentage of .828.

Quick Hitters:

* - St. Norbert is seventh out of 236 teams in Division III football in turnover margin at plus-1.78 turnovers per game. The Green Knights are 15th nationally in scoring offense at 40.2 points per game.

* - St. Norbert is averaging 4.9 yards per rushing attempt this season. The Green Knights have not rushed for over five yards per carry in a season since netting 5.3 yards per run in 2000. Prior to 2000, the last time St. Norbert had rushed for at least five yards a carry was in 1968.

* - During Jim Purtill's 12-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 59 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 27-2 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.

* - St. Norbert is 174-11 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 108-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.

About Donald J. Schneider Stadium

St. Norbert College is proud to move into the new Donald J. Schneider Stadium located on De Pere's near west side.

The 2,454-seat facility will house the Green Knights in football, men's and women's soccer and men's and women's outdoor track and field.

The stadium complex is named after major donor Don Schneider, a 1957 graduate of St. Norbert College. Schneider is the retired CEO of Schneider National Inc., one of the nation's largest transportation and logistics companies. Schneider is a former member of the college's Board of Trustees and was also an adjunct professor at the college during the 1960s.

The playing field within the stadium is named in honor of Howard "Chick" Kolstad, St. Norbert's football coach from 1960 to 1978. Immensely respected as a coach and person, Kolstad's 19 years produced a 96-76-5 record mainly against scholarship-level opponents. A fierce competitor who once proclaimed he would schedule Notre Dame if the Irish would agree to it, he had 12 winning seasons and two others at .500.



SCHNEIDER STADIUM replaces Minahan Stadium, which opened on De Pere's east side in 1938. It is the college's first new major college-owned athletics facility since Schuldes Sports Center opened in 1979.
