Game Overview:

St. Norbert hunts for its first win of the 2010 season when it makes its first of two trips over a three-week span to West Central Illinois to face Knox at the Knosher Bowl.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 14-2 series lead over Knox. The Green Knights have won the last 11 meetings with the Prairie Fire, with Knox's last win coming in a 21-19 triumph in 1998 in Galesburg, Ill.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 100-19 in his 12th season in De Pere.

Knox coach Chad Eisele (Knox, 1993) is 0-2 in his first season in Galesburg. Eisele went 31-20 in five years at Lake Forest from 2000 to 2004 and 1-9 in one season at Minnesota State-Moorhead in 2005 to give him a career mark of 32-31 in seven seasons.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert beat Knox 56-13 last Oct. 3 at Minahan Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights, who scored touchdowns on each of their first seven possessions, led 35-7 at halftime and 49-7 after three quarters to roll to the win.

The Green Knights put up 458 yards of total offense to just 238 for Knox. Rob Berger completed all 12 of his pass attempts for 165 yards and three

touchdowns in just a little over two quarters of action.

Mike Pinter led Knox with 55 yards rushing on 12 carries with one touchdown. Bill Meyer completed 3 of 8 passes for 54 yards with one touchdown and one interception.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert fell to 0-2 overall and 0-1 in the Midwest Conference with a 34-31 loss at Beloit this past Saturday. It was the first time the Green Knights have lost Midwest Conference opener since 1990.

The Green Knights are led on the ground by senior running back John Weninger, who has 146 yards on 40 carries. Senior quarterback Rob Berger has completed 22 of 46 passes for 214 yards with four touchdowns and five interceptions. Berger has rushed 16 times for 75 yards.

Sophomore wide receiver Joe Green has seven catches for 115 yards and one touchdown, while senior running back Bryan Stoppenbach has six catches for 18 yards and two touchdowns. Stoppenbach also has a rushing touchdown and has scored 18 of the Green Knights' 38 points.

St. Norbert's top three tacklers are defensive backs. Junior Ben Nantell has 24 tackles, sophomore Josh Vanden Heuvel 14 stops and junior Dan Sjoquist has 11. Nantell's 12 tackles per game are currently second in the Midwest Conference.

St. Norbert is averaging 274.5 yards and 19 points per game, totals that are ninth and eighth in the Midwest Conference, respectively. Opponents are averaging 414 yards and 37 points per game.

About the Prairie Fire:

Knox enters the St. Norbert game with an 0-2 overall record and an 0-1 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Prairie Fire, which has lost 12 of its last 13 games, opened the year with a 34-3 loss at Washington-Mo. before losing 33-12 last Saturday at Lawrence.

The Prairie Fire is led on the ground by Dan Kizior's 58 yards on

19 carries. Bill Meyer has the most attempts with 33 put has 10 net rushing yards. Meyer has completed 10 of 25 passes for 168 yards and two touchdowns with one interception. Clarke Cuthbert has seven receptions for 140 yards and two touchdowns.

Knox, which does not have a rushing touchdown so far, is averaging 7.5 points and 198 yards per game. Opponents have scored an average of 33.5 points with 419.5 yards per game.

Out of the Gate:

St. Norbert's 34-31 loss to Beloit on Saturday put the Green Knights at 0-2 for the first time in 13 years.

The Green Knights hadn't lost their first two games of a season since a 62-17 loss to UW-Oshkosh and a 48-7 setback to Drake on Sept. 6-13, 1997.

It also marked the first time St. Norbert had lost consecutive regular-season games in the 12-year coaching tenure of Jim Purtill. St. Norbert had not lost consecutive regular-season games since a 23-15 loss to Ripon and a 21-19 loss to Knox on Oct. 3-10, 1998.

Not Enough:

St. Norbert's 34-31 loss to Beloit on Saturday snapped a 59-game winning streak when scoring at least 30 points. The Green Knights' last loss when scoring at least 30 points was a 41-40 defeat to Illinois College on Nov. 10, 2001.

St. Norbert is now 169-11 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 105-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.

Turnover Tidbits:

Through two games, St. Norbert stands at minus-1 in turnover margin. However, opponents have turned the Green Knights' six turnovers into 31 points. St. Norbert has scored just 14 points off the five turnovers it has forced.

St. Thomas scored 24 points off the four turnovers it forced against the Green Knights, who had their only seven points come off an interception in deep in Tommies' territory.

Against Beloit, St. Norbert scored seven points set up by an interception. Beloit also scored seven points off an interception.

St. Norbert had just seven interceptions last year but has thrown five already this season.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is shooting for its 12th consecutive season with at least seven wins. Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just three times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005 and a 7-3 campaign in 2008.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 390-266-20 in 76 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .592. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league best record of 148-31, a winning percentage of .827. In 25 years in the Midwest Conference, St. Norbert has won 12 football championships.

St. Norbert has won 93 of its last 100 Midwest Conference games.

Quick Hitters:

- * St. Norbert has been outscored 27-7 in the first quarter of its two games this season.
- * St. Norbert is 5-for-10 on red zone opportunities this year. The Green Knights have four touchdowns and a field goal, and have missed two field goals, had one turnover, one series end on downs and a half end another.
- * Junior defensive lineman John Troyer is third in the Midwest Conference in tackles-for-loss at 2.5 per game.
- * During Jim Purtill's 11-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 55 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 26-1 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game seven different times.

About Donald J. Schneider Stadium

St. Norbert College is proud to move into the new Donald J. Schneider Stadium located on De Pere's near west side.

The 2,454-seat facility will house the Green Knights in football, men's and women's soccer and men's and women's outdoor track and field.

The stadium complex is named after major donor Don Schneider, a 1957 graduate of St. Norbert College. Schneider is the retired CEO of Schneider National Inc., one of the nation's largest transportation and logistics companies. Schneider is a former member of the college's Board of Trustees and was also an adjunct professor at the college during the 1960s.

The playing field within the stadium is named in honor of Howard "Chick" Kolstad, St. Norbert's football coach from 1960 to 1978. Immensely respected as a coach and person, Kolstad's 19 years produced a 96-76-5 record mainly against scholarship-level opponents. A fierce competitor who once proclaimed he would schedule Notre Dame if the Irish would agree to it, he had 12 winning seasons and two others at .500.



SCHNEIDER STADIUM replaces Minahan Stadium, which opened on De Pere's east side in 1938. It is the college's first new major college-owned athletics facility since Schuldes Sports Center opened in 1979.
