#### Game Overview:

St. Norbert will play its first Midwest Conference game at Kolstad Field at Schneider Stadium when it hosts Fox River Valley-rival Lawrence. Both teams are amongst a six-team logjam tied for third place in the Midwest Conference standings.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 21-9-2 series lead over Lawrence. The Green Knights have won the last 12 meetings with the Vikings since a 27-24 Lawrence win in 1997 in De Pere. Lawrence University claims only a 21-13-2 deficit in the series, but four games were played before St. Norbert began sponsoring varsity intercollegiate football in 1931.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 101-19 in his 12th season in De Pere.

Lawrence coach Chris Howard (UW-Stevens Point, 1983) is 17-35 in his sixth season in Appleton.

#### Last Meeting:

St. Norbert beat Lawrence 45-3 last Sept. 19 at Minahan Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights led 24-0 at halftime and were never seriously threatened in the second half.

St. Norbert outgained Lawrence 444-183 in total offense. Rob Berger completed 16 of 25 passes for 329 yards and three touchdowns with one inter-

ception. Jeremy Gezella caught six passes for 157 yards and two touch-downs.

#### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert improved to 1-2 overall and 1-1 in the Midwest Conference with a 49-0 throttling of Knox College last Saturday in Galesburg, Ill. The Green Knights rolled up 683 yards of total offense in the game.

Senior quarterback Rob Berger completed 16 of 19 passes for 284 yards and two touchdowns in little over one-half the game, and also had three rushing touchdowns. Berger has completed 38 of 65 passes for 498 yards and six touchdowns and five interceptions this season.

Senior running back John Weninger leads the ground game with 251 yards on 56 carries with three touchdowns. Berger has 137 yards rushing on 24 carries with three touchdowns. Sophomore wide receiver Joe Green leads the team in receptions with 10, and has 178 yards and two touchdowns.

Junior defensive back Ben Nantell has a team-high 29 tackles, while sophomore running back Josh Vanden Heuvel has 19 stops. Junior defensive lineman John Troyer has a team-high five tackles for loss.

St. Norbert is averaging 410.7 yards and 29 points per game, while opponents are netting 340 yards and 24.7 points per game.

#### About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters the St. Norbert game at 1-2 overall and 1-1 in the Midwest Conference. The Vikings are coming off a tough 30-25 loss to defending MWC champion Monmouth Saturday at the Banta Bowl in Appleton. The Vikings beat Knox 33-12 on Sept. 11 for their only win of the year.

The Vikings' top two rushers are also their top two passers. Sophomore Tyler Mazur has 188 yards rushing on 18 carries for three touchdowns, and has completed 32 of 55 passes for 343 yards and three touchdowns with six interceptions. Freshman Luke Barthelmess has rushed 22 times for 113 yards and has completed 35 of 63 passes for 324 yards with two touchdowns and three interceptions.

Freshman Sam Wagner is the leading receiver with 17 receptions for 243 yards and two touchdowns. Freshman Mason Garcia has 14 receptions for 99 yards and one touchdown.

Senior Greg Pater has a team-high 26 tackles, while senior Jeff Nicholas has 22 stops. Junior Robbie Ulloa has 21 tackles with 5.5 tackles-for-loss.

Lawrence is averaging 356.3 yards per game of total offense and is averaging 27.3 points per game. Opponents are averaging 319 yards and 24.3 points per game.

#### **Snapping Out of It:**

St. Norbert's offense, which was ninth in the Midwest Conference through two games, turned it on in a big way against Knox, piling up a whopping 683 yards of total offense.

The yardage sum ranks as the third-best offensive output in school history, and only the sixth time St. Norbert has surpassed the 600-yard plateau in school history. St. Norbert's school record of 732 yards came on 91 plays on Oct. 27, 2001 against Lake Forest. The Green Knights put up 731 yards on 98 plays on Oct. 9, 2004 against Lawrence.

St. Norbert put up its 683 yards against Knox on just 75 plays, averaging 9.1 yards per play.

The Green Knights' 347 yards passing also ranks in the top 10 in school history for passing yardage in a game.

#### **Turnover Tidbits:**

Through three games, St. Norbert stands at minus-1 in turnover margin after a push of 2-2 in the Knox game. Opponents have turned the Green Knights' eight turnovers into 31 points. St. Norbert has scored just 14 points off the seven turnovers it has forced.

St. Thomas scored 24 points off the four turnovers it forced against the Green Knights, who had their only

Against Beloit, St. Norbert scored seven points set up by an interception. Beloit also scored seven points off an interception.

St. Norbert had just seven interceptions last year but has thrown five already this season.

#### Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is shooting for its 12th consecutive season with at least seven wins. Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just three times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005 and a 7-3 campaign in 2008.

The Green Knights have an alltime record of 391-266-20 in 76 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .592. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league best record of 149-31, a winning percentage of .828. In 25 years in the Midwest Conference, St. Norbert has won 12 football championships.

St. Norbert has won 94 of its last 101 Midwest Conference games.

#### Quick Hitters:

\* - St. Norbert went 6-for-9 scoring points when reaching the red zone against Knox after opening the year 5-for-10 in its first two games. The Green Knights lost two fumbles and had a series end on downs against Knox.

\* - St. Norbert is now 169-11 alltime when scoring 30-or-more points and is 105-2 all-time when scoring 40or-more points.

\* - During Jim Purtill's 11-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 55 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 26-1 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game seven different times.

# About Donald J. Schneider Stadium

St. Norbert College is proud to move into the new Donald J. Schneider Stadium located on De Pere's near west side.

The 2,454-seat facility will house the Green Knights in football, men's and women's soccer and men's and women's outdoor track and field.

The stadium complex is named after major donor Don Schneider, a 1957 graduate of St. Norbert College. Schneider is the retired CEO of Schneider National Inc., one of the nation's largest transportation and logistics companies. Schneider is a former member of the college's Board of Trustees and was also an adjunct professor at the college during the 1960s.

The playing field within the stadium is named in honor of Howard "Chick" Kolstad, St. Norbert's football coach from 1960 to 1978. Immensely respected as a coach and person, Kolstad's 19 years produced a 96-76-5 record mainly against scholarship-level opponents. A fierce competitor who once proclaimed he would schedule Notre Dame if the Irish would agree to it, he had 12 winning seasons and two others at .500.



**SCHNEIDER STADIUM** replaces Minahan Stadium, which opened on De Pere's east side in 1938. It is the college's first new major college-owned athletics facility since Schuldes Sports Center opened in 1979.
