Game Overview:

St. Norbert looks to keep pace with Midwest Conference leader Ripon when it hosts Illinois College on De Pere Day at Schneider Stadium. Admission is free to this game.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 17-1 series lead over Illinois College. The Green Knights won the first nine meetings in the series before the Blueboys won 41-40 on Nov. 10, 2001 at Jacksonville, Ill. St. Norbert has won the last eight meetings. The Green Knights are 9-0 at home in the series.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 103-19 in his 12th season in De Pere.

Illinois College coach Garrett Campbell (CSU-Fullerton, 1998) is 11-14 in his third season in Jacksonville.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert cruised to a 49-0 win over Illinois College last Nov. 7 at England Stadium in Jacksonville, Ill. St. Norbert led 21-0 at halftime and pulled away from there.

The Green Knights outgained the Blueboys 427-119 in total offense. Illinois College was held to seven first downs and punted 13 times.

Rob Berger completed 20 of 31 passes for 217 yards with three touchdowns and one interception. Current Illinois College graduate assistant

Jeremy Gezella caught nine passes for 119 yards and one touchdown, while Logan Krueger added a pair of touchdown receptions. John Weninger had a team-high 59 yards rushing on 15 carries and one touchdown.

Mitch Niekamp led Illinois College, completing 10 of 31 passes for 60 yards.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert stands at 3-2 overall and 3-1 in the Midwest Conference after a 48-2 rout on the road of twotime defending league champion Monmouth College.

Senior quarterback Rob Berger has improved his Midwest Conference-best passing efficiency rating to 172.25. Berger has completed 66 of 104 passes (63.5 percent) for 979 yards with 13 touchdowns against six interceptions. Berger also has 267 rushing yards on 42 carries with four touchdowns.

Senior running back John Weninger leads the team - and is second in the MWC - in rushing with 451 yards on 103 carries with four touchdowns. Weninger also leads the team in receptions with 18 catches for 212 yards. Junior wide receiver Logan Krueger has a teamhigh 262 yards receiving with 15 catches and two touchdowns. Sophomore wide receiver Joe Green has 14 receptions for 221 yards and three touchdowns.

Junior defensive back Ben Nantell, this week's MWC Defensive Player of the Week, has a team-high 47 tackles. Junior defensive back Dan Sjoquist has 24 tackles with a team-high three passes defensed. Junior defensive lineman John Troyer has a team-high seven tackles for loss.

St. Norbert is averaging 462.8 yards and 42.4 points per game, while opponents are netting 330 yards and 20.4 points per game.

About the Blueboys:

Illinois College enters the game with a 2-3 overall record and a 2-2 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Blueboys have won two of their last three games. Illinois College beat Lake Forest 27-7 on Sept. 18, and after a 33-9 loss to Monmouth beat Lawrence 45-21 last Saturday. The Blueboys are 0-2 on the road this season.

Freshman running back Cecil Brimmage earned this week's MWC Offensive Player of the Week honors after running for 248 yards and three touchdowns against Lawrence. Brimmage has 347 yards on the season on 56 carries.

Quarterback Mitch Niekamp who passed a Minahan Stadiumrecord 74 times in 2008 - leads the Blueboys' passing attack, completing 108 of 188 passes for 1,188 yards with 10 touchdowns and 14 interceptions. Brock Thompson is his leading target with 23 receptions for 348 yards and three touchdowns. A total of 17 different players have caught a pass for Illinois College already this season.

Illinois College is averaging 370.8 yards per game of total offense and is averaging 26.4 points per game. Opponents are averaging 377.6 yards and 27.4 points per game.

Double Trouble:

Senior running back John Weninger recorded a rare daily double in the 48-2 win over Monmouth, recording at least 100 yards rushing and receiving in the same game.

Weninger's 126 yards rushing and 104 yards receiving marked just the third time in St. Norbert history a player has reached those two game plateaus simultaneously. Weninger's combined total of 230 yards is the highest among the three.

Jason Augustynowicz had 124 yards rushing and 102 yards receiving in a 31-7 win over Monmouth in 2001. Alec Getschow had 112 yards rushing and 100 yards receiving in a 63-14 win over Carroll in 2002.

Hot Hand:

Senior quarterback Rob Berger has been incredibly efficient in St. Norbert's last three games, all blowout wins for the Green Knights.

In a 77-26 win over Lawrence, Berger was 12-for-19 for 250 yards and five touchdowns. In a 48-2 win over Monmouth, Berger was 16-for-20 for 231 yards and two touchdowns with one interception.

Having at least an 80 percent completion rating against Knox and Monmouth gives Berger two of the top seven most accurate passing games in St. Norbert history.

In his most recent three games, Berger's quarterback rating is a staggering 201.20. His season rating of 172.25 leads the Midwest Conference and is 10th in this week's NCAA Division III statistical rankings.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is shooting for its 12th consecutive season with at least seven wins. Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just three times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005 and a 7-3 campaign in 2008.

The Green Knights have an alltime record of 393-266-20 in 76 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .594. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league best record of 151-31, a winning percentage of .830. In 25 years in the Midwest Conference, St. Norbert has won 12 football championships.

Quick Hitters:

* - St. Norbert is now 171-11 alltime when scoring 30-or-more points and is 107-2 all-time when scoring 40or-more points.

* - During Jim Purtill's 12-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 58 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 27-1 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.

About Donald J. Schneider Stadium

St. Norbert College is proud to move into the new Donald J. Schneider Stadium located on De Pere's near west side.

The 2,454-seat facility will house the Green Knights in football, men's and women's soccer and men's and women's outdoor track and field.

The stadium complex is named after major donor Don Schneider, a 1957 graduate of St. Norbert College. Schneider is the retired CEO of Schneider National Inc., one of the nation's largest transportation and logistics companies. Schneider is a former member of the college's Board of Trustees and was also an adjunct professor at the college during the 1960s.

The playing field within the stadium is named in honor of Howard "Chick" Kolstad, St. Norbert's football coach from 1960 to 1978. Immensely respected as a coach and person, Kolstad's 19 years produced a 96-76-5 record mainly against scholarship-level opponents. A fierce competitor who once proclaimed he would schedule Notre Dame if the Irish would agree to it, he had 12 winning seasons and two others at .500.



SCHNEIDER STADIUM replaces Minahan Stadium, which opened on De Pere's east side in 1938. It is the college's first new major college-owned athletics facility since Schuldes Sports Center opened in 1979.
