Game Overview:

St. Norbert faces Grinnell in a key Midwest Conference game, with the winner remaining in the hunt for the league championship. The game is also the dedication game for Schneider Stadium as well as St. Norbert's homecoming.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 15-1 lead in the all-time series, which began in 1986. Grinnell's only win in the series came in a 49-28 win in 1998 in De Pere, a year when the Pioneers went 10-0. The Green Knights are 11-0 against Grinnell under Jim Purtill.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 104-20 in his 12th season in De Pere.

Grinnell coach Jeff Pedersen (Grinnell, 2002) is 5-2 in his first season in Grinnell.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert battled to a 14-11 win over Grinnell last Sept. 12 in a defensive battle at Rosenbloom Field in Grinnell. The Green Knights led 7-3 at halftime and 14-3 after three quarters before holding off the Pioneers in the final 15 minutes.

John Weninger scored on touchdown runs of 4 and 6 yards for the Green Knights' lone touchdowns, finishing scoring drives of 20 and 49 yards.

St. Norbert outgained Grinnell 237-176 in total offense. Weninger rushed 30 times for 132 yards with the two touchdowns. Rob Berger completed 9 of 27 passes for 66 yards and was sacked five times.

Grinnell rushed for 40 net yards in 28 attempts. Mike Bogard completed 14 of 32 passes for 118 yards and one interception.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert moved to 4-3 overall and 4-2 in the Midwest Conference after topping erstwhile league co-leader Carroll 30-6 this past Saturday in Waukesha.

Senior quarterback Rob Berger has completed 94 of 163 passes (57.7 percent) for 1,377 yards with 15 touchdowns against nine interceptions. Berger, who went over 4,000 career passing yards in the Carroll game, also has 364 rushing yards on 65 carries with five touchdowns.

Senior running back John Weninger leads the team in rushing with 615 yards on 151 carries with seven touchdowns. Weninger, who has scored a team-high seven touchdowns, also leads the team in receptions with 25 catches for 261 yards. Sophomore wide receiver Joe Green has 23 receptions for 440 yards and four touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Logan Krueger has 21 receptions for 371 yards and three touchdowns.

Junior defensive back Ben Nantell has a team-high 53 tackles. Senior linebacker Justin Baker and sophomore defensive back Josh Vanden Heuvel each have 33 tackles, while junior defensive back Dan Sjoquist has 32 stops. Junior defensive lineman John Troyer has a team-high eight tackles for loss.

St. Norbert is averaging 436.6 yards and 38.1 points per game, while opponents are netting 314.6 yards and 19.1 points per game.

About the Pioneers:

Grinnell enters Saturday's game with a 5-2 overall record and a 4-2 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Pioneers have won three of their last four games, including a 31-17 home win over Lawrence last

Saturday. Grinnell's five wins this season are its most since going 6-4 in 2004.

Junior quarterback Mike Bogard paces the Grinnell offense, completing 122 of 197 (61.9 percent) of his passes for 1,484 yards with 13 touchdowns and seven interceptions. Sophomore quarterback Mike McCabe has also seen plenty of action in an offense that passes an average of 43 times a game. McCabe has completed 56 of 102 passes (54.9 percent) for 703 yards with eight touchdowns and eight interceptions.

Sophomore wide receiver Logan Granera has 51 receptions for 820 yards and six touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Robert Seer has 45 receptions for 579 yards and 12 touchdowns.

Grinnell, which rushes for just 75.1 yards per game, is led on the ground by sophomore running back T.J. Schaid, who has 266 yards on 74 carries and one touchdown.

Grinnell is averaging 387.6 yards per game of total offense and is averaging 28.6 points per game. Opponents are averaging 403.4 yards and 26.7 points per game.

Happy Homecomings:

St. Norbert's Homecomings have typically given alumni a cause to celebrate, with the Green Knights going 51-24-1 in the Fall Classics.

The Green Knights have enjoyed great Homecoming success since joining the Midwest Conference for football in 1984, going 23-3. St. Norbert has won 18 of its last 19 Homecoming contests. Since 1984, St. Norbert has beaten Ripon for Homecoming on seven different occasions. The only MWC schools to spoil Homecoming was the Univ. of Chicago in 1985 (7-6 loss), Beloit in 1990 (16-10 loss) and Grinnell in 1998 (49-28 loss).

St. Norbert head coach Jim Purtill is 11-0 on Homecoming.

in one game of first place with three games remaining.

Ripon is in first place at 5-1. Five teams are in a logjam for second place at 4-2: Carroll, Grinnell, Illinois College, Monmouth and St. Norbert. St. Norbert and Grinnell face off this week while Ripon is at Illinois College.

The last football MWC co-championship came in 2002 when St. Norbert and Lake Forest shared the title. The MWC has not had a three-way tie since 1976 when Cornell, Knox and Monmouth all shared the crown.

A four-way tie for the championship has not happened since 1925 when Beloit, Cornell, Monmouth and Carleton were deadlocked atop the standings.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert needs to win out in the regular season for its 12th consecutive season with at least seven wins. Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just three times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005 and a 7-3 campaign in 2008.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 394-267-20 in 76 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .593. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league best record of 152-32, a winning percentage of .826. In 25 years in the Midwest Conference, St. Norbert has won 12 football championships.

Quick Hitters:

* - St. Norbert is averaging 5.0 yards per rushing attempt this season. The Green Knights have not rushed for over five yards per carry in a season since netting 5.3 yards per run in 2000. Prior to 2000, the last time St. Norbert had rushed for at least five yards a carry was in 1968.

* - St. Norbert opponents are 15-for-75 on third-down conversions this year, a Midwest Conference best 20 percent conversion rate. Carroll was 1-for-11 against St. Norbert on third down this past Saturday.

About Donald J. Schneider Stadium

St. Norbert College is proud to move into the new Donald J. Schneider Stadium located on De Pere's near west side.

The 2,454-seat facility will house the Green Knights in football, men's and women's soccer and men's and women's outdoor track and field.

The stadium complex is named after major donor Don Schneider, a 1957 graduate of St. Norbert College. Schneider is the retired CEO of Schneider National Inc., one of the nation's largest transportation and logistics companies. Schneider is a former member of the college's Board of Trustees and was also an adjunct professor at the college during the 1960s.

The playing field within the stadium is named in honor of Howard "Chick" Kolstad, St. Norbert's football coach from 1960 to 1978. Immensely respected as a coach and person, Kolstad's 19 years produced a 96-76-5 record mainly against scholarship-level opponents. A fierce competitor who once proclaimed he would schedule Notre Dame if the Irish would agree to it, he had 12 winning seasons and two others at .500.



SCHNEIDER STADIUM replaces Minahan Stadium, which opened on De Pere's east side in 1938. It is the college's first new major college-owned athletics facility since Schuldes Sports Center opened in 1979.
