#### Game Overview:

St. Norbert College hosts Knox College during Family Weekend at Schneider Stadium. The game is part of SNC Day festivities on the St. Norbert campus, with admission to the game free.

#### **Broadcast:**

#### The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 15-2 series lead over Knox. The Green Knights have won the last 12 meetings with the Prairie Fire, with Knox's last win coming in a 21-19 triumph in 1998 in Galesburg, Ill.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 108-22 in his 13th season in De Pere.

Knox coach Chad Eisele (Knox, 1993) is 1-11 in his second season in Galesburg. Eisele went 31-20 in five years at Lake Forest from 2000 to 2004 and 1-9 in one season at Minnesota State-Moorhead in 2005 to give him a career mark of 33-40 in eight seasons.

#### **Last Meeting:**

St. Norbert rolled to a 49-0 win over Knox last Sept. 18 at the Knosher Bowl in Galesburg, Ill.

The Green Knights led 35-0 at halftime and scored touchdowns on seven of their first eight possessions. Rob Berger completed 16 of 19 passes for 284 yards and two touchdowns. John Weninger rushed for 105 yards as the Green Knights ran for 336 yards and totaled 683 yards of offense with 30 first downs. The 683 yards of total offense was the third-highest mark in school history.

Knox was held to 192 yards of total offense.

#### **About the Green Knights:**

St. Norbert improved to 1-1 on the season and 1-0 in the Midwest Conference with a 30-14 win over Beloit this past Saturday at Schneider Stadium. The Green Knights led 17-0 at halftime and 30-0 after three quarters. Beloit finished the game with minus-16 yards rushing in head coach Jim Purtill's 100th Midwest Conference victory.

Senior running back Adam Gruett rushed 19 times for 151 yards and one touchdown. Gruett leads St. Norbert on the ground with 190 yards on 37 carries. Senior quarterback Mike Fabrizio is 21 of 50 for 281 yards and three touchdowns with three interceptions on the season. Junior wide receiver Joe Green has eight catches for 107 yards and one touchdown.

St. Norbert sacked Beloit's quarterback seven times, with 3.5 going to junior defensive lineman Petr Bohacek. Bohacek, who was named MWC Defensive Player of the Week, also had 10 tackles and 4.5 tackles for loss. Senior linebacker Ben Nantell has a team-high 16 tackles this season and also had two quarterback sacks against Beloit.

St. Norbert is averaging 308.0 yards and 18.5 points per game, while opponents are netting 338.0 yards and 17.0 points per game. Opponents are rushing for an average of just 19.5 yards per game this season.

#### **About the Prairie Fire:**

Knox enters the game 0-2 overall and 0-1 in the Midwest Conference after a 62-42 loss to Lawrence at home last Saturday. The Prairie Fire also dropped their season opener 28-10 to Washington (Mo.) University on Sept. 3.

Sophomore quarterback Drew Diaz has completed 33 of 66 passes for 429 yards and six touchdowns with six interceptions in two games. Senior wide receiver Clarke Cuthbert has been Diaz's main target, hauling in 11 passes for 234 yards and three touchdowns. Sophomore running back Derek Mortenson leads Knox on the ground with 143 yards on 35 carries.

Junior linebacker Mike Hendrick leads the Knox defense with 33 tackles. Sophomore defensive back Matt Hendrick follows with 17 tackles and two passes defensed.

Knox is averaging 361.5 yards and 26.0 points per game, while opponents are averaging 521.0 yards and 45.0 points per game.

#### **Stuck in Reverse:**

St. Norbert held Beloit to minus-16 yards rushing this past Saturday. It marked the 14th time, according to available records, the Green Knights have held their opponent to a negative rushing total.

It was the fifth time since Jim Purtill took over as head coach in 1999 St. Norbert has held a foe to a negative rushing total. Lake Forest was held to minus-28 on Sept. 27, 2008, followed by a minus-11 yard total against Grinnell on Sept. 13, 2008. The Green Knights held Ripon to minus-11 yards on Oct. 25, 2003 and Illinois College to minus-7 yards on Oct. 4, 2003.

The St. Norbert record for best rushing defense came with a minus-77 yard total against UW-Stevens Point on Sept. 21, 1974.

#### Winning Ways:

In 2010, St. Norbert posted its 12th consecutive season with at least seven wins. Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight

games just three times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005 and 7-3 campaigns in 2008 and 2010.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 398-269-20 in 78 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .594. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league best record of 156-32, a winning percentage of .830.

The St. Norbert traveling party will attend the Notre Dame-Navy game played the next day at Aviva Stadium in Dublin.

#### **Quick Hitters:**

- \* Junior defensive lineman Petr Bohacek is fourth in the NCAA Division III national statistics in quarterback sacks with an average of 2.25 per game.
- \* St. Norbert's rushing defense is third in Division III allowing 19.5 yards per game. It is also sixth in both sacks (5 per game) and tackles for loss (11 per game).
- \* Junior kicker Sam Mason nailed a 42-yard field goal against Beloit this past Saturday, a boot that easily cleared the crossbar. It marked the first time in 26 games St. Norbert had a field goal of at least 40 years, dating back to Roger Nault's 41-yard placement against Monmouth on Oct. 11,
- \* St. Norbert is 175-11 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 108-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
- \* During Jim Purtill's 13-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 59 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 27-2 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.
