Game Overview:

St. Norbert College heads south down Highway 41 for its annual battle against Fox River Valley-rival Lawrence University. The Green Knights are one win short of their 400th football victory, dating back to the start of full varsity intercollegiate competition in 1931.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 22-9-2 series lead over Lawrence. The Green Knights have won the last 13 meetings with the Vikings since a 27-24 Lawrence win in 1997 in De Pere. Lawrence University claims only a 22-13-2 deficit in the series, but four games were played before St. Norbert began sponsoring varsity intercollegiate football in 1931.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 109-22 in his 13th season in De Pere.

Lawrence coach Chris Howard (UW-Stevens Point, 1983) is 19-43 in his seventh season in Appleton.

Lawrence last Sept. 25 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights led 27-6 at halftime before scoring 50 second half points, getting touchdowns on seven of eight second half possessions. The total of 103 points also set a St. Norbert record for highest combined score in school history.

The Green Knights rolled up 622 yards of total offense, including 346 on the ground. Rob Berger completed 12 of 19 passes for 250 yards and a school-record five touchdowns to lead St. Norbert.

Lawrence passed for 359 yards, with Jeremiah Johnson catching nine passes for 146 yards and one touchdown.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert improved to 2-1 on the season and 2-0 in the Midwest Conference with a 43-7 win over Knox this past Saturday at Schneider Stadium. The Green Knights led 21-0 at halftime and 36-0 after three quarters en route to posting 531 yards of total offense.

Senior running back Adam Gruett leads St. Norbert in rushing with 242 yards on 52 carries and one touchdown. Junior running back Austin Williams ran for a career high 92 yards against Knox with two touchdowns, and has 134 vards on 25 carries for the season. Senior quarterback Mike Fabrizio, who passed for 282 yards and four touchdowns against Knox, has completed 41 of 80 passes for 563 yards and seven touchdowns against three interceptions this season. Junior wide receiver Joe Green has 17 receptions for 205 yards after catching nine balls against Knox.

Senior linebacker Ben Nantell has a team-high 24 tackles this season, and also leads the squad with 6.5 tackles-for-loss. Junior defensive lineman owns the team lead in quarterback sacks with 4.5, while Nantell has three sacks. Senior linebacker Ben Lombardi has five tackles-for-loss with two sacks.

St. Norbert is averaging 382.3 yards and 26.7 points per game, while opponents are netting 276.7 yards and 13.7 points per game.

Opponents are rushing for an average of just 43.7 yards per game and 1.3 yards per carry this season.

About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters Saturday's game with a 1-2 overall record and a 1-1 ledger in the Midwest Conference. The Vikings are coming off a 56-0 loss at Monmouth this past Saturday. Lawrence opened the season with a 34-21 home non-conference loss to St. Scholastica on Sept. 3 before beating Knox 62-42 on Sept. 10.

Sophomore quarterback Luke Barthelmess has completed 69 of 111 passes for 1,025 yards and eight touchdowns with two interceptions. Barthelmess threw for a Midwest Conference-record 549 yards on 28 of 39 passing with six touchdowns in the win over Knox. Barthelmess is the Vikings' leading rusher with 115 yards on 48 carries. Junior wide receiver Tyler Mazur has caught 21 passes for 342 yards and five touchdowns.

Senior defensive lineman Nick Kerkman shares the team lead in tackles with 22 stops. Senior defensive back Robbie Ulloa has 22 tackles with one interception. Junior defensive lineman Alex Schmitt has 3.5 tackles-for-loss and three quarterback sacks.

Lawrence is averaging 421.3 yards and 27.7 points per game, while opponents are averaging 540.0 yards and 44.0 points per game.

Three and Out:

St. Norbert has been stellar defensively on third down this season, with opponents converting a paltry 17.5 percent of its chances. Foes have moved the chains just seven times on 40 third down opportunities

The mark easily leads the Midwest Conference, well ahead of Ripon (30.3 percent) and Carroll (31.7 percent).

The Green Knights also lead the MWC in red zone defense, allowing scores on just 5 of 10 possessions. St. Norbert has held twice on downs and opponents have missed

Winning Ways:

In 2010, St. Norbert posted its 12th consecutive season with at least seven wins. Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just three times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005 and 7-3 campaigns in 2008 and 2010.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 399-269-20 in 78 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .594. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league best record of 157-32, a winning percentage of .831.

The St. Norbert traveling party will attend the Notre Dame-Navy game played the next day at Aviva Stadium in Dublin.

Ouick Hitters:

- * St. Norbert's 26 first downs against Knox doubled their total on the year to 52. The Green Knights had 16 against Beloit and 10 in the season opener against St. Thomas. The Green Knights' average of 17.3 first downs per game is the lowest in the Midwest Conference.
- * St. Norbert is 176-11 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 109-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
- * During Jim Purtill's 13-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 59 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 27-2 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.
