Game Overview:

St. Norbert College hosts Monmouth College in a game that will leave the winner alone in first place in the Midwest Conference. The winner of the St. Norbert-Monmouth game has gone on to an outright Midwest Conference title in each of the past eight seasons.

Broadcast:

The game will be broadcast live on WACY-TV 32 with Ted Stefaniak and John Maino on the call. WACY is available to Time Warner Cable customers in Northeast Wisconsin on Channel 13.

The game will also be videostreamed online on www.nmtvsports.com with Tim Derozier on the call.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 20-5 series lead over Monmouth in a series that began in 1975. The Green Knights have won 11 of the last 14 games in the series, but the two teams have split the last six meetings. Monmouth has won two of its last three visits to De Pere - 28-20 in 2005 and 31-22 in 2008 - sandwiched around a 48-0 St. Norbert rout in 2006.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 110-22 in his 13th season in De Pere.

Monmouth coach Steve Bell (Bemidji State, 1991) is 87-31 in his 12th season in Monmouth.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert returned three interceptions for touchdowns in the third quarter to break open a close game and beat Monmouth 48-2 last Oct. 2 in Monmouth, Ill.

Austin Arts, Josh Holzhaeuser and Justin Baker all had interception returns for scores in a 28-point third quarter which gave St. Norbert a 41-0 lead. The Green Knights intercepted Monmouth five times.

St. Norbert outgained Monmouth 460-176 in total offense. John Weninger rushed for 126 yards on 31 carries with two touchdowns. Rob Berger completed 16 of 20 passes for 231 yards.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert stands at 3-1 overall and 3-0 in the Midwest Conference following a 30-0 win over Lawrence this past Saturday in Appleton. It was the Green Knights' first shutout of the season.

Junior running back Austin Williams took over the team rushing lead with a 133-yard effort against Lawrence, and now has 267 yards on 40 carries on the year. Senior quarterback Mike Fabrizio, who threw for 260 yards against Lawrence, has completed 63 of 117 passes for 823 yards and eight touchdowns with three interceptions. Junior wide receiver Joe Green has 25 receptions for 285 yards and four touchdowns, while senior wide receiver Logan Krueger has 16 catches for 307 yards and one score.

Senior linebacker Ben Nantell has a team-high 29 tackles this season, and also leads the squad with 7.5 tackles-for-loss. Junior defensive lineman Petr Bohacek owns the team lead in quarterback sacks with five, while Nantell and senior defensive lineman Dan Hansmann have three sacks apiece. Senior linebacker Ben Lombardi has five tackles-for-loss with two sacks.

St. Norbert is averaging 420.0 yards and 27.5 points per game, while opponents are netting 267.2 yards and 10.3 points per game. Opponents are rushing for an aver-

age of just 41.0 yards per game and 1.4 yards per carry this season.

About the Scots:

Monmouth enters the game with a 3-1 overall record and a 3-0 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Scots defeated Illinois College 55-14 last week. Monmouth's lone loss came in its season opener at home to Wartburg 35-28.

The Scots' offense starts with fifth-year senior quarterback Alex Tanney. Tanney, who missed all but two games last season with an injury, has completed 96 of 131 (73.3 percent) passes for 1,353 yards and 14 touchdowns with one interception. Senior wide receiver Mike Blodgett, also a fifth-year senior after sitting out with an injury last year, has 40 receptions for 600 yards and four touchdowns. Sophomore running back Trey Yocum has rushed for 515 yards on 67 carries with seven touchdowns.

Senior linebacker Rod Ojong and freshman linebacker Preston Lumzy share the team lead in tackles with 31 apiece. Lumzy has 5.5 quarterback sacks. Senior linebacker Adam Hoste has 29 tackles and two interceptions, including one for a 100-yard touchdown return last week against Illinois College.

Monmouth is averaging 584.5 yards and 50 points per game, while opponents are averaging 345.5 yards and 17.3 points per game.

Tanney Terrific:

One of the most intriguing matchups in Division III football this week is St. Norbert's stingy defense against decorated Monmouth quarterback Alex Tanney.

The Green Knights' defense has been stout so far this year, ranking third in this week's NCAA Division III statistical rankings in rushing defense (41.0 yards per game), third in tackles-for-loss (10.5 per game), ninth in sacks (4.0 per game) and 13th in scoring defense (10.3 points per game).

Tanney leads an offense ranked

No. 1 nationally in total offense (584.5 yards per game) and No. 3 in scoring (50.0 points per game).

In his career, Tanney has thrown for 11,735 yards, completing 1,020 of 1,494 passes (68.3 percent). He has thrown 133 touchdown passes against 23 interceptions. His career passing yardage is 1,870 yards short and his touchdown passes 15 shy of NCAA Division III career records. Tanney, who is 2-1 as a starter against St. Norbert, has a NCAA Division III career record of 27 games of at least 300 yards passing.

Winning Ways:

In 2010, St. Norbert posted its 12th consecutive season with at least seven wins. Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just three times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005 and 7-3 campaigns in 2008 and 2010.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 400-269-20 in 78 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .595. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league best record of 158-32, a winning percentage of .832.

The St. Norbert traveling party will attend the Notre Dame-Navy game played the next day at Aviva Stadium in Dublin.

Quick Hitters:

- * St. Norbert is 177-11 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 109-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
- * During Jim Purtill's 13-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 59 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 27-2 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.
