#### Game Overview:

St. Norbert College looks to stay within striking distance of first-place Monmouth College when it travels deep into the Land of Lincoln to face Illinois College. The Green Knights and Blueboys are currently locked in a four-way tie for second place along with Carroll and Ripon.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 17-2 series lead over Illinois College. The Green Knights won the first nine meetings in the series before the Blueboys won 41-40 on Nov. 10, 2001 at Jacksonville, Ill. St. Norbert had then won the eight straight meetings before the Blueboys won 26-25 last season at Schneider Stadium in De Pere.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 110-23 in his 13th season in De Pere.

Illinois College coach Garrett Campbell (CSU-Fullerton, 1998) is 18-17 in his fourth season in Jacksonville.

#### **Last Meeting:**

Illinois College rallied late to top St. Norbert 26-25 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere last Oct. 9. The Blueboys' Mitch Niekamp hooked up with Brett Eschmann on a 20-yard touchdown pass on fourth down with 1:48 remaining to pull out the win. The Blueboys held a 19-6 third-quarter lead before St. Norbert charged back to take a 25-19 lead. There was a total of nine

turnovers in the game, including five by St. Norbert.

Rob Berger completed 14 of 34 passes for 150 yards with one touchdown and three interceptions for St. Norbert. John Weninger rushed for 119 yards on 25 carries for the Green Knights.

Niekamp completed 25 of 39 passes for 246 yards with two touchdowns and two interceptions. Cecil Brimmage rushed 29 times for 130 yards for the Blueboys.

#### **About the Green Knights:**

St. Norbert stands at 3-2 overall and 3-1 in the Midwest Conference after a heartbreaking 10-3 loss at home to Monmouth. The Green Knights had four red zone opportunities but came away with only three points.

Junior running back Austin Williams, who missed the Monmouth game with an injury, holds the team rushing lead with 267 yards on 40 carries and four touchdowns. Sophomore running back Craig Fagan rushed for 103 yards against Monmouth and has 251 yards this season. Senior quarterback Mike Fabrizio has completed 84 of 153 passes for 1,075 yards with eight touchdowns and three interceptions. Junior wide receiver Joe Green has 33 receptions for 405 vards and four touchdowns.

Senior linebacker Ben Nantell leads the Green Knights in tackles with 35. He also has five passes defensed, 7.5 tackles for loss and three sacks. Freshman defensive back Justin Johnson has 28 tackles and a team-high three interceptions. Junior defensive lineman Petr Bohacek has 24 tackles with teamhighs with eight tackles-for-loss and six sacks.

St. Norbert is averaging 407.4 yards and 22.6 points per game, while opponents are netting 280.4 yards and 10.2 points per game. Opponents are rushing for an average of just 48.8 yards per game and 1.7 yards per carry this season.

#### **About the Blueboys:**

Illinois College enters this week with a 4-1 overall record and a 3-1

mark in the Midwest Conference. The Blueboys dispatched Lawrence 54-44 this past Saturday in Appleton.

Freshman quarterback Michael Bates leads the Illinois College offense with 129 completions in 205 attempts (62.9 percent) for 1,566 yards with 14 touchdowns and seven interceptions. Senior wide receiver Brock Thompson has caught 39 passes for 447 yards and five touchdowns, while junior wide receiver Colin Duling has 25 receptions for 371 yards and six touchdowns. Sophomore running back Cecil Brimmage has 418 yards rushing on 69 carries with four touchdowns.

Senior linebacker Jake DeFauw leads the Blueboys in tackles with 45. Sophomore linebacker Carter Cox has 42 tackles with five tacklesfor-loss. Senior defensive back Eric Fisher has 33 tackles with three interceptions.

Illinois College is averaging 464.4 yards and 36.8 points per game, while opponents are averaging 489.0 yards and 38.2 points per game.

#### D is for Defense:

St. Norbert's defense held Monmouth to 40 points under their season average last week but still came away with a 10-3 loss to the Scots. The Green Knights face another high-octane offense this week in Illinois College.

St. Norbert is third nationally in rushing defense at the halfway point of the season, allowing just 48.8 yards per game. St. Thomas currently leads Division III at 40.0 yards per game, while Lycoming is second at 41.5 yards per game.

The Green Knights are ninth nationally at 3.8 sacks per game and 12th in scoring defense at 10.2 points per game. St. Norbert has scored 10 total points in its two losses this season. St. Norbert is 39th in the country in total defense, allowing only 280.4 yards per game.

Illinois College enters the game 10th in the country in passing offense at 313.2 yards per game and 18th in total offense at 464.6 yards

per game. Quarterback Michael Bates is fourth in the country in total offense at 345.8 yards per game.

#### Winning Ways:

In 2010, St. Norbert posted its 12th consecutive season with at least seven wins. Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just three times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005 and 7-3 campaigns in 2008 and 2010.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 400-270-20 in 78 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .594. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league best record of 158-33, a winning percentage of .827.

#### Irish Eyes Are Smiling:

St. Norbert's 2012 season opener will be Aug. 31 against John Carroll (Ohio) in Dublin, Ireland. For more information on the trip, go to http://www.snc.edu/athletics/football/ireland2012.html

The St. Norbert traveling party will attend the Notre Dame-Navy game played the next day at Aviva Stadium in Dublin.

#### **Quick Hitters:**

- \* St. Norbert is ninth in the Midwest Conference in scoring offense at 22.6 points per game. The Green Knights' pace of 226 points for the season would be their lowest total since scoring 194 points in 1996.
- \* St. Norbert is 177-11 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 109-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
- \* During Jim Purtill's 13-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 59 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 27-2 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.
