Game Overview:

St. Norbert College will attempt to snap a two-game losing streak when it hosts Carroll University for Homecoming at Schneider Stadium. The Green Knights are currently in a three-way tie for fourth place, while the Pioneers are tied for second place.

Broadcast:

The game will be broadcast live on WACY-TV 32 with Ted Stefaniak and John Maino on the call. WACY is available to Time Warner Cable customers in Northeast Wisconsin on Channel 13.

The game will also be videostreamed online on www.nmtvsports.com with Tim Derozier on the call.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Carroll 24-8 in the all-time series, which began in 1935. The 24 wins are the second-most for the Green Knights against an opponent trailing the 25 all-time wins against Lake Forest College. The Green Knights are 15-3 in the series since Carroll joined the Midwest Conference in 1992. St. Norbert has won 14 straight games in the series, starting in 1996.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 110-24 in his 13th season in De Pere.

Carroll coach Mark Krzykowski (Carroll, 1994) is 5-1 in his first season in Waukesha.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert dispatched Carroll 30-6 last Oct. 16 on Carroll's Schneider Stadium in Waukesha. The Green Knights led 20-6 at halftime and put the game away with 10 fourth-quarter points.

The Green Knights totaled 355 yards of total offense but were able to capitalize on outstanding field position, with an average start of their own 45-yard line. Joe Green caught five passes for 133 yards and one touchdown, while Rob Berger completed 14 of 25 passes for 248 yards and one touchdown.

Carroll was led by Joe Beckstrand's 82 yards rushing on 18 carries with one touchdown. The Pioneers threw for 109 yards and had just 178 yards of total offense. Carroll was also 1-for-11 on third-down conversions.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the weekend 3-3 overall and is 3-2 in the Midwest Conference following a 48-34 loss at Illinois College this past Saturday. The Green Knights and Blueboys were tied 21-21 at halftime before the host scored three third-quarter touchdowns to pull away.

Junior running back Austin Williams, who has missed the last two games due to injury, still holds the team rushing lead with 267 yards on 40 carries and four touchdowns. Sophomore running back Craig Fagan has 265 yards on 65 carries. Senior quarterback Mike Fabrizio, who threw for a career-high 311 yards against Illinois College, has completed 108 of 197 passes for 1,386 yards with 10 touchdowns and six interceptions. Junior wide receiver Joe Green has 40 receptions for 532 yards and five touchdowns.

Senior linebacker Ben Nantell leads the Green Knights in tackles with 46. He also has five passes defensed, 9.5 tackles for loss and four sacks. Freshman defensive back Justin Johnson has 35 tackles and a team-high four interceptions. Junior defensive back Josh Vanden Heuvel is third on the squad in tackles with 31.

St. Norbert is averaging 409.7 yards and 24.5 points per game, while opponents are netting 325.2 yards and 16.5 points per game.

About the Pioneers:

Carroll enters the game with a 5-1 overall record and in a tie for second place with Illinois College at 4-1 in the Midwest Conference. The Pioneers have won their last four games, including a 67-17 rout of Lawrence at home this past Saturday. Carroll's lone loss this season came 34-27 on Sept. 10 at Illinois College.

Senior running back Joe Beckstrand leads the Pioneers and is second in the Midwest Conference in rushing with 620 yards on 99 carries and five touchdowns. Sophomore quarterback Ryan Young paces the Pioneers in passing with 1,081 having completed 95 of 153 passes for 10 touchdowns and seven interceptions. Senior wide receiver Nate Soddy has caught 21 passes for 375 yards and eight touchdowns.

Senior linebacker Mike Dziewit is second in the Midwest Conference in tackles with 62, and has 10 tackles for loss and seven sacks with two interceptions. Senior defensive lineman Josh Zank has 37 tackles with 11.5 tackles for loss and also has seven sacks. The Pioneers' defense leads the Midwest Conference with 22 quarterback sacks.

Carroll is averaging 408.2 yards and 37.0 points per game, while opponents are averaging 297.0 yards and 19.8 points per game. Carroll's yardage allowed per game is the best in the Midwest Conference.

Happy Homecomings:

St. Norbert's Homecomings have typically given alumni a cause to celebrate, with the Green Knights going 52-24-1 in the Fall Classics. Last season, St. Norbert beat Grinnell 58-14 in heavy rain for its homecoming victory.

The Green Knights have enjoyed great Homecoming success since joining the Midwest Conference for

football in 1984, going 24-3. St. Norbert has won 19 of its last 20 Homecoming contests. Since 1984, St. Norbert has beaten Ripon for Homecoming on seven different occasions. The only MWC schools to spoil Homecoming was the Univ. of Chicago in 1985 (7-6 loss), Beloit in 1990 (16-10 loss) and Grinnell in 1998 (49-28 loss).

St. Norbert head coach Jim Purtill is 12-0 on Homecoming.

Winning Ways:

Sitting at 3-3 overall, the Green Knights will need to win their last four games to win at least seven games for the 13th consecutive year. Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just three times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005, 7-3 campaigns in 2008 and 7-4 in 2010.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 400-271-20 in 78 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .593. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league best record of 158-34, a winning percentage of .823.

Irish Eyes Are Smiling:

St. Norbert's 2012 season opener will be Aug. 31 against John Carroll (Ohio) in Dublin, Ireland. For more information on the trip, go to <http://www.snc.edu/athletics/football/ireland2012.html>

The St. Norbert traveling party will attend the Notre Dame-Navy game played the next day at Aviva Stadium in Dublin.

Quick Hitters:

* - St. Norbert is 177-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 109-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.

* - During Jim Purtill's 13-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 59 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 27-2 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.
