Game Overview:

St. Norbert opens the 2012 Midwest Conference slate with a home game against Knox. The Green Knights are looking for their first Midwest Conference title since winning the league championship during the 2010 season.

Broadcast:

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 16-2 series lead over Knox. The Green Knights have won the last 13 meetings with the Prairie Fire, with Knox's last win coming in a 21-19 triumph in 1998 in Galesburg, Ill.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert topped Knox 43-7 last Sept. 17 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights outgained the Prairie Fire 531-154, and had 249 rushing yards. Mike Fabrizio completed 20 of 30 passes for 282 yards and four touchdowns for the Green Knights. Joe Green caught nine passes for 98 yards and two touchdowns.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 114-25 in his 14th season in De Pere.

Knox coach Chad Eisele (Knox, 1993) is 1-20 in his third season in Galesburg. Eisele went 31-20 in five years at Lake Forest from 2000 to 2004 and 1-9 in one season at Minnesota State-Moorhead in 2005 to give him a career mark of 33-49 in nine seasons.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the Knox game at 0-1 overall after suffering a 40-3 loss to John Carroll last Friday at Donnybrook Stadium in Dublin, Ireland. It was the first NCAA Division III regular-season game played in Europe since the 1992 season.

St. Norbert was led offensively by senior running back Austin Williams, who gained 43 yards on 14 carries. Sophomore quarterback James Tringali got the start against John Carroll and completed 12 of 25 passes for 48 yards and one interception. Senior wide receiver Joe Green caught four passes for 35 yards.

Junior defensive back Anthony Parker had a team-high eight tackles against John Carroll. Senior defensive back Josh Vanden Heuvel added seven tackles, all unassisted, while senior defensive back Austin Arts had five tackles and one pass defensed. Senior linebacker Adam Nitsche made four tackles and snared one interception.

St. Norbert gained 90 yards of total offense and seven first downs against John Carroll, while the Blue Streaks put up 513 yards and 20 first downs.

About the Prairie Fire:

Knox enters the St. Norbert game at 0-1 overall. The Prairie Fire, which has lost 15 consecutive games, dropped a 62-55 shootout with Eureka this past Saturday in Galesburg, Ill. Eureka quarterback Sam Durley completed 34 of 52 passes for a NCAA all-divisions record 736 yards in addition to five touchdowns.

Junior running back Derek Mortensen rushed 32 times for 140 yards and three touchdowns. Junior quarterback Drew Diaz completed 8 of 17 passes for 169 yards and one touchdown with two interceptions, and also rushed eight times for 68 yards. Junior wide receiver Dustin Armstrong caught five passes for 116 yards and one touchdown.

Senior linebacker Mike Hendrick led the Knox defense with 12 tackles, including one quarterback sack. Senior defensive back Jonas Mack had 10 tackles with one pass defensed. Senior linebacker John Bass and junior linebacker Tom Discher both had eight tackles apiece.

Knox gained 469 yards of total offense and had 22 first downs against Eureka. The Prairie Fire allowed Eureka to gain 821 yards and 38 first downs - with 31 first downs coming via the air.

Opener Observations:

St. Norbert is 24-3 all-time in its first Midwest Conference game of the season.

The Green Knights had won 19 consecutive league openers dating back to 1991 before Beloit tipped St. Norbert 34-31 in 2010.

St. Norbert's only other losses in a league opener came in a 17-13 set-back to Cornell on Sept. 27, 1986 and a 33-32 loss to Monmouth on Sept. 22, 1990.

The Green Knights have never lost a conference opener at home, going 15-0 in those games.

Green, Green:

Senior wide receiver Joe Green has a chance to move up the career receptions list with a productive day this weekend.

Green enters the Knox game with 120 career receptions, tying him for fourth on the all-time St. Norbert career list with Steve Heim (1982-84). Current wide receivers coach Todd Bierowski (1991-94) sits in third with 122 career receptions, while Greg Rotherham (1974-77) sits in second place with 124 catches. Mike Whitehouse (1986-89) is the career leader with 230 catches.

Green is also one touchdown reception away from becoming the third player in St. Norbert history to post 20 career touchdown receptions. Green trails just Whitehouse (37) and Judd O'Connell (23, 2006-07) on the career list.

Green has 1,862 career receiving yards, and needs just 138 to become the fifth player in school history to amass 2,000 career yards. O'Connell is fourth on the list with 2,158.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is seeking its 14th consecutive season with at least seven wins.

Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just four times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005, 7-3 campaigns in 2008 and 2011, and 7-4 in 2010.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 404-272-20 in 79 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .595. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 162-34, a winning percentage of .827.

Quick Hitters:

- * Sophomore kicker Randy Hill made his first collegiate field goal attempt when he connected on a 39yarder for St. Norbert's only points last Friday against John Carroll.
- * St. Norbert had just one penalty in the John Carroll game, a five-yard infraction.
- * St. Norbert is 180-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 110-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
- * During Jim Purtill's 13-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 61 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 29-2 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.
