Game Overview:

St. Norbert faces a key game in the Midwest Conference race when it hosts Carroll at Schneider Stadium. Both teams are 2-0 in the league this season. As part of SNC Day, admission to the game is free.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Carroll 25-8 in the all-time series, which began in 1935. The 25 wins are the second-most for the Green Knights against an opponent trailing the 26 all-time wins against Lake Forest College. The Green Knights are 16-3 in the series since Carroll joined the Midwest Conference in 1992. St. Norbert has won 15 straight games in the series, starting in 1996.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert scored on a touchdown in every quarter as the Green Knights went on to top Carroll 28-7 last Oct. 15 at a windy and blustery Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The win was St. Norbert's 15th in a row against the Pioneers.

Mike Fabrizio completed 12 of 26 passes for 128 yards and four touch-

downs. Logan Krueger caught five passes for 76 yards with touchdown receptions of 49, 4 and 5 yards. Craig Fagan rushed 19 times for 112 yards for St. Norbert.

Ryan Young completed 14 of 33 passes for 95 yards for Carroll. Joe Beckstrand rushed 20 times for 89 yards and one touchdown.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 116-25 in his 14th season in De Pere. He is 108-10 all-time in Midwest Conference games and is 12-0 all-time against Carroll.

Carroll coach Mark Krzykowski (Carroll, 1994) is 10-3 in his second season in Waukesha. He is 0-1 all-time against St. Norbert.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert eked out a thrilling 35-31 win last Saturday at archrival Ripon. The Green Knights' Austin Williams scored the game-winning touchdown on a 1-yard run with 12 seconds remaining to move the Green Knights to 2-1 overall and 2-0 in the Midwest Conference.

Williams, a senior running back, holds the team rushing lead with 217 yards on 52 attempts and two touchdowns. Freshman running back Brad Boockmeier has 66 yards rushing and two touchdowns on 12 attempts. Sophomore quarterback James Tringali has completed 42 of 74 passes for 528 yards with five touchdowns and six interceptions. Senior wide receiver Joe Green has 14 receptions for 214 yards and three touchdowns.

Senior defensive lineman Petr Bohacek is this week's MWC Defensive Player of the Week after posting 15 tackles against Ripon. Bohacek has a team-high 23 tackles with three quarterback sacks. Senior linebacker Tobias Cole has 19 tackles. Sophomore linebacker Zach Klarkowski, junior linebacker Nick Keller and senior defensive back Josh Vanden Heuvel all have 14 tackles apiece.

St. Norbert is averaging 23.0 points and 276.7 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are

allowing opponents 30.3 points and 408.3 yards per game.

About the Pioneers:

Carroll enters the St. Norbert game with a 3-0 overall record and a 2-0 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Pioneers beat Lakeland 24-17 on Sept. 1, Ripon 30-24 on Sept. 8 and topped Knox 48-6 this past Saturday. Carroll is looking for its first 4-0 start since finishing 8-1 in 1992.

Freshman running back Daniel Arden leads Carroll in rushing with 152 yards on 30 attempts. Sophomore running back Lamont Williams has 148 yards rushing on 22 carries with four touchdowns, while sophomore running back Casey Legan has 102 yards rushing on 22 carries with two touchdowns. Sophomore quarterback Justin Butterfield has completed 49 of 84 passes for 704 yards and seven touchdowns with two interceptions. Junior wide receiver Tyler Ostrander has been Butterfield's top target with 21 receptions for 353 yards and four touchdowns.

Senior linebacker Steven Korus leads the Pioneers in tackles with 30. Senior defensive back Neal Layng has 21 stops and one interceptions, while sophomore linebacker Michael Sahli has 18 tackles with one interception.

Carroll is averaging 34.0 points and 381.3 yards per game. Defensively, the Pioneers are allowing 15.7 points and 237.3 yards per game.

Streak Snippets:

St. Norbert's 15-game winning streak in the series against Carroll matches the school record for the most consecutive wins against a single opponent.

St. Norbert also topped Lake Forest 15 straight times from 1987 to 2001.

The Green Knights began their long string of wins over the Pioneers with a 27-0 win in 1995 in Waukesha. St. Norbert has won every year since, except for 2001 when the game scheduled for Sept. 15 was cancelled following the Sept.

St. Norbert has had a few close shaves in its winning streak with Carroll, but has managed to pull every game out. Dan Luedtke's successful dive for the pylon on a two-point conversion in double overtime ended a thrilling 18-17 win at Minahan Stadium in 1997. Another two-point conversion by St. Norbert set up by a Carroll penalty led to a 36-35 win in 2004, and the Green Knights got a late interception to seal a 26-24 win in 2006.

In 2008, Bryan Stoppenbach's 6-yard run with 1:35 left led to a 20-17 Homecoming win at Minahan Stadium, and the next year St. Norbert trailed 20-0 at halftime at Carroll before rallying to a 28-20 win.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is seeking its 14th consecutive season with at least seven wins.

Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just four times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005, 7-3 campaigns in 2008 and 2011, and 7-4 in 2010.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 406-272-20 in 79 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .596. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 164-34, a winning percentage of .828.

Quick Hitters:

* - St. Norbert is 182-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 110-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.

* - During Jim Purtill's 14-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 61 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 29-2 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.
