Game Overview:

The 700th game in St. Norbert football history is also the Green Knights' 200th official game in the Midwest Conference, and it's an important one. St. Norbert travels to West Central Illinois to face Monmouth, in a matchup where the winner has gone on to win the MWC title in each of the last nine seasons.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 20-6 series lead over Monmouth in a series that began in 1975. The Green Knights have won 11 of the last 15 games in the series, but Monmouth has won four of the last seven meetings. St. Norbert is 10-3 at Monmouth in the series. The Green Knights claimed a decisive 48-2 win in their last trip to Monmouth in 2010.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert dropped a 10-3 heartbreaker to Monmouth last Oct. 1 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights and Fighting Scots slugged it out to a 3-3 tie for most of the game until Monmouth's Trey Yocum broke loose on a 46-yard touchdown run for the decisive score with just 1:09 left in the game.

The Green Knights had the ball for 36:14 and outgained Monmouth 357-

333 but had four red-zone opportunities result in just three points. Joe Green had eight receptions for 120 yards, and Craig Fagan rushed 32 times for 103 yards for St. Norbert.

Monmouth's Alex Tanney, currently on injured reserve with the Kansas City Chiefs, completed 27 of 46 passes for 253 yards and one interception. Mike Blodgett caught nine passes for 101 yards for the Scots.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 117-25 in his 14th season in De Pere. He is 109-10 all-time in Midwest Conference games and is 9-4 all-time against Monmouth.

Monmouth coach Steve Bell (Bemidji State, 1991) is 96-33 in his 13th season in Monmouth. He is 4-8 all-time against St. Norbert.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert pulled out a thrilling 28-21 overtime win over Carroll this past Saturday at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights' 16th straight win over the Pioneers moved the Green Knights to 3-1 overall and 3-0 in the Midwest Conference.

Senior running back Austin Williams keeps the team rushing lead with 272 yards on 67 attempts and two touchdowns. Freshman running back Brad Boockmeier has 98 yards rushing and two touchdowns on 22 attempts, and had a key 38-yard reception in the win over Carroll. Sophomore quarterback James Tringali has completed 62 of 111 passes for 754 yards with eight touchdowns and six interceptions. Senior wide receiver Joe Green has 22 receptions for 318 yards and four touchdowns.

Senior defensive lineman Petr Bohacek has a team-high 25 tackles with four quarterback sacks. Junior defensive back Anthony Parker is this week's MWC Defensive Player of the Week after posting 11 tackles with two interceptions against Carroll. Parker is second on the squad with 23 tackles. Senior linebacker Tobias Cole and senior

defensive back Josh Vanden Heuvel are tied for third on the team with 20 tackles apiece.

St. Norbert is averaging 24.3 points and 283.5 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing opponents 28.0 points and 377.5 yards per game.

About the Fighting Scots:

Monmouth enters the St. Norbert game, which is its home opener, with a 2-1 overall record and is 2-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Scots are coming off a 31-28 win at Cornell this past Saturday. Monmouth opened its season with a 33-3 loss at Coe on Sept. 1 and topped Beloit 31-14 on Sept. 8.

Junior running back Trey Yocum leads the Scots' ground game with 361 yards on 69 carries with four touchdowns. Junior quarterback Brik Wedekind has completed 40 of 67 passes for 455 yards with three touchdowns and one interception. Sophomore running back/wide receiver Michael Buehne has a team-high 16 receptions for 159 yards and one touchdown, and has rushed 12 times for 58 yards.

Freshman linebacker Jordan Kalk leads Monmouth in tackles with 33, and also has two tackles-for-loss. Senior defensive back Ryan Flannigan is second with 24 tackles and has recovered two fumbles. Junior linebacker Patrick Sheets has 22 tackles with a team-high three passes defended.

Monmouth is averaging 21.7 points and 324.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Scots are allowing 25.0 points and 398.0 yards per game.

Overtime Observations:

St. Norbert's 28-21 overtime win over Carroll this past Saturday was the first game in Schneider Stadium history that needed extra time.

Jim Purtill is 4-0 all-time in overtime games, including the Carroll won. St. Norbert rallied from a 31-9 second-half deficit to beat Grinnell 43-40 on Oct. 23, 1999. The Green Knights then claimed their only NCAA Division III Playoffs victory to date with a 26-20 double-over-

time win over Simpson at Minahan Stadium. The Green Knights topped Wartburg 42-35 in an overtime thriller on Sept. 5, 2009 at Minahan Stadium.

St. Norbert has won five consecutive overtime games dating back to 1997, and is 6-2 all-time when needing extra time. The Green Knights are 5-1 at home all-time in overtime games.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is seeking its 14th consecutive season with at least seven wins.

Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just four times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005, 7-3 campaigns in 2008 and 2011, and 7-4 in 2010.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 407-272-20 in 79 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .597. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 165-34, a winning percentage of .829.

Quick Hitters:

* - In the last two games a Tanney has not started at quarterback for Monmouth against St. Norbert, the Green Knights won by scores of 48-0 in 2006 and 48-2 in 2010. Jared Mundt started in 2006 for Monmouth, which had eight turnovers in that game. Brik Wedekind, currently Monmouth's starter, got the nod to start in the game two years ago.

* - St. Norbert is 182-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 110-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.

* - During Jim Purtill's 14-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 61 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 29-2 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.
