Game Overview:

The scenario for St. Norbert this week is simple: win and clinch a berth in the NCAA Division III Playoffs as well as the outright Midwest Conference championship. The Green Knights clinched a share of the league title last week after beating Grinnell while Illinois College lost to Cornell.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 27-2 lead in the all-time series, which began in 1984. St. Norbert had won 15 straight games in the series before the Foresters shocked St. Norbert 17-0 in the 2002 season finale at Minahan Stadium, and the Green Knights have won 10 straight since. The Foresters' only other win in the series came in 1986.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert topped Lake Forest 20-10 on Nov. 10, 2012 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The victory vaulted the Green Knights to a share of the MWC title with the Foresters and a berth in the NCAA Division III Playoffs. The Green Knights led 17-0 after the first quarter and held on from there.

The Green Knights posted 176 yards of total offense but cashed in on three short fields to score two touchdowns and a field goal in the first quar-

ter. James Tringali completed 13 of 21 passes for 110 yards and one touchdown, while Joe Green caught eight passes for 75 yards and one score.

Lake Forest finished with 241 yards of total offense, with 78 coming on its final possession. The Foresters, who rushed for seven net yards, got 234 yards passing from Pete Scaffidi, who completed 25 of 47 passes. Austin Sobey caught eight passes for 113 yards.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 130-28 in his 15th season in De Pere. He is 13-1 all-time against Lake Forest.

Lake Forest coach Jim Catanzaro (Greenville, 2000) is 22-27 in his fifth season in Lake Forest. He is 0-4 all-time against St. Norbert.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert heads into the Lake Forest game at 8-1 overall and 8-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights, who have won 13 consecutive conference games, have clinched a share of their 15th MWC title and with a win earns a berth in the NCAA Division III Playoffs.

Sophomore running back Brad Boockmeier holds the team rushing lead with 704 yards on 139 attempts with seven touchdowns, and also has 24 receptions for 199 yards and one touchdown. Senior wide receiver Brian Fliess has 25 catches for 452 yards and four touchdowns. Junior quarterback James Tringali has completed 122 of 219 passes for 1,597 yards with 10 touchdowns and five interceptions.

Senior linebacker Brian Feltz leads the Green Knights with 59 tackles and also has 8.0 tackles for loss. Junior linebacker Matt Petersilka has 49 tackles, 11.5 tackles-for-loss, 6.5 quarterback sacks, four pass breakups and two interceptions. Junior linebacker Zach Klarkowski has 40 tackles with five tackles-for-loss. Senior defensive lineman Peter Latham posted three quarterback sacks against Grinnell to give him five on the season, second only to Petersilka's total.

St. Norbert is averaging 26.2 points and 320.3 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 12.8 points and 293.3 yards per game.

About the Foresters:

Lake Forest enters the St. Norbert game at 7-2 overall and 6-2 in the Midwest Conference. The Foresters, who were idle this past weekend, last played Nov. 2 and lost 27-14 to Ripon. Lake Forest's other loss this season came in a 55-7 setback on Oct. 12 at Illinois College.

Freshman running back Charlie Quinn leads the Foresters in rushing with 385 yards and two touchdowns in 97 attempts. Senior running back Alec Howe has 254 yards and two touchdowns on 79 attempts. Senior quarterback Mike Lewis has completed 119 of 242 passes for 1,273 yards and 11 touchdowns with 13 interceptions. Senior wide receiver Mike Peters leads the Foresters in receptions with 39 for 333 yards and three touchdowns. Sophomore wide receiver George Vidas has 23 catches for 296 yards and three touchdowns.

Senior linebacker John Dillon and senior linebacker Jordan Cruz share the team lead in tackles with 63. Junior linebacker John Preston has 62 tackles, while senior defensive lineman Jake Rotkvich has 42 tackles with 6.5 quarterback sacks.

Lake Forest is averaging 17.4 points and 248.4 yards per game. Defensively, the Foresters are allowing 16.6 points and 293.7 yards per game.

Winning Ways:

With its 52-17 win over Beloit on Nov. 2, St. Norbert has won at least seven games in a season for the 15th consecutive season. The Green Knights also clinched a share of their 11th MWC title in the last 15 years with a 23-0 win over Grinnell on Nov. 9.

Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just five times -8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005, 8-3 in 2012, 7-3 campaigns in 2008 and 2011, and 7-4 in 2010.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 420-275-20 in 80 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .601. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 178-35, a winning percentage of .836.

St. Norbert has won 123 of its last 134 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .918.

Hat Trick:

St. Norbert junior kicker Randy Hill registered a career-high three field goals in this past Saturday's 23-0 win over Grinnell at Schneider Stadium

Hill connected on a 32-yard field goal in the first quarter, and then had field goals of 22 and 24 yards in the fourth quarter to seal the win.

Hill's performance marked just the third time in St. Norbert history a kicker has converted three field goals in the same game. Chris Griffin nailed a school-record four field goals in a 47-29 win over Knox on Sept. 28, 2002. Karl Zacharias kicked three in a 23-7 win over the University of Chicago on Nov. 7, 1987.

Quick Hitters:

- * Grinnell finished with minus-13 yards rushing against St. Norbert on Saturday. It was the best mark for the Green Knights since holding Beloit to minus-16 yards rushing on Sept. 10, 2011.
- *- The Green Knights had 69 yards passing against Grinnell. It was the fewest for St. Norbert in a win since getting 66 yards passing in a 14-11 win over Grinnell on Sept. 12, 2009.
- * St. Norbert is 187-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 113-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
- * During Jim Purtill's 15-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 65 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 36 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 33-2 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.
