Game Overview:

St. Norbert makes its 11th appearance in the NCAA Division III Playoffs when it travels to southern Wisconsin to face No. 5-ranked UW-Whitewater. The winner of the game will face the Franklin-Washington (Mo.) winner in the second round.

The Series:

Saturday's game marks the 30th meeting between St. Norbert and UW-Whitewater in a series begun in 1932. Whitewater leads the overall series 17-9-3, and is 12-4-1 all-time at home in the series. The Warhawks have won four straight games in the series since a 6-3 St. Norbert win on Sept. 11, 1976 in De Pere.

Last Meeting:

UW-Whitewater topped St. Norbert 59-17 in a first-round NCAA Division III Playoffs game on Nov. 18, 2006 at Perkins Stadium in Whitewater. The Warhawks scored on their first seven possessions of the game to take a 45-10 halftime lead. Whitewater outgained St. Norbert 601-151 in total offense.

Cody Craig completed 10 of 21 passes for 105 yards with one touchdown and one interception to lead the Green Knights. Judd O'Connell caught three passes for 50 yards, including a 40-yard touchdown reception from Craig.

Justin Jacobs completed 12 of 19 passes for 274 yards with four touchdowns to lead the Warhawks. Derek Stanley caught five passes for 95 yards and three touchdowns, while Brady Pittz rushed 21 times for 87 yards and two touchdowns.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 130-29 in his 15th season in De Pere.

UW-Whitewater coach Lance Leipold (UW-Whitewater, 1986) is 89-6 in his seventh season in Whitewater.

NCAA Playoff History:

St. Norbert is making its 11th NCAA Division III Playoffs appearance and its 10th in the last 15 years. St. Norbert is 1-10 all-time in the playoffs, beating Simpson (Iowa) 26-20 in double overtime in 2003's first round before losing at eventual national champion St. John's (Minn.) 38-13. St. Norbert has lost to Central (Iowa) in 1989 and 2000 (55-7 and 29-14, respectively), Augustana (Ill.) in 1999 (39-32), St. John's in 2001 (27-20), UW-La Crosse (37-23) in 2004, UW-Whitewater (59-17) in 2006, UW-Eau Claire (24-20) in 2007, North Central (57-7) in 2010 and St. Thomas (48-17) in 2012.

UW-Whitewater is also making its 11th NCAA Division III Playoffs appearance, and its eighth in the last nine years. The Warhawks are 33-6 all-time and won national championships in 2007, 2009, 2010 and 2011.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the NCAA Division III Playoffs at 8-2 overall. The Green Knights won their 15th Midwest Conference title at 8-1, claiming the championship outright.

Sophomore running back Brad Boockmeier holds the team rushing lead with 751 yards on 152 attempts with seven touchdowns, and also has a team-high 29 receptions for 223 yards and one touchdown. Senior wide receiver Brian Fliess has 26 catches for 458 yards and four touchdowns. Junior quarterback James Tringali has completed 135 of 253 passes for 1,710 yards with 10 touchdowns and six interceptions.

Senior linebacker Brian Feltz leads the Green Knights with 64 tackles and also has 8.0 tackles for loss. Junior linebacker Matt

Petersilka has 51 tackles, 12.5 tackles-for-loss, 7.5 quarterback sacks, four pass breakups and two interceptions. Junior linebacker Zach Klarkowski has 46 tackles with six tackles-for-loss.

St. Norbert is averaging 23.9 points and 306.4 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 14.6 points and 297.4 yards per game.

About the Warhawks:

UW-Whitewater enters the NCAA Division III Playoffs at 10-0 overall. The Warhawks, ranked No. 5 by D3football.com, won the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference championship at 7-0. Whitewater topped UW-River Falls 43-6 this past Saturday in Whitewater to wrap up an unbeaten regular season.

Sophomore running back Jordan Ratliffe leads the Warhawks in rushing with 841 yards on 139 carries and five touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Jake Kumerow has 50 receptions for 865 yards with 11 touchdowns. Junior quarterback Matt Behrendt has completed 191 of 298 passes for 2,076 yards with 26 touchdowns against one interception.

Senior linebacker Cole Klotz leads the Warhawks in tackles with 70. Senior linebacker Josh Williams has 50 tackles, while senior linebacker Kyle Wismer has 44 stops with nine going for a loss.

Whitewater is averaging 39.3 points and 413.8 yards per game. Defensively, the Warhawks are allowing 8.0 points and 221.6 yards per game.

State School Snippets:

Saturday's game against UW-Whitewater marks the 164th time in St. Norbert football history the Green Knights will battle a University of Wisconsin System school on the gridiron. It is the first meeting since the Green Knights lost a first-round NCAA Division III playoff game 24-20 to UW-Eau Claire in 2007.

St. Norbert has played all eight current football-playing members Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference, as well as former members UW-Milwaukee and UW-Superior, which dropped football in the early 1990s. St. Norbert owns at least one win over all eight current WIAC members and is 80-75-8 all-time against the league.

Oshkosh 37 times (14-20-3 all-time), the most meetings with any St. Norbert opponent. The Green Knights have also battled UW-Whitewater 29 times (9-17-3), UW-Stevens Point 26 times (13-12-1), UW-Milwaukee 23 times (19-4) and UW-La Crosse on 21 occasions (13-7-1).

St. Norbert has opened its season 14 times against a WIAC foe since 1988. The Green Knights played Stevens Point in 1988 and 1989, and then had a 10-year series with Oshkosh from 1990 to 1999 before playing Whitewater to open the 2004 and 2005 seasons.

The Green Knights have lost 17 consecutive games against the WIAC since a 25-7 win over UW-Platteville on Nov. 5, 1983 in De Pere.

Winning Ways:

With its 52-17 win over Beloit on Nov. 2, St. Norbert won at least seven games in a season for the 15th consecutive season. The Green Knights also clinched a share of their 11th MWC title in the last 15 years with a 23-0 win over Grinnell on Nov. 9.

Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just five times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005, 8-3 in 2012, 7-3 campaigns in 2008 and 2011, and 7-4 in 2010.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 420-276-20 in 80 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .601. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 178-36, a winning percentage of .832.

St. Norbert has won 123 of its last 135 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .911.

Quick Hitters:

* - UW-Whitewater sophomore defensive back Ryan Winske is the nephew of St. Norbert baseball coach Tom Winske.

* - St. Norbert is 187-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 113-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.

* - During Jim Purtill's 15-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 65 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 36 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 33-2 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.
