Game Overview:

St. Norbert opens the 2013 Midwest Conference schedule with a road trip to west central Illinois to face Knox. The Green Knights are looking to repeat as Midwest Conference champions and gain their 11th MWC title in 15 seasons and their 15th league crown overall.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 17-2 lead over Knox in a series dating back to the 1988 season. The Green Knights have won the last 14 meetings with the Prairie Fire, with Knox's last win coming in a 21-19 triumph in 1998 in Galesburg, Ill. St. Norbert, which holds a 751-297 scoring edge in the series, is 7-2 all-time on the road in the series.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert topped Knox 31-20 last Sept. 8 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights held a 17-14 lead after three quarters but scored two fourth-quarter touchdowns to pull away.

Austin Williams rushed 24 times for 101 yards for St. Norbert, while James Tringali completed 20 of 33 passes for 258 yards with three touchdowns and four interceptions. Joe Green hauled in six passes for 65 yards and two touchdowns.

Derek Mortensen led Knox on the ground with 69 yards on 20 carries. Drew Diaz completed 11 of 22 passes for 119 yards with two touchdowns and two interceptions. Dustin Armstrong caught seven passes for 77 yards and one touchdown.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 122-28 in his 15th season in De Pere. He is 14-0 all-time against Knox.

Knox coach Damon Tomeo (Pomona-Pitzer, 1999) is 0-1 in his first season in Galesbug. Tomeo was 14-30 in four seasons at Minnesota State-Moorhead from 2006-09 for a total mark of 14-31.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the Knox game 0-1 overall after dropping a 41-0 decision to John Carroll this past Saturday at Toyota Park in Bridgeview, Ill.

Sophomore running back Brad Boockmeier led St. Norbert on the ground with 29 carries in 11 attempts. Senior running back Craig Fagan added 24 yards in five attempts. Junior quarterback James Tringali completed 9 of 25 passes for 68 yards. Boockmeier was the leading receiver with three catches for 10 yards, while senior wide receiver Michael Heim caught two asses for 20 yards.

Senior defensive back Anthony Parker led St. Norbert in tackles with 11. Senior defensive back Joe Schlueter finished with seven tackles, including one for a loss. Sophomore defensive back Matt Fargo had five tackles and three passes defensed.

St. Norbert totaled 114 yards against John Carroll. Defensively, the Green Knights allowed the Blue Streaks 664 yards.

About the Prairie Fire:

Knox enters Saturday's game with an 0-1 overall record. The Prairie Fire dropped a 21-17 decision on the road to Eureka in the Abraham Lincoln Bowl series between the two schools.

Senior running back Derek Mortensen leads the Prairie Fire on the ground with 115 yards rushing on 28 carries with one touchdown. Sophomore quarterback Luke Oosterbaan completed 9 of 20 passes for 140 yards with one touchdown and one interception. Sophomore wide receiver Ilir Emini caught four passes for 100 yards and one touchdown, while senior tight end Neal Moon caught three passes for 33 yards.

Sophomore linebacker Mitch Weissenhofer led Knox in tackles with 13. Senior linebacker Tom Discher had 11 tackles, while junior defensive lineman Austin Finley had eight tackles with three going for a loss.

Knox posted 300 yards of total offense against Eureka. Defensively, the Prairie Fire allowed Eureka 274 yards.

Opener Observations:

St. Norbert is 25-3 all-time in its first Midwest Conference game of the season.

The Green Knights had won 19 consecutive league openers dating back to 1991 before Beloit tipped St. Norbert 34-31 in 2010.

St. Norbert's only other losses in a league opener came in a 17-13 set-back to Cornell on Sept. 27, 1986 and a 33-32 loss to Monmouth on Sept. 22, 1990.

Punting Patter:

St. Norbert had a rare game where all 13 of its possessions against John Carroll ended with a punt.

Junior punter Kevin Krueger set a pair of school record with 13 punts and 489 punting yards. Six of Krueger's punts were fair caught and four were placed inside the John Carroll 20-yard line. Krueger finished with a gross punting average of 37.6 yards and a net average of 33.9 yards.

The old record for punts in a game was held by Steve Wilmet, who punted 12 times in a 7-0 loss to Hillsdale on Nov. 15, 1968. The old punting yardage standard was held by Bob Forstrom, who punted 10

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is attempting to win at least seven games for the 15th consecutive year in 2013.

Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just five times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005, 8-3 in 2012, 7-3 campaigns in 2008 and 2011, and 7-4 in 2010.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 412-275-20 in 79 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .597. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 170-35, a winning percentage of .829.

Streak Stoppers:

St. Norbert has lost consecutive games in the same season only three times during Jim Purtill's 15-year tenure.

The Green Knights last lost consecutive games on Oct. 1-8, 2011 when they lost to Monmouth 10-3 and Illinois College 48-34, respectively.

St. Norbert dropped back-to-back games on Nov. 10-17, 2001 to Illinois College (41-40) and St. John's (27-20) and on Sept. 4-11, 2010 to St. Thomas (40-7) and Beloit (34-31).

St. Norbert has not had an overall three-game losing streak since Oct. 11-25, 1997, when it fell to Lawrence (27-24), Ripon (16-14) and Beloit (21-20/ot).

Quick Hitters:

- * St. Norbert is 184-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 112-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
- * During Jim Purtill's 15-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 63 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 31-2 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.
