Game Overview:

It's Ripon Week at St. Norbert as the Green Knights look to remain unbeaten in Midwest Conference action. St. Norbert and Ripon both won its conference openers last week. It is also SNC Day in De Pere, and admission to the game is free.

Broadcast:

The game will be broadcast live regionally on WACY-TV 32 with Dean Leisgang and John Burton on the call. This is the third consecutive season WACY has live broadcast St. Norbert home football games.

The Series:

St. Norbert owns a 23-10 lead over Ripon in a hotly contested series that dates back to 1979. St. Norbert has won 13 of the last 14 meetings in the series, the Green Knights' lone blemish a 19-7 Ripon win at Ingalls Field in 2008. The Green Knights are 12-4 all-time at home in the series, and hold an all-time 987-653 scoring edge in the rivalry.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert rallied late to tip Ripon 35-31 last Sept. 15 in a thriller at Ingalls Field in Ripon. St. Norbert led 21-0 before Ripon took leads of 24-21 and 31-28, the latter coming with 1:28 remaining. A 50-yard Brian Fliess kickoff return set up the game-winning St. Norbert drive, with Austin

Williams' 1-yard plunge with 12 seconds remaining proving the difference.

Williams led St. Norbert on the ground with 73 yards on 14 carries and two touchdowns. James Tringali was 10-for-16 for 222 yards with two touchdowns and one interception. Joe Green caught four passes for 114 yards and one touchdown.

Ripon, which had possession for a whopping 41 minutes 45 seconds, ran 85 plays to St. Norbert's 40. Tom Sawyer had 103 yards rushing and two touchdowns on 21 carries, while Connor Greenwald had 26 carries for 93 yards and one touchdown. Sawyer completed 10 of 13 passes for 105 yards with one touchdown and one interception.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 123-28 in his 15th season in De Pere. He is 13-1 all-time against Ripon.

Ripon coach Ron Ernst (Nebraska Wesleyan, 1980) is 145-72 in his 23rd season in Ripon. He is 6-16 all-time against St. Norbert.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the Ripon game 1-1 overall and 1-0 in the Midwest Conference after topping Knox 42-7 last Saturday at the Knosher Bowl in Galesburg, Ill.

Sophomore running back Brad Boockmeier leads the St. Norbert ground game with 196 yards rushing on 27 carries with three touchdowns. Junior quarterback James Tringali has completed 19 of 39 passes for 231 yards and one touchdown with no interceptions. Senior wide receiver Michael Heim has caught five passes for 131 yards and one touchdown.

Senior linebacker Brian Feltz and senior defensive back Anthony Parker share the team lead in tackles with 12. Senior linebacker Nick Keller has 11 tackles, while senior defensive back Joe Schlueter has 10 tackles and returned an interception 85 yards for a touchdown against Knox.

St. Norbert is averaging 21.0

points and 284.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 24.0 points and 480.0 yards per game.

About the Red Hawks:

Ripon enters the St. Norbert game with a 2-0 overall record and a 1-0 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Red Hawks opened the season with a 31-24 win at Wisconsin Lutheran on Sept. 7 before pulling out a big 22-20 win over Carroll last week, a game that saw them trail 17-0 in the first half.

Sophomore running back Connor Greenwald leads the Red Hawks in rushing with 196 yards and 46 attempts and one touchdown. Senior quarterback Tom Sawyer has 139 yards rushing on 46 carries and three touchdowns, and has completed 18 of 34 passes for 300 yards with one touchdown and no interceptions. Senior wide receiver Tommy Zak has nine catches for 131 yards, both team highs.

Senior defensive back Luke Morgan has a team-high 18 tackles, while junior defensive back Logan Will has 13 tackles.

Ripon is averaging 26.5 points and 424.5 yards per game. Defensively, the Red Hawks are allowing 22.0 points and 359.0 yards per game.

Bookin' Boockmeier:

St. Norbert sophomore running back Brad Boockmeier had a career day in last Saturday's 42-7 win over Knox. Boockmeier finished with 167 yards rushing on 16 carries and three touchdowns, a 10.4 yards per carry average.

Boockmeier scored the game's first points on a 54-yard touchdown run, and added scoring jaunts of 10 and 5 yards in the second quarter.

Boockmeier's total marked just the fourth time in school history a back has rushed for at least 167 yards on 16 carries or less, and it was the first time it occurred since 1978.

Joe Hoerning was the last to accomplish the feat, rushing for 170 yards and three touchdowns on 11 carries in a 56-0 win over

Maranatha Baptist on Sept. 16, 1978 at Minahan Stadium. The only other two times it happened were by Norm Jarock, whose No. 36 is retired by the college. Jarock did it in back-to-back games, getting 178 yards on 16 carries and two touchdowns against UW-Platteville on Nov. 3, 1956 and 175 yards on 16 carries and one touchdown against UW-La Crosse on Nov. 10, 1956..

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is attempting to win at least seven games for the 15th consecutive year in 2013.

Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just five times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005, 8-3 in 2012, 7-3 campaigns in 2008 and 2011, and 7-4 in 2010.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 413-275-20 in 80 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .597. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 171-35, a winning percentage of .830.

Quick Hitters:

* - Senior wide receiver Michael Heim's 111 yards receiving against Knox was a career high. It marked only the sixth time in St. Norbert history a player had at least 111 yards receiving on three receptions or less. The last time it occurred came on Sept. 30, 2000 when Brandon Spaulding caught three passes for 189 yards - all going for touchdowns - in a 54-31 win over Ripon at Minahan Stadium.

* - St. Norbert is 185-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 112-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.

* - During Jim Purtill's 15-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 64 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 32-2 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.
