Game Overview:

St. Norbert faces another critical game when it travels to Waukesha to face Carroll. The Green Knights are currently tied with Lake Forest atop the MWC standings with a 2-0 league mark, while Carroll is 1-1 in conference action.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Carroll 26-8 in the all-time series, which began in 1935. The 26 wins are the second-most for the Green Knights against an opponent trailing the 27 all-time wins against Lake Forest College. The Green Knights are 17-3 in the series since Carroll joined the Midwest Conference in 1992. St. Norbert has won 16 straight games in the series, dating back to 1996, the most consecutive wins for the Green Knights over any opponent.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert pulled out a thrilling 28-21 overtime win over Carroll last Sept. 22 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights scored on the first play of overtime on a 25-yard touchdown pass from James Tringali to Joe Green. The St. Norbert defense then forced a Carroll fumble on the Pioneers' possession to end the game.

Tringali led St. Norbert with 226 yards passing, completing 20 of 37 pass-

es with three touchdowns. Green caught eight passes for 104 yards and one touchdown. Austin Williams rushed for 55 yards on 15 carries and one touchdown.

Lamont Williams led Carroll on the ground with 101 yards rushing and three touchdowns on 23 carries. Justin Butterfield completed 13 of 27 passes for 110 yards and two interceptions. Tyler Ostrander caught six passes for 50 yards.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 124-28 in his 15th season in De Pere. He is 13-0 all-time against Carroll.

Carroll coach Mark Krzykowski (Carroll, 1994) is 17-6 in his third season in Waukesha. He is 0-2 all-time against St. Norbert.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the Carroll game with a 2-1 overall record and a 2-0 ledger in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights are coming off a convincing 33-6 win over Ripon this past Saturday in De Pere.

Sophomore running back Brad Boockmeier leads the Green Knights' rushing attack with 273 yards on 52 carries. Boockmeier also leads the team in receptions with nine for 96 yards and one touchdown. Junior quarterback James Tringali has completed 35 of 60 passes for 422 yards and four touchdowns with no interceptions.

Senior linebacker Brian Feltz owns the team lead in tackles with 23. Senior defensive back Anthony Parker, junior defensive back Joe Lorenz, junior linebacker Zach Klarkowski and junior linebacker Matt Petersilka all have 14 tackles apiece. Petersilka has two quarterback sacks and four tackles-for-loss.

St. Norbert is averaging 25.0 points and 284.3 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 18.0 points and 390.0 yards per game.

About the Pioneers:

Carroll enters Saturday's game with a 2-1 overall record and a 1-1

mark in the Midwest Conference. The Pioneers rebounded from a 22-20 loss at Ripon on Sept. 14 with a 24-14 win over Knox at home this past Saturday.

Sophomore running back Daniel Arden leads Carroll on the ground with 259 yards rushing on 56 carries and four touchdowns. Junior running back Lamont Williams made his first appearance this season against Knox, rushing for 192 yards on 25 carries and two touchdowns. Sophomore quarterback Tyler Shovanec has completed 22 of 43 passes for 224 yards and two touchdowns. Sophomore quarterback Cody DiGiovanni has completed 7 of 15 passes for 124 yards and one touchdown with one interception. Senior wide receiver Andy Laurin has five catches for 24 yards.

Junior linebacker Michael Sahli leads Carroll defensively with 32 tackles, including five tackles-for-loss and one quarterback sack. Senior defensive back Marcus Radue has 24 tackles, while senior linebacker Mark Spratte has 23 stops.

Carroll is averaging 23.7 points and 355.3 yards per game. Defensively, the Pioneers are allowing 18.0 points and 335.7 yards per game.

Red Zone Report:

St. Norbert's defense is currently ranked 11th in red zone defense the latest NCAA Division III statistical rankings. The Green Knights have allowed just three scores in eight opponent red-zone opportunities through three games.

St. Norbert has allowed one touchdown and two field goals from the red zone this season. Ripon scored a passing touchdown in the third quarter of last Saturday's 33-6 loss. John Carroll got a pair of field goals in its 41-0 win on Sept. 7.

The Green Knights are also one of 27 teams so far in Division III to have scored on all of their red-zone chance. St. Norbert is 7-for-7 thus far, scoring five rushing touchdowns and two passing touchdowns.

Turnover Talk:

St. Norbert has not lost possession this season via fumble or interception, one of seven teams in Division III to do so.

St. Norbert joins Susquehanna as the only two teams to have played three games and committed a turnover. Illinois College and Willamette have played two games, while Catholic, Colby and Wesleyan have played one game without a turnover.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is attempting to win at least seven games for the 15th consecutive year in 2013.

Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just five times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005, 8-3 in 2012, 7-3 campaigns in 2008 and 2011, and 7-4 in 2010.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 414-275-20 in 80 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .598. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 172-35, a winning percentage of .831.

Quick Hitters:

* - St. Norbert is second in the Midwest Conference in kickoff coverage. Junior kicker Randy Hill's kickoffs are averaging 61.3 yards, with a MWC-high four touchbacks. St. Norbert's net on kickoffs of 42.6 yards trails only Knox's net of 43.9 yards.

* - St. Norbert is 186-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 112-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.

* - During Jim Purtill's 15-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 64 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 35 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 32-2 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.
