Game Overview:

For the third consecutive week, St. Norbert faces another long-time rival in the Midwest Conference football race when it entertains Monmouth Saturday at Schneider Stadium. The two schools have combined to capture at least a share of every MWC title since 1999.

Broadcast:

The game will be broadcast live regionally on WACY-TV 32 with Dean Leisgang and John Burton on the call. This is the third consecutive season WACY has live broadcast St. Norbert home football games. WACY-TV can be found on most Time Warner Cable analog systems in the area on Channel 83

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 20-7 series lead over Monmouth in a series that began in 1975. The Green Knights have won 11 of the last 16 games in the series, but Monmouth has won five of the last eight meetings. The Fighting Scots have won their last two visits to De Pere - a 31-22 decision on Oct. 11, 2008 and by a 10-3 score on Oct. 1, 2011.

With the Midwest Conference moving to divisional play starting in 2014, this is Monmouth's last scheduled regular-season visit to De Pere until 2019.

Last Meeting:

Monmouth trounced St. Norbert 31-9 on Sept. 29, 2012 at Zorn Memorial Stadium in Monmouth, Ill. The Green Knights could not recover from a 24-point Monmouth second quarter, which included 17 points in the last 3:18 of the half.

St. Norbert's James Tringali completed 13 of 32 passes for 160 yards with one touchdown and three interceptions. Austin Williams rushed 17 times for 28 yards.

Monmouth rushed for 258 yards on 59 carries, with Trey Yocum gaining 154 yards on 26 carries with two touchdowns. Brik Wedekind completed 10 of 17 passes for 90 yards with one touchdown and one interception.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 125-28 in his 15th season in De Pere. He is 9-5 all-time against Monmouth.

Monmouth coach Steve Bell (Bemidji State, 1991) is 100-39 in his 14th season in Monmouth. He is 5-8 all-time against St. Norbert.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the Monmouth game with a 3-1 overall record and a 3-0 mark in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights are coming off an impressive 27-7 road win at Carroll this past Saturday to remain unbeaten in league action.

Sophomore running back Brad Boockmeier picked up his second 100-yard rushing game of the season with 111 yards against Carroll. Boockmeier has gained 384 yards on 81 attempts with six touchdowns, and also leads the Green Knights in receiving with 16 catches for 151 yards and one touchdown. Junior quarterback James Tringali has completed 58 of 94 passes for 648 yards with four touchdowns and no interceptions.

Senior linebacker Brian Feltz leads the Green Knights with 26 tackles. Junior linebacker Matt Petersilka has 20 tackles, five tackles-for-loss and three quarterback sacks. Senior defensive back Joe Schlueter has 18 tackles with three tackles-for-loss.

St. Norbert is averaging 25.5 points and 291.5 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 15.3 points and 343.8 yards per game.

About the Fighting Scots:

Monmouth enters its matchup with St. Norbert at 1-2 overall and 1-1 in the Midwest Conference. The Scots were upended at home last Saturday, dropping a 23-20 decision to Cornell after holding a 20-3 lead in the third quarter.

Senior running back Trey Yocum leads the Scots offense, rushing 79 times for 482 yards and five touchdowns. Senior quarterback Brik Wedekind has completed 46 of 85 passes for 680 yards with five touchdowns and three interceptions. Senior wide receiver Austin Peterson has caught 16 passes for 176 yards and one touchdowns, while freshman wide receiver Cole Krynicki has 10 receptions for 205 yards and one touchdown.

Senior linebacker Bryan Mesik leads Monmouth in tackles with 24. Senior linebacker Narvie Cooper has 23 tackles, while junior defensive lineman Jack Porter has 18 tackles and four tackles-for-loss.

Monmouth is averaging 33.7 points and 443.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Scots are allowing 20.0 points and 377.3 yards per game.

Turnover Talk:

St. Norbert has not lost possession this season via fumble or interception, the only team in Division III to do so this season.

The Green Knights' streak of games without a turnover is even more impressive when you consider St. Norbert is one of only three schools in the top 20 of fewest turnovers to have already played four games this season.

UW-Whitewater, Illinois College, Westfield State, Colby and Benedictine all have just one turnover this season.

ranked 11th in red zone defense the latest NCAA Division III statistical rankings. The Green Knights have allowed just four scores in nine opponent red-zone opportunities through four games (44.4 percent).

St. Norbert has allowed two touchdowns and two field goals from the red zone this season. Ripon and Carroll are the only two teams to have scored touchdowns from the red zone on the Green Knights' this season.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is attempting to win at least seven games for the 15th consecutive year in 2013.

Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just five times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005, 8-3 in 2012, 7-3 campaigns in 2008 and 2011, and 7-4 in 2010.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 415-275-20 in 80 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .599. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 173-35, a winning percentage of .832.

Quick Hitters:

- * In Midwest Conference games only, St. Norbert's defense is allowing just 237.0 yards per game tops in the league. The Green Knights are also allowing just 96.3 yards passing per game in league games.
- * St. Norbert is 10-for-11 in red zone scoring chances in conference play. The Green Knights have scored 10 touchdowns and were stopped on downs once when inside their opponents' 20-yard line.
- * St. Norbert is 186-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 112-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
- * During Jim Purtill's 15-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 65 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 36 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 33-2 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.
