#### Game Overview:

St. Norbert hosts Cornell in the Green Knights' annual Homecoming game Saturday at Schneider Stadium. The Green Knights and Rams are two of the four remaining unbeaten teams in conference action entering play this weekend.

#### Broadcast:

The game will be broadcast live regionally on WACY-TV 32 with Dean Leisgang and John Burton on the call. This is the third consecutive season WACY has live broadcast St. Norbert home football games. WACY-TV can be found on most Time Warner Cable analog systems in the area on Channel 83.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert and Cornell have met only five times, with St. Norbert holding a 3-2 lead in a series started in 1986. The home team had won the first four games until St. Norbert secured a 20-16 win in Mount Vernon, Iowa last season.

The Rams won the first matchup 17-13 at Ash Park in Mount Vernon on Sept. 27, 1986. The Green Knights returned the favor the following season with a 52-14 rout at Minahan Stadium in De Pere. Cornell won 28-15 in Mount Vernon in 1992 en route to a 10-0 season. The Green Knights then won in De Pere on Sept. 25, 1993 by a 40-26 count.

### Last Meeting:

St. Norbert topped Cornell 20-16 last Oct. 6 at Ash Park in Mount Vernon, Iowa. The Green Knights led 20-7 after three quarters, but a Rams rally in the fourth quarter fell short.

The Green Knights posted 319 yards of total offense. James Tringali completed 19 of 29 passes for 195 yards with one touchdown and one interception. Austin Williams rushed 21 times for 72 yards.

Cornell had 359 yards of offense, with 324 coming via Juan Flores' passing. He completed 23 of 41 passes for two touchdowns but also had three interceptions. Ra'Shad Green caught 10 passes for 116 yards.

### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 126-28 in his 15th season in De Pere. He is 1-0 all-time against Cornell.

Cornell coach Vince Brautigam (Iowa Wesleyan, 1988) is 10-24 in his fourth season in Mount Vernon. Including eight seasons at Dubuque and 11 seasons at Mount Senario, Brautigam is 99-130 in 23 years as a collegiate head coach.

### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the Cornell game at 4-1 overall and 4-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights scored the last 20 points of the game to top Monmouth 22-14 last Saturday at Schneider Stadium to remain unbeaten in league play.

Sophomore running back Brad Boockmeier earned his third 100-yard rushing game in four weeks with 168 yards on 28 carries against Monmouth. Boockmeier has gained 552 yards on 109 attempts with six touchdowns, and also shares the lead in receiving with 18 catches for 157 yards and one touchdown. Junior wide receiver Mark Villers has caught 18 passes for 281 yards. Junior quarterback James Tringali has completed 75 of 123 passes for 958 yards with five touchdowns and no interceptions.

Senior linebacker Brian Feltz

leads the Green Knights with 31 tackles. Junior linebacker Matt Petersilka has 27 tackles, 6.5 tackles-for-loss, 3.5 quarterback sacks, three pass breakups and two interceptions. Senior defensive backs Joe Schlueter and Anthony Parker each have 22 tackles.

St. Norbert is averaging 24.8 points and 333.8 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 15.0 points and 324.8 yards per game.

### About the Rams:

Cornell enters its game with St. Norbert at 3-1 overall and 3-0 in the MWC. The Rams spanked Beloit 58-24 at home this past Saturday. Cornell, with its only loss Sept. 14 in a 42-7 setback at Coe, is off to its best start since opening the 2001 season 5-0.

Senior quarterback Juan Flores leads the Cornell offense, completed 75 of 109 passes for 959 yards with six touchdowns and seven interceptions. Flores is second on the team in rushing with 202 yards on 40 carries and three touchdowns. Sophomore running back Ethan Thompson leads the Rams in rushing with 363 yards on 63 carries and four touchdowns. Sophomore wide receiver Ben Knake has caught 22 passes for 262 yards and one touchdown.

Junior linebacker Alex Latow leads the Rams in tackles with 47. Senior linebacker Geoffrey Miller has 39 tackles, while senior linebacker Jeremy Demlow has 38 tackles and a team-high seven tackles-for-loss.

Cornell is averaging 33.2 points and 451.1 yards per game. Defensively, the Rams are allowing 25.0 points and 397.5 yards per game.

### Triple Threat:

St. Norbert reached three lofty offensive statistical plateaus for just the second time in school history in Saturday's 22-14 win over Monmouth at Schneider Stadium.

It marked the first time in 38 years St. Norbert had a 150-yard rusher, a 300-yard passer and a 100-

yard receiver in the same game. Brad Boockmeier rushed for 168 yards, James Tringali threw for 310 yards and Mark Villers had 129 yards receiving.

The first time it happened came on Oct. 18, 1975 in a 55-40 Green Knights' win at Monmouth. Mike Rydzon rushed for 157 yards, Remy Stephenson passed for 367 yards and Greg Benesh had 284 receiving yards and five touchdowns - both of which are still St. Norbert records.

### Happy Homecomings:

St. Norbert's Homecomings have typically given alumni a cause to celebrate, with the Green Knights going 54-24-1 in the fall classics. Last season, St. Norbert beat Lawrence 79-7 for its Homecoming victory.

The Green Knights have enjoyed great Homecoming success since joining the Midwest Conference for football in 1984, going 26-3. St. Norbert has won 21 of its last 22 Homecoming contests. Since 1984, St. Norbert has beaten Ripon for Homecoming on seven different occasions. The only MWC schools to spoil Homecoming was the Univ. of Chicago in 1985 (7-6 loss), Beloit in 1990 (16-10 loss) and Grinnell in 1998 (49-28 loss).

St. Norbert head coach Jim Purtill is 14-0 on Homecoming.

### Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is attempting to win at least seven games for the 15th consecutive year in 2013.

Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just five times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005, 8-3 in 2012, 7-3 campaigns in 2008 and 2011, and 7-4 in 2010.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 416-275-20 in 80 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .599. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 174-35, a winning percentage of .833.
