Game Overview:

St. Norbert travels down Highway 41 to face Fox River Valley-rival Lawrence. The Green Knights have won 10 consecutive Midwest Conference games dating back to last season. In a scheduling quirk, this game is a non-conference game for Lawrence.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 24-9-2 lead over Lawrence in a series begun in 1932. The Green Knights have won the last 15 meetings with the Vikings since a 27-24 Lawrence win in 1997 at Minahan Stadium in De Pere. Lawrence claims only a 24-13-2 deficit in the series, but four games were played before St. Norbert began sponsoring full varsity intercollegiate football in 1931.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert handled Lawrence 79-7 last Oct. 13 in a game played in a driving rain at Schneider Stadium in De Pere, setting a school record for points in a game. The Green Knights led 35-0 at the end of the first quarter and 45-0 at halftime.

The Green Knights totaled 366 yards rushing and 551 yards of total

offense. Thirteen different St. Norbert backs had a rushing attempt, led by Austin Williams' 172 yards rushing with three touchdowns on 18 carries. James Tringali completed 7 of 13 passes for 126 yards and one touchdown.

Lawrence was held to 120 yards of total offense and had three first downs.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 127-28 in his 15th season in De Pere. He is 14-0 all-time against Lawrence.

Lawrence coach Mike Barthelmess (Principia, 1983) is 2-13 in his second season in Appleton. Barthelmess was 15-61-1 in nine years as head coach at Principia.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the Lawrence game 5-1 overall and 5-0 in the Midwest Conference, a half-game ahead of Illinois College. The Green Knights scored two fourth-quarter touchdowns to top Cornell 20-17 this past Saturday at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. St. Norbert has won its last 10 Midwest Conference games.

Sophomore running back Brad Boockmeier holds the team rushing lead with 577 yards on 118 attempts with six touchdowns, and also shares has 19 receptions for 170 yards and one touchdown. Junior wide receiver Mark Villers leads the squad in receiving with 21 catches for 302 yards. Junior quarterback James Tringali has completed 91 of 152 passes for 1,144 yards with six touchdowns and no interceptions.

Senior linebacker Brian Feltz leads the Green Knights with 40 tackles. Junior linebacker Matt Petersilka, this week's Midwest Conference Defensive Player of the Week, has 38 tackles, 8.5 tackles-for-loss, 4.5 quarterback sacks, four pass breakups and two interceptions. Junior linebacker Zach Klarkowski is third on the club with 27 tackles.

St. Norbert is averaging 24.0 points and 317.3 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are

allowing 15.3 points and 324.5 yards per game.

About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters its game against St. Norbert with an 0-5 mark overall and in the Midwest Conference. The Vikings are coming off a 48-14 loss at Carroll this past Saturday.

Senior quarterback Luke Barthelmess has completed 87 of 163 passes for 903 yards with five touchdowns and five interceptions. He is also the Vikings' leading rusher with 454 yards on 106 carries with one touchdown. Sophomore running back Dalton Sendelbach has rushed 56 times for 217 yards. Junior wide receiver Tyler Lueck paces the Vikings in receptions with 17 for 128 yards.

Senior linebacker Andy Paider leads the Vikings defensively with 34 tackles, including a whopping 13 tackles-for-loss, and two quarterback sacks. Sophomore defensive back Andy Eichhorst has 32 tackles and the Vikings' lone interception this season. Junior linebacker Brandon Taylor has 30 tackles this season.

Lawrence is averaging 13.6 points and 350.4 yards per game. Defensively, the Vikings are allowing 34.2 points and 385.0 yards per game.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is two wins away from winning at least seven games in a season for the 15th consecutive season.

Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just five times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005, 8-3 in 2012, 7-3 campaigns in 2008 and 2011, and 7-4 in 2010.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 417-275-20 in 80 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .600. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 175-35, a winning percentage of .833.

St. Norbert has won 120 of its last 132 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .909.

Defensive Dope:

In Midwest Conference play this season, St. Norbert is allowing a scant 10.5 points per game. The Green Knights have not allowed more than 17 points in a conference game this season.

The Green Knights also have the best defense in regard to yards allowed, yielding just 256.6 yards per game. St. Norbert opponents have scored just six touchdowns in five MWC games. Monmouth and Illinois College have allowed seven touchdowns, but both the Scots and Blueboys have played just four league contests.

St. Norbert is also a whopping plus-10 in turnover margin. The Green Knights have 14 takeaways (including 10 interceptions), while turning the ball over just four times in MWC action. Illinois College and Monmouth are both plus-5.

Quick Hitters:

* - St. Norbert's kickoff coverage is tops in the MWC, with a net of 42.0 yards per kickoff. The Green Knights have the most touchbacks in the conference with 10.

* - St. Norbert and Lawrence are the bottom two teams in the MWC in net punting. The Green Knights are tenth at 27.3 yards per punt, while the Vikings are 11th at 24.2 yards per boot.

* - Lawrence leads the NCAA Division III in fewest penalties (2.4) and fewest penalty yards (19.0) per game, and is second in average time of possession (37:31).

* - St. Norbert is 186-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 112-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.

* - During Jim Purtill's 15-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 65 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 36 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 33-2 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.
