Game Overview:

St. Norbert attempts to keep pace in the Midwest Conference championship race when it hosts in-state foe Beloit at Schneider Stadium. The Green Knights carry a six-game overall winning streak into the game, and are deadlocked atop the MWC standings with Illinois College at 6-0.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Beloit in an all-time series 19-10 dating back to 1984, and has won 13 of the last 14 meetings.. The Green Knights had won 11 straight games in the series before Beloit claimed a 34-31 win in Beloit in 2010.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert topped Beloit 42-7 on Oct. 27, 2012 at Strong Stadium in Beloit. The Green Knights led 28-0 after the first quarter and 42-0 at half-time en route to the win. St. Norbert scored touchdowns on its first six possessions.

The Green Knights totaled 414 yards of total offense, with 302 of it coming on the ground. Austin Williams rushed for 136 yards on 12 carries and one touchdown, while Brad Boockmeier rushed 14 times for 98 yards and

two touchdowns. James Tringali completed 7 of 15 passes for 81 yards and one touchdown.

Beloit's Lucas McLeran completed 15 of 29 passes for 149 yards and one interception. Dillon Hess caught six passes for 69 yards, while Lukeson Versulien had 38 yards rushing and one touchdown on seven carries.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 128-28 in his 15th season in De Pere. He is 13-1 all-time against Beloit.

Beloit coach Chris Brann (West Virginia Wesleyan, 1991) is 21-57 in his eighth season in Beloit. Coupled with a 9-41 mark over five years at Carleton, Brann has an all-time record of 30-98.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the Beloit game at 6-1 overall and 6-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights, who have won their last 11 Midwest Conference games, were idle this past weekend. St. Norbert last played on Oct. 19, when it topped Lawrence 17-6 at Banta Bowl in Appleton.

Sophomore running back Brad Boockmeier, who did not play against Lawrence, holds the team rushing lead with 577 yards on 118 attempts with six touchdowns, and also has 19 receptions for 170 yards and one touchdown. Junior wide receiver Mark Villers leads the squad in receiving with 21 catches for 302 yards, while senior Brian Fliess has 20 catches for 300 yards and three touchdowns. Junior quarterback James Tringali has completed 104 of 179 passes for 1,321 yards with seven touchdowns and one interception.

Senior linebacker Brian Feltz leads the Green Knights with 49 tackles. Junior linebacker Matt Petersilka has 38 tackles, 8.5 tackles-for-loss, 4.5 quarterback sacks, four pass breakups and two interceptions. Senior defensive backs Anthony Parker and Joe Schlueter each have 30 tackles, with Parker posting a team-high three intercep-

tions.

St. Norbert is averaging 23.0 points and 317.6 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 14.0 points and 316.4 yards per game.

About the Buccaneers:

Beloit enters the St. Norbert game at 1-7 overall and 1-6 in the Midwest Conference. The Buccaneers are coming off a 40-14 loss at Ripon this past Saturday. Beloit posted its lone win on Sept. 21 with a 38-21 triumph over Lawrence.

The Buccaneers are led offensively by freshman running back Mason Dixon. Dixon has rushed for nine touchdowns on 167 carries for 1,083 yards, the fifth highest aggregate total in Division III entering this weekend. Freshman quarterback Kameron Sallee has completed 26 of 65 passes for 399 yards with five touchdowns and three interceptions, and has rushed for 260 yards on 76 carries. Sophomore wide receiver Michael Nolden has 18 catches for 288 yards and five touchdowns.

Junior linebacker Jake Fisher leads the Buccaneers in tackles with 56. Freshman linebacker Riley Pearson has 47 tackles, while junior defensive lineman Derell Carter has 44 tackles.

Beloit is averaging 16.9 points and 272.8 yards per game. Defensively, the Buccaneers are allowing 38.1 points and 448.1 yards per game.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is one win away from winning at least seven games in a season for the 15th consecutive season.

Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just five times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005, 8-3 in 2012, 7-3 campaigns in 2008 and 2011, and 7-4 in 2010.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 418-275-20 in 80 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .600. In Midwest Conference play, St.

Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 176-35, a winning percentage of .834.

St. Norbert has won 121 of its last 132 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .917.

Defensive Dope:

In Midwest Conference play this season, St. Norbert is allowing a meager 9.5 points per game. The Green Knights have not allowed more than 17 points in a conference game this season.

The Green Knights also have the best defense in regard to yards allowed, yielding just 258.5 yards per game. St. Norbert opponents have scored just seven touchdowns in six MWC games. Monmouth follows with 10 touchdowns yielded.

St. Norbert is also a whopping plus-10 in turnover margin. The Green Knights have 15 takeaways (including 12 interceptions), while turning the ball over just five times in MWC action.

Quick Hitters:

* - St. Norbert's 17-6 win over Lawrence was the Green Knights' lowest winning point total since a 14-11 triumph over Grinnell on Sept. 12, 2009. The Green Knights are 3-16 when scoring less than 20 points in a game under Jim Purtill. St. Norbert also topped Lake Forest 14-7 on Sept. 23, 2006.

* - St. Norbert's kickoff coverage is tops in the MWC, with a net of 42.0 yards per kickoff. The Green Knights have the most touchbacks in the conference with 11.

* - St. Norbert is 186-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 112-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.

* - During Jim Purtill's 15-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 65 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 36 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 33-2 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.
