Game Overview:

St. Norbert plays its final home game of the season when it hosts Grinnell at Schneider Stadium. The Green Knights remain tied with Illinois College atop the Midwest Conference standings, with the two teams not meeting this season.

Broadcast:

The game will be broadcast live regionally on WACY-TV 32 with Dean Leisgang and John Burton on the call. This is the third consecutive season WACY has live broadcast St. Norbert home football games. WACY-TV can be found on most Time Warner Cable analog systems in the area on Channel 83.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds an 18-1 lead in the all-time series, which began in 1986. Grinnell's only win in the series came in a 49-28 win in 1998 in De Pere, a year when the Pioneers went 10-0. The Green Knights have won the last 14 meetings in the series. In the six home games against Grinnell under Jim Purtill, St. Norbert has won by an average of 44.2 points per game.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert snaked out a 20-12 win over Grinnell on Nov. 3, 2012 at Rosenbloom Stadium in Grinnell, Iowa. The Pioneers led 12-7 after the

third quarter but St. Norbert scored two touchdowns in the final 15 minutes to claim victory.

James Tringali completed 16 of 25 passes for 202 yards with two touchdowns. Brad Boockmeier rushed 15 times for 101 yards, while Austin Williams had 75 yards on 24 carries.

Sam Poulos completed 15 of 36 passes for 127 yards for Grinnell. He also had a team-high 29 rushing yards despite being sacked six times.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Jim Purtill (Miami-Ohio, 1978) is 129-28 in his 15th season in De Pere. He is 14-0 all-time against Grinnell.

Grinnell coach Jeff Pedersen (Grinnell, 2002) is 15-23 in his fourth season in Grinnell. He is 0-3 all-time against St. Norbert

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters its game with Grinnell at 7-1 overall and 7-0 in the Midwest Conference. The Green Knights, who have won 12 consecutive MWC games, are coming off a 52-17 rout of Beloit in De Pere this past Saturday.

Sophomore running back Brad Boockmeier, who has not played in the last two games, continues to lead the team in rushing with 577 yards on 118 attempts with six touchdowns, and also has 19 receptions for 170 yards and one touchdown. Sophomore running back Brandon Carter is second on the team in rushing with 215 yards on 32 carries and two touchdowns after gaining 168 yards against Beloit. Senior wide receiver Brian Fliess has 23 catches for 430 yards and four touchdowns. Junior quarterback James Tringali has completed 112 of 197 passes for 1,528 yards with 10 touchdowns and three interceptions.

Senior linebacker Brian Feltz leads the Green Knights with 54 tackles and also has 7.5 tackles for loss. Junior linebacker Matt Petersilka has 43 tackles, 9.5 tacklesfor-loss, 4.5 quarterback sacks, four pass breakups and two interceptions. Senior defensive back Anthony Parker is third on the squad with 35 tackles, and also has a team-high four interceptions.

St. Norbert is averaging 26.6 points and 337.2 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 14.4 points and 311.8 yards per game.

About the Pioneers:

Grinnell enters the St. Norbert game at 2-6 overall and 2-5 in the Midwest Conference. The Pioneers are coming off a 24-21 win over Lawrence this past Saturday in Appleton, Grinnell's other win this season came on Sept. 28 when it beat Beloit 42-17.

Sophomore quarterback Sam Poulos paces the Grinnell offense, completed 123 of 221 passes for 1,435 yards with five touchdowns and four interceptions. Junior wide receiver Jacob Meixler has 44 receptions for 626 yards and two touchdowns, while junior wide receiver Jake O'Polka has 25 catches for 250 yards and three touchdowns. Freshman running back Jacob Bernholtz has a team-high 308 yards rushing on 85 attempts and seven touchdowns.

Junior linebacker David Ternes leads the Midwest Conference in tackles with 108. Senior defensive back Kevin Hwang has 69 tackles with four interceptions. Senior linebacker Jeremy Wiles has 68 total stops.

Grinnell is averaging 15.8 points and 267.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Pioneers are allowing 32.4 points and 461.5 yards per game.

Offensive Options:

St. Norbert has had three different running backs rush for at least 86 yards in a game this season.

Sophomore Brad Boockmeier has three 100-yard rushing games this season. He rushed for 168 yards in a 22-14 win over Monmouth on Oct. 5. Boockmeier had 167 yards and three touchdowns in a 42-7 win over Knox Oct. 5, and also had 111 yards and two touchdowns in a 27-7 win over Carroll on Sept. 28.

Sophomore Brandon Carter matched Boockmeier's highest output when he rushed for 168 yards and two touchdowns in a 52-17 win over Beloit on Nov. 2.

Junior Zach Broberg finished with 86 yards rushing and one touchdown in a 17-6 win at Lawrence on Oct. 19.

Winning Ways:

With its 52-17 win over Beloit on Nov. 2, St. Norbert has won at least seven games in a season for the 15th consecutive season.

Since Jim Purtill became head coach in 1999, St. Norbert has won as few as eight games just five times - 8-2 seasons in 2001 and 2005, 8-3 in 2012, 7-3 campaigns in 2008 and 2011, and 7-4 in 2010.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 419-275-20 in 80 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .601. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 177-35, a winning percentage of .835.

St. Norbert has won 122 of its last 133 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .917.

Quick Hitters:

- *-The Green Knights are allowing just 3.0 yards per rushing play, which is No. 1 in the MWC.
- * St. Norbert's kickoff coverage is tops in the MWC, with a net of 43.0 yards per kickoff up one full yard from last week. The Green Knights have the most touchbacks in the conference with 15.
- * St. Norbert is 187-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 113-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
- * During Jim Purtill's 15-year tenure as head coach, St. Norbert has scored 65 defensive and special teams touchdowns. Using available game records, research uncovered St. Norbert had scored just 36 defensive touchdowns from 1956 to 1998. Under Purtill, St. Norbert is 33-2 when scoring a defensive touchdown and has scored multiple defensive scores in a game eight different times.
