Game Overview:

St. Norbert and Cornell meet for the second time this season as the Green Knights and Rams meet to play for fifth place during the Midwest Conference Championship Weekend. The Green Knights placed third in the MWC North Division, while the Rams were third in the MWC South Division.

The Series:

St. Norbert and Cornell have met only six times, with St. Norbert holding a 4-3 lead in a series begun in 1986. The Rams are 3-1 all-time at home in the series, with St. Norbert's lone win at Ash Park coming in a 20-16 win on Oct. 6, 2012.

The two teams are scheduled to meet for the third time in 11 games next season on Oct. 3, 2015 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere.

Last Meeting:

Cornell rallied late for a 28-27 win over St. Norbert earlier this season on Oct. 4 at Ash Park in Mount Vernon, Iowa. The Green Knights held leads of 21-7 and 27-14 before the Rams scored the game-winning touchdown with 28 seconds remaining on a Daniel Brown 5-yard run.

The Rams outgained the Green Knights 385-301 in total offense. Brown

completed 15 of 27 passes for 153 yards and two touchdowns while rushing 11 times for 52 yards to lead the Rams. Ben Knake caught 12 passes for 129 yards and one touchdown.

James Tringali paced the Green Knights with 198 yards passing, completing 16 of 28 passes with one touchdown and one interception. Elijah Fort rushed 20 times for 86 yards and one touchdown, while J.T. Crosby rushed eight times for 21 yards and two touchdowns.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Steve Opgenorth (Winona State, 2005) is 5-4 in his first season in De Pere.

Cornell coach Vince Brautigam (Iowa Wesleyan, 1988) is 19-29 in his fifth season in Mount Vernon. Including eight seasons at Dubuque and 11 seasons at Mount Senario, Brautigam is 108-135 in 24 years as a collegiate head coach.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert heads into its season finale with a 5-4 overall record. The Green Knights finished third in the Midwest Conference North Division with a 3-2 mark after falling to division champion Macalester 21-13 this past Saturday in De Pere.

Senior running back Zach Broberg enters the last game with the team rushing lead at 360 yards on 85 carries with five touchdowns. Freshman running back Elijah Fort has 334 yards on 84 carries and two touchdowns. Senior quarterback James Tringali has completed 112 of 198 passes for 1,204 yards with seven touchdowns and six interceptions. Sophomore wide receiver Zach Reeves has 35 receptions for 475 yards and three touchdowns, while freshman wide receiver Brett Olson has 29 catches for 394 yards and four touchdowns.

Senior linebacker Zach Klarkowski tops the Green Knights defensively with 86 tackles and also has 10.5 tackles-for-loss with four quarterback sacks. Senior linebacker Matt Petersilka has 72 tackles with 4 1/2 tackles-for-loss, while

sophomore defensive back Ryan Grandlic has 64 tackles. Senior defensive back Joe Lorenz has 53 stops and has a team-high nine passes defensed. Senior defensive lineman Austin Prusha has 50 tackles with 12 1/2 tackles for loss and five quarterback sacks.

St. Norbert is averaging 22.7 points and 297.4 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 21.6 points and 344.4 yards per game.

About the Rams:

Cornell enters the game with a 5-3 overall record. The Rams placed third in the Midwest Conference South Division with a 3-2 ledger following a 30-23 loss at division champion Illinois College this past Saturday.

Senior running back Preston Ritchie leads the Rams' ground game with 541 yards on 91 carries with six touchdowns. Freshman quarterback Daniel Brown has completed 101 of 187 passes for 1,223 yards with 12 touchdowns and six interceptions, and has also rushed for 532 yards on 98 carries and five touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Ben Knake has caught 62 passes for 712 yards and seven touchdowns.

Senior linebacker Alex Latow leads the Rams' defense with a total of 103 tackles, including 16 tacklesfor-loss and 7 1/2 quarterback sacks. Sophomore linebacker Maliek Ketchens has 62 tackles and three interceptions, while senior defensive back Aaron Welch has 57 tackles.

Cornell is averaging 31.4 points and 403.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Rams are allowing 27.3 points and 396.5 yards per game.

Twice Baked:

When St. Norbert takes the field at Cornell on Saturday, it will be playing an opponent twice in the same season - a rarity in Green Knight football annals.

The Green Knights have not faced the same opponent in one season in 80 years - going back to the infancy of the program in 1934. St. Norbert,

which began intercollegiate football in 1931, played UW-Oshkosh twice en route to a 1-4-2 finish. St. Norbert opened with a 0-0 tie against the Titans on Sept. 22, 1934 in De Pere, and then lost the return trip to Oshkosh 13-6 on Oct. 20.

St. Norbert and Oshkosh also met twice in 1933 - a 0-0 tie in Oshkosh and a 6-0 Oshkosh win in De Pere.

Those two instances are the only two times St. Norbert has faced an opponent twice in one season in program history until this year.

Cornell last played an opponent twice in one season in 1996 - beating Ripon 26-14 in the regular season before the Red Hawks countered with a 26-8 win in the MWC Championship Game.

Field Goal Facts:

St. Norbert's Randy Hill became just the second kicker in school history to boot at least 10 field goals in one season after making two in this past Saturday's game against Macalester.

Hill is 10-for-13 on field-goal attempts this season. He joins Bob Forstrom as the only other player to make at least that many, with Forstrom going 12-for-18 in 2004.

Hill, who has made his last nine field-goal attempts, is the St. Norbert career leader in field goals with 26.

Quick Hitters:

- *-St. Norbert scored a touchdown off a blocked punt for the first time in five years in this past Saturday's 21-13 loss to Macalester. Zach Klarkowski returned a punt blocked by Dan Egan 30 yards for a touchdown in the second quarter. The last blocked punt resulting in a St. Norbert touchdown came when Dustin Gresen fell on a blocked punt in the end zone in a 44-0 win over Beloit on Oct. 31, 2009 the last game ever played in Minahan Stadium.
- * St. Norbert is 189-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 114-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
