#### **Game Overview:**

St. Norbert travels to the Hawkeye State to face Cornell in the second of its two games against the South Division of the Midwest Conference this season. The matchup between the Green Knights and Rams is considered a non-conference game in the league standings.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert and Cornell have met only six times, with St. Norbert holding a 4-2 lead in a series started in 1986. The home team had won the first four games until St. Norbert won the last two meetings since Cornell's return to the Midwest Conference in 2012.

#### **Last Meeting:**

St. Norbert pulled out a pulsating 20-17 win over Cornell on Oct. 12, 2013 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The Rams held a 17-7 lead through three quarters before the Green Knights scored two fourth-quarter touchdowns to eke out the victory.

James Tringali scored on a 1-yard run early in the fourth quarter, and Tringali then found Michael Heim on an 11-yard touchdown pass with 8:33 to go to lift St. Norbert to the win. Tringali completed 16 of 29 passes for 186 yards and one score, while Craig Fagan rushed 17 times for 56 yards to

Cornell was led by Juan Flores, who completed 19 of 30 passes for 214 yards and one touchdown with four interceptions. Preston Ritchie led the Rams on the ground with 45 yards on 14 carries.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Steve Opgenorth (Winona State, 2005) is 2-1 in his first season in De Pere.

Cornell coach Vince Brautigam (Iowa Wesleyan, 1988) is 15-27 in his fifth season in Mount Vernon. Including eight seasons at Dubuque and 11 seasons at Mount Senario, Brautigam is 104-133 in 24 years as a collegiate head coach.

#### **About the Green Knights:**

St. Norbert enters its game at Cornell at 2-1 overall after beating Illinois College 32-27 this past Saturday in De Pere. The Green Knights trailed 27-6 entering the fourth quarter before closing the game with 26 unanswered points.

Senior quarterback James Tringali has completed 47 of 82 passes for 450 yards with four touchdowns and two interceptions. Freshman running back Elijah Fort has 120 yards rushing on 36 carries, while senior Zach Broberg has 101 rushing yards on 13 carries and two touchdowns. Sophomore wide receiver Zach Reeves has 15 receptions for three touchdowns, and freshman wide receiver Brett Olson has seven catches for 83 yards and one touchdown.

linebacker Senior Zach Klarkowski, this week's reigning Midwest Conference Defensive Player of the Week after a 16-tackle performance against Illinois College, has a team-high 31 tackles. He also has two tackles-for-loss and one quarterback sack. Senior defensive back Joe Lorenz has 24 tackles, while senior linebacker Matt Petersilka has 23 tackles. Senior defensive lineman Austin Prusha has 20 tackles along with a teamhigh eight tackles-for-loss and 4 1/2 quarterback sacks.

St. Norbert is averaging 24.7 points and 271.3 yards per game.

Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 30.3 points and 376.0 yards per game.

#### **About the Rams:**

Cornell enters the game with a 1-1 overall record. The Rams opened the season with a 50-21 home loss to archrival Coe on Sept. 13, and rebounded this past Saturday with a 43-24 win at Ripon.

Senior Kyle Stennes and freshman Daniel Brown split time at quarterback in the win over Ripon. On the season, Stennes is 28for-48 for 297 yards passing with one touchdown and one interception. Brown is 10-for-15 passing for 98 yards with three touchdowns and one interception, and has also rushed eight times for 69 yards. Senior running back Preston Ritchie has a team-high 205 rushing yards on 39 carries and two touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Ben Knake has 20 receptions for 173 yards and one touchdown. Knake is currently fifth in the Division III national statistical rankings in receptions per game.

Senior linebacker Alex Latow is the Rams' leading tackler with 26 stops, including 3 1/2 tackles-forloss and two quarterback sacks. Junior defensive back Kenny Smith has 19 tackles, while sophomore defensive back Maliek Ketchens has 17 tackles.

Cornell is averaging 32.0 points and 357.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Rams are allowing 37.0 points and 441.0 yards per game.

#### **Tringali Tidbits:**

St. Norbert senior quarterback James Tringali helped lead the Green Knights' fourth-quarter charge this past Saturday in a 32-27 win over Illinois College. St. Norbert scored four touchdowns in the final 14:31 of the game to score 26 unanswered points to erase a 27-6 deficit.

The comeback marked the fifth time in Tringali's tenure as the starting quarterback St. Norbert erased a deficit entering the fourth quarter to win a game.

back wins on the road during his sophomore season in 2012. The Green Knights trailed Ripon 24-21 entering the final quarter, and again 31-28, before scoring with 12 seconds to go to win 35-31. St. Norbert then trailed Grinnell 12-7 after three quarters before winning 20-12.

Last season, St. Norbert trailed Monmouth at home 14-12 before scoring 10 fourth-quarter points to win 22-14. The very next week, the Green Knights trailed Cornell 17-7 before winning 20-17.

Tringali owns an 18-7 record as the St. Norbert starting quarterback.

#### **Fourth Quarter Facts:**

Through three games this season St. Norbert has held a significant edge in the fourth quarter, a trend that will have to continue in order for the Green Knights to capture a 16th Midwest Conference title.

The Green Knights have outscored their opponents 32-3 through three games this season. St. Norbert outscored Carthage 6-0 in the season opener and Illinois College 26-0 this past Saturday.

North Central scored the only fourth-quarter points against St. Norbert this season on a 32-yard field goal by Dom Zavaglia.

#### Winning Ways:

In 2014, St. Norbert is looking for its 16th consecutive season with at least seven wins.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 422-278-20 in 81 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .600. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 178-36, a winning percentage of .832.

St. Norbert has won 123 of its last 135 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .911.

#### **Ouick Hitters:**

- \* St. Norbert is 188-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 113-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
- \* Senior defensive lineman Austin Prusha is seventh in Division III in quarterback sacks at 1.5 per game.
