#### **Game Overview:**

St. Norbert plays at home for the second consecutive week as the Green Knights attempt to win back-to-back games for the first time this year when they host Beloit.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert leads Beloit in an all-time series 20-10 dating back to 1984, and has won 14 of the last 15 meetings.. The Green Knights had won 11 straight games in the series before Beloit claimed a 34-31 win in Beloit in 2010. St. Norbert has won seven consecutive home games in the series since 2000.

#### **Last Meeting:**

St. Norbert defeated Beloit 52-17 on Nov. 2, 2013 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights jumped out to a 21-0 lead just 11 minutes into the game and cruised from there.

The Green Knights outgained the Buccaneers 475-279 in total offense. Brandon Carter rushed 21 times for 168 yards and two touchdowns. Brian Fliess, who had 224 all-purpose yards, caught three passes for 130 yards

and one touchdown. James Tringali completed 8 of 18 passes for 207 yards with three touchdowns and two interceptions.

Beloit was led by Mason Dixon, who rushed 28 times for 107 yards. Evan Phillips completed 12 of 24 passes for 125 yards and one touchdown. Luke McLeran caught five passes for 21 yards and one touchdown.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Steve Opgenorth (Winona State, 2005) is 3-3 in his first season in De Pere.

Beloit coach Seth Duerr (Wooster, 2000) is 2-4 in his first season in Beloit.

#### About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the Beloit contest at 3-3 overall and 1-1 in the Midwest Conference North Division. The Green Knights, who posted a season-high 384 yards of total offense, won on Homecoming for the 16th consecutive year with a 13-10 win over Ripon.

Senior running back Zach Broberg took over the team lead in rushing with 98 yards rushing against Ripon. Broberg has 265 yards this season on 55 carries with three touchdowns. Sophomore quarterback J.T. Crosby made his first collegiate start and posted 286 yards of total offense (175 passing, 111 rushing). Crosby is the thirdleading rusher this season with 175 yards on 33 carries and four touchdowns, and has completed 10 of 27 passes overall for 175 yards. Sophomore wide receiver Zach Reeves has caught 22 passes for 332 yards and three touchdowns.

Defensively, senior linebacker Zach Klarkowski leads the Green Knights with 66 tackles and also has 5.5 tackles-for-loss with two quarterback sacks. Senior linebacker Matt Petersilka has 51 tackles with 3 1/2 tackles-for-loss, while sophomore defensive back Ryan Grandlic has 43 tackles. Senior defensive lineman Austin Prusha has 39 tackles, with 11.5 tackles for loss, and five quarterback sacks. Senior defensive back Joe Lorenz has 36

tackles, and shares the team lead in passes defensed with Grandlic with six.

St. Norbert is averaging 20.0 points and 280.7 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 26.5 points and 376.5 yards per game.

#### **About the Buccaneers:**

Beloit comes into the St. Norbert game with a 2-4 overall record and an 0-2 mark in the Midwest Conference North Division. The Buccaneers have lost three straight, including a 28-21 setback this past Saturday to Macalester. Beloit owns wins this season over Grinnell (27-23 on Sept. 13) and Lake Forest (27-24 in overtime) on Sept. 27.

Sophomore running back Mason Dixon is fourth in the Midwest Conference in rushing with 637 yards on 160 carries and seven touchdowns. Dixon has 67.2 percent of Beloit's rushing attempts this season. Sophomore quarterback Evan Phillips has completed 79 of 139 passes for 789 yards with four touchdowns and six interceptions. Junior wide receiver Michael Nolden has 26 catches for 303 yards and one touchdown, while sophomore wide receiver Kam Sallee has 23 catches for 172 yards and one touchdown.

Junior defensive back Antonio Jones leads the Buccaneers defensively with 48 tackles. Sophomore defensive back Dewight Walker has 47 tackles this season, while sophomore linebacker Riley Pearson has 46 tackles and 5 1/2 quarterback sacks. Senior defensive lineman Derell Carter has 41 tackles, 12 tackles-for-loss and 6.5 quarterback sacks.

Beloit is averaging 16.8 points and 261.8 yards per game. Defensively, the Buccaneers are allowing 27.3 points and 388.2 yards per game.

#### **Crosby Comments:**

St. Norbert sophomore quarter-back J.T. Crosby enjoyed a solid performance in his first collegiate start calling the signals in this past Saturday's 13-10 win over Ripon.

Crosby finished with 286 yards of total offense, which was 74.5 percent of the Green Knights' season-high total of 384 yards. Crosby completed 10 of 26 passes for 175 yards, and also rushed 21 times for 111 yards. Six of Crosby's rushing attempts accounted for first downs.

Crosby's 111-yard rushing performance marked the 14th time since 1994 a St. Norbert quarterback has rushed for 100 yards in a game. It was the first time a St. Norbert signal caller had a 100-yard rushing game since Rob Berger rushed for 116 yards in a 58-14 win over Grinnell on Oct. 23, 2010.

Berger (2007-10) had five 100-yard rushing games, while Tim Pierret (1996-99) had four. Dan Luedtke (1994-97) and Steve Stratton (1991-94) have two apiece.

Stratton's 169 rushing yards in a 33-30 loss to Beloit on Oct. 29, 1994 is the St. Norbert record for singlegame rushing yards by a quarterback.

#### Winning Ways:

In 2014, St. Norbert is looking for its 16th consecutive season with at least seven wins. St. Norbert will have to win its four remaining games to reach the seven-win plateau this season.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 423-280-20 in 81 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .599. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 179-37, a winning percentage of .829.

St. Norbert has won 124 of its last 137 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .905.

#### **Quick Hitters:**

- \* St. Norbert is 188-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 113-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
- \*-St. Norbert senior kicker Randy Hill was named Midwest Conference Special Teams Player of the Week after scoring seven of the Green Knights' 13 points against Ripon. Hill kicked field goals of 32 and 31 yards and converted his lone extra-point try.
