Game Overview:

St. Norbert travels down Highway 41 for the second consecutive year to face Fox River Valley-rival Lawrence in a rare November night game at Banta Bowl. The Green Knights have won two consecutive games overall, while the Vikings have dropped their last two outings.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds a 25-9-2 lead over Lawrence in a series begun in 1932. The Green Knights have won the last 16 meetings with the Vikings since a 27-24 Lawrence win in 1997 at Minahan Stadium in De Pere. Lawrence claims only a 25-13-2 deficit in the series, but four games were played before St. Norbert began sponsoring full varsity intercollegiate football in 1931.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert topped Lawrence 17-6 on Oct. 19, 2013 at Banta Bowl in Appleton. The Green Knights led 7-6 at halftime before getting a third-quarter touchdown and a late field goal to get the win.

Lawrence scored first on a 1-yard touchdown run by Dalton Sendelbach early in the second quarter. James Tringali found Brian Fliess on a 41-yard

touchdown pass later in the period to put St. Norbert ahead. Zach Broberg had a 3-yard touchdown run in the third quarter, while Randy Hill's 30-yard field goal with 2:22 left ended the scoring.

St. Norbert outgained Lawrence 319-268 in total offense. Tringali completed 13 of 27 passes for 177 yards with one touchdown and one interception. Fliess caught six passes for 103 yards and one touchdown, while Broberg rushed 19 times for 86 yards.

Luke Barthelmess completed 16 of 26 passes for 190 yards and had a team-high 21 rushing yards to pace the Vikings.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Steve Opgenorth (Winona State, 2005) is 4-3 in his first season in De Pere.

Lawrence interim coach Chris Harris (Cumberlands, 2000) is 2-4 in his first season in Appleton.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the Lawrence game at 4-3 overall and 2-1 in the Midwest Conference North Division. The Green Knights won for the second consecutive game with a 29-14 win over Beloit this past Saturday at Schneider Stadium in De Pere.

Senior running back Zach Broberg holds the team rushing lead with 341 yards on 74 carries with four touchdowns. Senior quarterback James Tringali came off the bench against Beloit and passes for 153 yards while rushing for 68 more. Tringali has completed 85 of 141 passes for 845 yards with five touchdowns and three interceptions. Sophomore wide receiver Zach Reeves has caught 29 passes for 410 yards and three touchdowns.

Defensively, senior linebacker Zach Klarkowski leads the Green Knights with 72 tackles and also has 7.5 tackles-for-loss with three quarterback sacks. Senior linebacker Matt Petersilka has 57 tackles with 3 1/2 tackles-for-loss, while sophomore defensive back Ryan Grandlic has 51 tackles. Senior defensive

lineman Austin Prusha has 42 tackles, with 11.5 tackles for loss, and five quarterback sacks. Senior defensive back Joe Lorenz has 41 stops and has a team-high seven passes defended.

St. Norbert is averaging 21.3 points and 290.6 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 24.7 points and 363.4 yards per game.

About the Vikings:

Lawrence enters the St. Norbert game at 2-5 overall and 1-2 in the Midwest Conference North Division. The Vikings, who lost Saturday at Macalester 33-0, are 2-1 at home this season. Lawrence defeated Maranatha Baptist 59-0 on Sept. 13 and Beloit 21-13 on Oct. 11, and lost to Grinnell 29-7 on Oct. 4.

Junior running back Dalton Sendelbach leads the Vikings in rushing with 241 yards on 75 carries with one touchdown. Freshman quarterback Chance Byrd has completed 68 of 133 passes for 856 yards with seven touchdowns and 10 interceptions, and has also rushed for 139 yards on 72 carries with one touchdown. Senior wide receiver Taylor Mandich leads the Vikings in receiving with 31 receptions for 546 yards with five touchdowns.

Senior linebacker Brandon Taylor leads the Vikings in tackles with 68. Senior defensive back Dan Taylor has 58 tackles and five passes defended. Sophomore defensive lineman Tony Harth had 43 tackles with 11 tackles-for-loss and three quarterback sacks.

Lawrence is averaging 16.3 points and 300.4 yards per game. Defensively, the Vikings are allowing 32.9 points and 367.9 yards per game.

Field Goal Fodder:

St. Norbert kicker Randy Hill has converted all five of his field-goal attempts in the last two weeks.

Hill cashed in on field goals of 32 and 31 yards in a 13-10 win over Ripon on Oct. 18. He then converted field goals of 40, 25 and 22 yards - all into a stiff north wind that gust-ed up to 27 miles per hour - in this

past Saturday's 29-14 win over Beloit.

It marked the second time in his career Hill had three field goals in a game. Hill made field goals of 32, 22 and 24 yards in a 23-0 win over Grinnell on Nov. 9, 2013 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere.

Hill has a total of 22 field goals to place him second on the St. Norbert career leaderboard.

Chris Griffin is the St. Norbert career leader with 23 field goals made from 2000-03. Griffin also had a school-record four field goals in a 47-29 win over Knox on Sept. 28, 2002.

Plays Patter:

St. Norbert ran 85 plays from scrimmage in Saturday's 29-14 win over Beloit, the most it has had in a game in over three seasons.

The Green Knights rushed the ball 50 times and attempted 35 passes to total 350 yards of offense. St. Norbert held possession of the football for 36 minutes 21 seconds.

The last time St. Norbert ran at least 85 plays in a game was on Sept. 29, 2011, when the Green Knights ran 86 plays in a 33-0 win at Lawrence - a stretch dating back 35 games.

Winning Ways:

In 2014, St. Norbert is looking for its 16th consecutive season with at least seven wins. St. Norbert will have to win its three remaining games to reach the seven-win plateau this season.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 424-280-20 in 81 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .599. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 180-37, a winning percentage of .829.

St. Norbert has won 125 of its last 138 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .906.

* - St. Norbert is 188-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 113-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
