straight game with a 42-0 shutout win over Lawrence this past Saturday night at Banta Bowl in Appleton.

Senior running back Zach Broberg holds the team rushing lead with 353 yards on 82 carries and five touchdowns. Freshman running back Elijah Fort has 261 yards rushing on 71 carries with two touchdowns. Senior quarterback James Tringali has completed 97 of 170 passes for 1,057 yards and seven touchdowns with three interceptions. Sophomore wide receiver Zach Reeves has 32 receptions for 462 yards and three touchdowns, while freshman wide receiver Brett Olson has 28 catches for 346 vards and four touchdowns.

Senior linebacker Zach Klarkowski leads the Green Knights defensively with 77 tackles and also has 7.5 tackles-for-loss with three quarterback sacks. Senior linebacker Matt Petersilka has 62 tackles with 4 1/2 tackles-forloss, while sophomore defensive back Ryan Grandlic has 56 tackles. Senior defensive lineman Austin Prusha has 46 tackles, with 11.5 tackles for loss, and five quarterback sacks. Senior defensive back Joe Lorenz has 45 stops and has a team-high nine passes defensed.

St. Norbert is averaging 23.9 points and 307.4 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 21.6 points and 341.8 yards per game.

#### **About the Scots:**

Macalester enters the game enjoying a banner season in its first season as an affiliate member of the Midwest Conference. The Scots, 7-1 overall and 4-0 in the MWC North Division, have won six straight games. Macalester dropped Carroll, ranked No. 24 in the AFCA Division III Top 25, by a 34-17 score this past Saturday for its first-ever win over a nationally ranked opponent

The Scots feature the league's top rushing offense at 238.1 yards per game, led by junior running back Zandy Stowell. Stowell has 933 yards rushing on 178 carries with five touchdowns. Senior quarter-back Samson Bialostok has completed 88 of 181 passes for 1,283 yards with eight touchdowns and four interceptions. Bialostok also has 626 yards rushing on 89 carries with 11 touchdowns. Senior wide receiver Ben Hillman has caught 29 passes for 394 yards with two touchdowns.

Junior linebacker Ryan Fleming leads Macalester in tackles with 75, and also has four tackles-for-loss. Senior defensive back Jole Miller has 57 tackles. Senior linebacker Reid Callahan has 43 tackles with 9 1/2 tackles-for-loss and 2 1/2 quarterback sacks.

Macalester is averaging 26.0 points and 405.8 yards per game. Defensively, the Scots are allowing 13.9 points and a Midwest Conference-best 273.9 yards per game.

#### **Schneider Stuff:**

St. Norbert enters its final home game of the 2014 campaign with a 19-4 all-time record at Schneider Stadium, which opened in 2010.

Entering Saturday's game with Macalester, St. Norbert brings forward a 14-game winning streak at Schneider Stadium against Midwest Conference schools.

The Green Knights are 18-2 there in Midwest Conference games and are 19-2 overall against Midwest Conference opponents.

St. Norbert is 3-1 at home this season, with its only loss coming 51-17 to perennial national power and then No. 6-ranked North Central on Sept. 13.

# **Macalester Musings:**

Macalester is in its first season as a football-only member of the Midwest Conference. The Scots are a member of the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference in all other sports.

The Scots' seven wins this season mark just the third time they have reached that mark in 121 seasons of intercollegiate football. Macalester, which has never won eight games in a season, was 7-2-1 in 1986 and 7-2 in 1960.

Macalester last won a MIAC football championship in 1947. Its current six-game winning streak marks the first time since 1950 it has a victory skein that long in a single season.

## Tiebreaker Talk:

As it turned out, the Midwest Conference schedulemaker planned plenty of drama heading into the final week of divisional play. Both the North and South Divisions could end in three-way ties after action this Saturday.

If St. Norbert would beat Macalester and Carroll would beat Beloit, there would be a three-way tie for first. Quarters led in divisional games is the tiebreaker, with Macalester currently leading with 14 quarters led. Carroll has 12 and St. Norbert 11.

In the South Division, if Cornell would beat Illinois College and Monomouth beats Knox, a threeway tie could also exist. Illinois College has 13 quarters led, Monmouth 12 and Cornell 10.

# Winning Ways:

In 2014, St. Norbert is looking for its 16th consecutive season with at least seven wins. St. Norbert will have to win its two remaining games to reach the seven-win plateau this season.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 425-280-20 in 81 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .600. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 181-37, a winning percentage of .830.

St. Norbert has won 126 of its last 139 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .906.

## **Quick Hitters:**

- \* St. Norbert is 189-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 114-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
- \* Randy Hill's two field goals against Lawrence give him 24 for his career, which is now first in St. Norbert history. He passed Chris Griffin's old mark of 23 (2000-03).
