Game Overview:

St. Norbert makes its 12th appearance in the NCAA Division III Playoffs when it travels to southern Wisconsin to face No. 5-ranked UW-Whitewater. The winner of the game will face the Wheaton-Lakeland winner in the second round.

The Series:

Saturday's game marks the 31st meeting between St. Norbert and UW-Whitewater in a series begun in 1932. Whitewater leads the overall series 18-9-3, and is 13-4-1 all-time at home in the series. The Warhawks have won five straight games in the series since a 6-3 St. Norbert win on Sept. 11, 1976 in De Pere. The series is St. Norbert's second-most oft-renewed non-conference series, second only to 37 meetings with UW-Oshkosh.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert last faced UW-Whitewater on Nov. 23, 2013 and dropped a first-round NCAA Division III Playoffs game to the Warhawks by a 31-7 score at Perkins Stadium. The Green Knights trailed 10-0 at halftime and 17-7 through three quarters before the Warhawks pulled away with a pair of fourth-quarter touchdowns.

Brad Boockmeier rushed 19 times for 61 yards for St. Norbert. James Tringali completed 13 of 25 passes for 74 yards with one touchdown and two interceptions. Brian Fliess caught four passes for 19 yards. Whitewater's Matt Behrendt completed 24 of 38 passes for 279 yards and three touchdowns. Ryan Givens rushed 25 times for 123 yards and one touchdown, while Justin Howard caught 11 passes for 72 yards.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 10-0 in his first season in De Pere.

UW-Whitewater coach Kevin Bullis (UM-Morris, 1989) is 9-1 in his first season in Whitewater.

NCAA Playoff History:

St. Norbert is making its 12th NCAA Division III Playoffs appearance and its 11th in the last 17 years. St. Norbert is 1-11 all-time in the playoffs, beating Simpson (Iowa) 26-20 in double overtime in 2003's first round before losing at eventual national champion. The Green Knights are 0-2 all-time in the playoffs against UW-Whitewater.

UW-Whitewater is making its 13th NCAA Division III Playoffs appearance, and its 10th in the last 11 years. The Warhawks are 43-6 all-time and won national championships in 2007, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2013 and 2014.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 10-0 overall after capturing its 16th Midwest Conference championship since joining the league in 1984 with a 16-7 win over Monmouth this past Saturday at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights enter the week ranked No. 17 in the AFCA Division III Top 25 Poll.

Sophomore running back Elijah Fort leads the Green Knights in rushing with 719 yards on 132 carries with 16 touchdowns. Senior running back Brad Boockmeier has 696 yards rushing on 144 carries and five touchdowns. Sophomore quarterback Jack Becker has completed 119 of 185 passes for 1,478 yards with 10 touchdowns and four interceptions while rushing for 418 yards on 78 carries with five touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Zach Reeves has caught 34 passes for 484

yards and one touchdown. Sophomore Brett Olson has caught 20 passes for 341 yards and two touchdowns.

Senior linebacker R.J. Callow leads the Green Knights in tackles with 75, while senior linebacker Wyatt Veseth has 65 tackles. Junior defensive back Ryan Grandlic, the reigning MWC Defensive Player of the Week, has 58 tackles with five interceptions. Senior linebacker Jacob Wells has 57 stops. Senior defensive back Frank Laterza has a team-high six interceptions and seven passes defended.

St. Norbert is averaging 33.4 points and 410.3 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 9.9 points and 279.8 yards per game. St. Norbert's scoring defense is currently sixth in Division III.

About the Warhawks:

UW-Whitewater enters the NCAA Division III Playoffs with a 9-1 overall record. The Warhawks, the two-time defending national champion, finished 6-1 as the runner-up in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. Whitewater, ranked No. 5 in the D3football.com Top 25, suffered its only loss in a 10-7 setback at UW-Oshkosh on Oct. 10.

Senior running back Jordan Ratliffe leads the Warhawks in rushing with 1,100 yards on 172 carries with 17 touchdowns. Junior quarterback Chris Nelson has completed 133 of 193 passes for 1,930 yards with 16 touchdowns and two interceptions. Junior wide receiver Marcus Hudson has caught 41 passes for 729 yards and six touchdowns, while senior wide receiver Joe Worth has 36 receptions for 452 yards and four touchdowns.

Junior linebacker Paul Foster leads the Warhawks' defense with a team-high 59 tackles. Senior linebacker Justin Dischler has 57 tackles, while senior defensive back Ryan Winske has 53 tackles and four interceptions.

Whitewater is averaging 41.8 points and 451.3 yards per game. Defensively, the Warhawks are allowing 11.5 points and 280.6 yards per game.

Fort's 108 points are tied for fourth most in a season in St. Norbert history.

Casey Meehan holds the St. Norbert record with 152 points scored in 2004. Jason Augustynowicz scored 126 points in 2001, while Mike Whitehouse scored 113 points in 1988.

Defensive Dirt:

St. Norbert turned in a stellar defensive performance in Saturday's 16-7 win over Monmouth for the Midwest Conference championship. The Green Knights held the Scots to 30 points under their scoring average, with Monmouth entering the game netting 37.7 points per game.

The Green Knights finished with five takeaways in the game while not turning the ball over on offense. The plus-five performance vaulted St. Norbert to the No. 1 spot in the Division III national statistics in turnover margin at plus-2.10 per game.

St. Norbert is sixth in Division III in scoring defense allowing just 9.9 points per game. UW-Whitewater is 11th yielding 11.5 points per game.

The Green Knights are also four nationally in passes intercepted with 21.

State School Snippets:

Saturday's game against UW-Whitewater marks the 165th time in St. Norbert football history the Green Knights will battle a University of Wisconsin System school on the gridiron.

St. Norbert has played all eight current members of the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference, as well as former members UW-Milwaukee and UW-Superior. St. Norbert owns at least one win over all eight current WIAC members and is 80-76-8 all-time against the league.

St. Norbert has played UW-Oshkosh 37 times (14-20-3 all-time), the most meetings with any St. Norbert opponent. The Green Knights have also battled UW-Whitewater 30 times (9-18-3), UW-Stevens Point 26 times (13-12-1), UW-Milwaukee 23 times (19-4) and UW-La Crosse on 21 occasions (13-7-1).

St. Norbert has opened its season 14 times against a WIAC foe since 1988. The Green Knights played Stevens Point in 1988 and 1989, and then had a 10-year series with Oshkosh from 1990 to 1999 before playing Whitewater to open the 2004 and 2005 seasons.

The Green Knights have lost 18 consecutive games against the WIAC since a 25-7 win over UW-Platteville on Nov. 5, 1983 in De Pere.

St. Norbert will open the 2016 and 2017 seasons against UW-Stevens Point. The 2016 game is in De Pere.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert clinched its 17th consecutive winning season with its win over Ripon on Oct. 17. The Green Knights claimed their first 10-win season since 2007 with their win last Saturday over Monmouth. It was St. Norbert's tenth unbeaten regular season all-time and fifth since 2000.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 436-281-20 in 82 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .605. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 186-38, a winning percentage of .830.

St. Norbert has won 131 of its last 145 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .903.

Quick Hitters:

- * St. Norbert had nine first downs in Saturday's 16-7 win over Monmouth. It marked the first time since a 26-22 win over Ripon on Oct. 23, 1993 the Green Knights won a game with less than 10 first downs. St. Norbert also had nine first downs in that contest.
- * Both St. Norbert and UW-Whitewater have gotten off to fast starts in games this season. The Green Knights have outscored their opponents 85-13 in the first quarter of games this season. The Warhawks hold a commanding 143-14 scoring edge in the first quarter this season.
