Game Overview:

St. Norbert comes off its bye week to face Illinois College in the first of two games against Midwest Conference South Division opponents, neither of which will count in the league standings. The Green Knights are the remaining unbeaten team overall in the Midwest Conference. The game is also Illinois College's Homecoming.

The Series:

St. Norbert holds an 18-3 series lead over Illinois College in a series begun in 1984. The Green Knights won the first nine meetings in the series before the Blueboys won 41-40 on Nov. 10, 2001 at Jacksonville, Ill. St. Norbert had then won the next eight meetings before the Blueboys captured games in 2010 and 2011. The Green Knights and Blueboys did not play in 2012 and 2013.

Last Game:

St. Norbert pulled off a 32-27 win over Illinois College on Sept. 27, 2014 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights trailed 27-6 entering the fourth quarter, but scored 26 points while forcing four consecutive Blueboys three-and-outs to rally to the win. Zach Broberg rushed nine times for 96 yards and two touchdowns for St. Norbert, while James

Tringali completed 15 of 26 passes for 205 yards. Michael Bates paced Illinois College by completing 22 of 40 passes for 218 yards and one touchdown. Dakota Lammy rushed 25 times for 83 yards and one touchdown.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 2-0 in his first season in De Pere.

Illinois College coach Garrett Campbell (CSU-Fullerton, 1998) is 47-26 in his eighth season in Jacksonville.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the Illinois College game at 2-0 overall. The Green Knights swept their pair of non-conference games against the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin, beating North Park 41-31 on Sept. 12. St. Norbert scored two touchdowns in the last 22 seconds to rally to win.

Senior running back Brad Boockmeier leads the Green Knights in rushing with 167 yards on 35 carries and one touchdown. Sophomore Elijah Fort has 157 yards rushing on 19 carries and four touchdowns. Sophomore quarterback Jack Becker has completed 35 of 47 passes for 402 yards with three touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Zach Reeves leads the Green Knights in receptions with 10 for 93 yards.

Senior linebacker R.J. Callow leads the Green Knights in tackles with 18, and also has two tacklesfor-loss. Senior linebacker Wyatt Veseth has 16 tackles this season after a 13-tackle outing against North Park. Sophomore defensive back Tyler Jensen has 19 tackles and also returned an interception for a touchdown against North Park.

St. Norbert is averaging 38.0 points and 401.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 18.5 points and 331.0 vards per game.

About the Blueboys:

Illinois College enters its game with St. Norbert at 1-1 overall. The Blueboys opened with a 53-20 win over Aurora on Sept. 5 before dropping a 51-33 decision on Sept. 12 to Rose-Hulman, game a Engineers posted 626 yards of total offense.

Senior quarterback Brady Huber leads the Blueboys offense, completing 51 of 75 passes for 656 yards with 10 touchdowns and one interception. Sophomore wide receiver Kyle Obertino has 11 receptions for 282 yards and four touchdowns, while junior wide receiver/defensive back Austin Ellsworth has 11 catches for 141 yards and three touchdowns. Junior running back Dyllan Bailey has 105 yards rushing on 16 attempts.

Sophomore linebacker Matt Graef leads Illinois College's defense with 18 tackles. Senior linebacker Dylan Schuler has 17 tackles with 2 1/2 tackles-for-loss. Sophomore linebacker Josh Brooks has 16 tackles.

Illinois College is averaging 43.0 points and 437.5 yards per game. Defensively, the Blueboys are allowing 35.5 points and 456.6 yards per game.

First Down Fun:

St. Norbert kept moving the chains in a 41-31 win over North Park on Sept. 12. The Green Knights held the ball for 36 minutes 35 seconds while churning out a total of 28 first downs. St. Norbert had 16 first downs rushing, nine passing and three via penalty.

The 28 first downs marked the first time St. Norbert registered that many first downs against a non-Midwest Conference Division III opponent.

The St. Norbert record for most first downs against a non-MWC opponent is 30, set on Oct. 31, 1970 in a 28-21 win against UW-Milwaukee. The Green Knights also had 29 first downs on Sept. 13, 1986 in a 34-30 loss to Michigan Tech. St. Norbert had 28 first downs in a 42-0 win over St. Cloud State on Nov. 9, 1968.

The overall St. Norbert record for first downs in a game is 35, set on Oct. 2, 1993 in a 42-21 win over Grinnell.

Solid Start:

St. Norbert head coach Dan McCarty, the 11th field boss in Green Knights gridiron history, is the first coach to start 2-0 in his debut season in 69 years.

McCarty has piloted the Green Knights to a 2-0 start behind wins of 35-6 over Carthage on Sept. 5 and 41-31 over North Park on Sept. 12.

McCarty is the first to do it since the third coach in program history -Tom Hearden - turned the trick to open his collegiate coaching career in 1946. The Green Knights defeated UW-Stevens Point 54-0 and UW-Whitewater 19-12 to open the 1946 campaign, en route to an 8-0 season.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is looking for its 17th consecutive winning season in 2015.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 428-281-20 in 82 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .601. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 181-38, a winning percentage of .826.

St. Norbert has won 126 of its last 140 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .900.

Quick Hitters:

- * St. Norbert sophomore defensive back Tyler Jensen returned an interception 50 yards for a touchdown on the final play of St. Norbert's 41-31 win over North Park. It marked the second consecutive week with a "pick six" for the Green Knights. Frank Laterza had an 84-yard interception return for a touchdown in a 35-6 win over Carthage on Sept. 5.
- * St. Norbert's 41 points against North Park marked just the third time in the last 21 games the Green Knights have reached the 40-point plateau. St. Norbert defeated Lawrence 42-0 on Nov. 1, 2014 and Beloit 52-17 on Nov. 2, 2013.
- * St. Norbert is 192-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 115-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
