Game Overview:

St. Norbert returns to Schneider Stadium for the first time in nearly a month when it hosts Cornell. The Green Knights, the lone unbeaten team overall in the Midwest Conference, are playing the second of two non-conference crossover games this season against a South Division opponent.

The Series:

St. Norbert and Cornell have met eight times, with St. Norbert holding a 5-3 lead in a series begun in 1986. The Green Knights are 3-0 all-time at home in the series, including a 20-17 over the Rams on Oct. 12, 2013 in the last meeting at Schneider Stadium.

Last Game:

St. Norbert scored 28 fourth-quarter points to rally to a 35-28 win over Cornell on Nov. 15, 2014 at Ash Park in Mount Vernon, Iowa. The game, which Cornell led 28-7 just four seconds into the fourth quarter, was the Midwest Conference's fifth-place game and the second of two meetings between the two squads last season. Zach Broberg had two touchdowns in the rally and James Tringali's 3-yard touchdown run with 38 seconds left

snapped a 28-28 tie. Tringali completed 22 of 30 passes for 250 yards and two touchdowns, while Broberg rushed 18 times for 117 yards and two touchdowns. Brett Olson also had 105 yards receiving on four catches. Daniel Brown completed 19 of 29 passes for 225 yards and three touchdowns to lead Cornell. Ben Knake caught six passes for 137 yards for the Rams.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 3-0 in his first season in De Pere.

Cornell coach Vince Brautigam (Iowa Wesleyan, 1988) is 20-32 in his sixth season in Mount Vernon. Including eight seasons at Dubuque and 11 seasons at Mount Senario, Brautigam is 109-138 in 25 years as a collegiate head coach.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 3-0 overall after an impressive 21-2 road win over Illinois College this past Saturday. The Green Knights broke open a close game with two fourth-quarter touchdowns.

Sophomore quarterback Jack Becker has completed 49 of 66 passes (74.2 percent) for 532 yards with three touchdowns. Senior running back Brad Boockmeier has a teamhigh 263 rushing yards on 57 attempts and two touchdowns. Sophomore running back Elijah Fort has 175 yards rushing on 27 attempts with five touchdowns. Junior wide receiver Zach Reeves leads the Green Knights in receptions with 14 for 120 yards, while Boockmeier has 10 receptions for 89 yards and two touchdowns.

Senior linebacker Wyatt Veseth leads the Green Knights in tackles with 25. Senior linebacker R.J. Callow has 22 tackles with two tackles-for-loss, one quarterback sack and one interception. Junior defensive back Ryan Grandlic has 19 tackles with two interceptions, while sophomore defensive back Tyler Jensen has 17 tackles.

St. Norbert is averaging 32.3 points and 364.3 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are

allowing 13.0 points and 317.0 yards per game.

About the Rams:

Cornell enters the game 1-2 overall. The Rams are coming off a 26-21 home loss to Ripon this past Saturday. Cornell picked up its only win in its season opener on Sept. 5 with a 33-9 triumph over Iowa Wesleyan.

Sophomore quarterback Daniel Brown leads the Rams' offense. Brown has completed 48 of 92 passes for 517 yards with five touchdowns and four interceptions. Brown is also Cornell's leading rusher with 236 yards on 45 attempts. Senior wide receiver Ben Knake leads the Rams in receptions with 21 for 173 yards and one touchdown. Sophomore running back Devan Clark has 182 yards rushing on 36 attempts.

Junior defensive back Maliek Ketchens leads Cornell in tackles with 29. Junior defensive lineman Andrew Joseph has 24 tackles with 4.5 tackles-for-loss and 2.5 quarter-back sacks. Junior linebacker Austin McDonald has 17 tackles with 3.5 tackles-for-loss with two quarter-back sacks.

Cornell is averaging 19.0 points and 338.7 yards per game. Defensively, the Rams are allowing 28.3 points and 439.7 yards per game.

Safety Dance:

St. Norbert's 21-2 win over Illinois College this past Saturday was a rarity in the fact the losing team had scored only a safety. It marked the first time since 2009 Illinois College had not scored any offensive points. The Blueboys had entered the game averaging 43 points per game.

The Green Knights' win allowing just two points marked only the third time in school history St. Norbert won a game yielding only a safety.

St. Norbert beat Monmouth 48-2 on Oct. 2, 2010 in Monmouth, Ill., for its most recent win where the opponent had just two points. The first occurrence came in the first game in school history, when St.

Punt Patter:

St. Norbert sophomore punter Marcus Maguire helped keep the Green Knights winning the field position battle in last Saturday's 21-2 win over Illinois College.

Maguire, who was named MWC Special Teams Player of the Week this past Monday, punted four times for an average of 47.5 yards, with three punts pinning Illinois College inside its 20-yard line. It tied for the third-best game for gross punting average in school history.

Kevin Krueger's 51.0-yard average against Carroll last season and Adam Gruett's 50.8-yard average against Grinnell in 2010 are the two best marks in St. Norbert history. Maguire tied Bob Forstrom's game average against Grinnell in 2004.

Papam Pablum:

With its win over Illinois College, St. Norbert improved to 2-3 all-time when the Pope was in the United States. Pope Francis was in Philadelphia last Saturday.

The first four games all came during papal visits by St. John Paul II. The Green Knights beat Lake Forest 21-17 on Oct. 7, 1995. St. Norbert lost at Valparaiso 23-7 on Oct. 6, 1979, and then lost 31-17 at Michigan Tech and 31-8 at Dayton on Sept. 12 and 19, 1987, respectively.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is looking for its 17th consecutive winning season in 2015.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 429-281-20 in 82 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .601. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 181-38, a winning percentage of .826.

St. Norbert has won 126 of its last 140 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .900.
