Game Overview:

St. Norbert jumps into the Midwest Conference North Division fray hosting a key matchup against Carroll. The Pioneers were the favorite to win the North Division in the league's pre-season coaches poll, while the Green Knights were tabbed for second.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Carroll 27-9 in the all-time series, which began in 1935. The 27 wins are tied for the most for the Green Knights against an opponent, matching the 27 all-time wins against Lake Forest College. The Green Knights are 18-4 in the series since Carroll joined the Midwest Conference in 1992. St. Norbert had won 17 straight games in the series prior to Carroll winning last year's meeting. The Green Knights are 15-2 all-time at home in the series. This will be the final conference game between the two schools with Carroll leaving for the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin in 2016.

umph at Schneider Stadium in Waukesha. The Pioneers outgained the Green Knights 452-185 in total offense. Carroll's Kevin Jennings caught nine passes for 179 yards and two touchdowns, while Kyle Burlingame completed 20 of 29 passes for 286 yards and two touchdowns. The Pioneers, who led 17-0 at halftime, had possession for 38 minutes 7 seconds. Zach Broberg led St. Norbert with 59 yards rushing on nine attempts.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 4-0 in his first season in De Pere.

Carroll coach Mark Krzykowski (Carroll, 1994) is 31-13 in his fifth season in Waukesha.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 4-0 overall after a 31-3 win over Cornell this past Saturday at Schneider Stadium. The Green Knights have not allowed a touchdown in their last two games, including a 21-2 win over Illinois College on Sept. 26.

Sophomore running back Elijah Fort was named MWC Offensive Player of the Week after scoring four touchdowns against Cornell. Fort leads the team in rushing with 270 yards on 49 carries, and his eight rushing touchdowns are tied for ninth in Division III. Senior running back Brad Boockmeier has 269 yards rushing on 59 carries with two touchdowns. Sophomore quarterback Jack Becker has completed 60 of 88 passes for 681 yards and four touchdowns with two interceptions. Junior wide receiver Zach Reeves leads the Green Knights in receptions with 19 for 217 yards.

Senior linebacker R.J. Callow leads the Green Knights in tackles with 28. Junior defensive back Alec Swanson, the reigning MWC Defensive Player of the Week, has 26 tackles. Senior linebacker Wyatt Veseth has 25 tackles, while senior defensive back Jacob Wells has 22 stops. Sophomore linebacker Tommy Gonzales has a team-high five tackles-for-loss and three quar-

terback sacks.

St. Norbert is averaging 32.0 points and 376.5 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 10.5 points and 303.8 yards per game. St. Norbert's scoring defense is currently 14th in Division III.

About the Pioneers:

Carroll enters the game at 2-2 overall. The Pioneers defeated Lake Forest 35-13 at home this past Saturday. Carroll lost its season opener to Lakeland 34-33 in overtime on Sept. 5 and also lost to Monmouth 22-16 on Sept. 26. The Pioneers own a 21-13 win over Benedictine on Sept. 12.

Junior quarterback Kyle Burlingame has completed 83 of 133 passes for 851 yards with eight touchdowns and five interceptions. Senior wide receiver Kevin Jennings has hauled in 43 aerials for 447 yards and four touchdowns. Senior tailback Daniel Arden has a team-high 371 yards rushing on 66 attempts and four touchdowns.

Senior defensive back Ty Zimmerman leads the Pioneers in tackles with 32. Junior linebacker Tyler Aerts has 23 tackles with 4.5 tackles-for-loss. Senior defensive lineman Gianni Bandera has 18 tackles and 3.5 tackles-for-loss.

Carroll is averaging 26.2 points and 356.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Pioneers are allowing 20.5 points and 329.2 yards per game.

Pick Patter:

St. Norbert pilfered four Cornell passes this past Saturday, the second time in four games this season the Green Knights have intercepted four passes in a game.

The Green Knights have intercepted 12 passes so far this season after posting just four interceptions in 10 games the entire 2014 season.

St. Norbert's interception total of 12 is currently fourth in Division III. Stevenson, Austin and Thomas More are tied for first with 13.

Senior defensive back Frank Laterza is currently fourth in Division III with an average of 1.0

interceptions per game. He is also tied for second nationally in passes defended at 3.0 per game.

Go For It:

St. Norbert is a remarkable 11-for-11 on fourth-down conversions this season. The Green Knights are one of four teams in Division III to be batting 1.000 on fourth-down conversions this season.

Concordia-Moorhead (12-for-12), Gustavus Adolphus (3-for-3) and Hamilton (2-for-2) are the other three.

Two fourth-down opportunities turned into touchdowns in this past Saturday's 31-3 win over Cornell - a 29-yard pass from Jack Becker to Elijah Fort and a 28-yard run by Fort.

Turnover Talk:

St. Norbert enters the week second in Division III in turnover margin at plus-2.75 per game. Only Stevenson is higher at plus-3.00 per game.

The Green Knights have made 12 interceptions this season and recovered two opponents' fumbles. St. Norbert has thrown two interceptions and lost one fumble to rank 12th nationally in turnovers lost.

Defense Discussion:

St. Norbert has not allowed a touchdown in its last two games - a 21-2 win at Illinois College and a 31-3 home win over Cornell.

The two victories marked the first time in St. Norbert history the Green Knights have won consecutive games while allowing the other team to score, but without allowing a touchdown.

Quick Hitters:

- * Sophomore running back Elijah Fort is ninth nationally in scoring at 13.5 points per game.
- * St. Norbert is 193-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 115-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
- * St. Norbert has won 126 of its last 140 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .900.
