#### **Game Overview:**

It's Ripon Week for St. Norbert as the Green Knights travel to Ripon in another key Midwest Conference North Division matchup. The Green Knights and Red Hawks are meeting for the 35th consecutive season, the longest continuous series in St. Norbert football history.

#### The Series:

St. Norbert owns a 25-10 lead over Ripon in a hotly contested series that dates back to 1979. St. Norbert has won 15 of the last 16 meetings in the series, the Green Knights' lone blemish a 19-7 Ripon win at Ingalls Field in 2008. The Green Knights are 11-6 all-time at Ingalls Field and hold an all-time 1,033-670 scoring edge in the rivalry.

#### **Last Meeting:**

St. Norbert held on to defeat Ripon 13-10 on Oct. 18, 2014 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights led 13-0 before holding off a late Red Hawks' surge. St. Norbert forced a Ripon fumble inside the red zone with just over 4 minutes remaining to seal the win. The Green Knights outgained the Red Hawks 384-294 in total offense. J.T. Crosby completed 10 of 26 passes for 175 yards and also rushed 21 times for 111 yards, while Zach Broberg added 98 yards on 26 carries. Connor Greenwald led Ripon on the

ground with 42 yards on 11 carries, while Stephen Covalt completed 4 of 15 passes for 83 yards.

#### The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 5-0 in his first season in De Pere.

Ripon coach Ron Ernst (Nebraska Wesleyan, 1980) is 157-83 in his 25th season in Ripon. He is 6-18 all-time against St. Norbert.

#### **About the Green Knights:**

St. Norbert enters the game 5-0 overall and 1-0 in the Midwest Conference North Division after a 21-14 win over Carroll this past Saturday at Schneider Stadium. The Green Knights' 5-0 start is their first since 2009.

Sophomore running back Elijah Fort leads the Green Knights in rushing with 331 yards on 64 carries with eight touchdowns. Senior running back Brad Boockmeier has 312 vards rushing, while senior Brandon Carter has added 170 yards rushing on 34 carries. Sophomore quarterback Jack Becker has completed 70 of 107 passes for 827 vards with five touchdowns and two interceptions. Junior wide receiver Zach Reeves has caught 23 passes for 249 yards and one touchdown, while sophomore wide receiver Brett Olson has 13 receptions for 254 yards and one touchdown.

Senior linebacker R.J. Callow leads the Green Knights in tackles with 37. Junior defensive back Alec Swanson is second on the squad in tackles with 28. Junior defensive back Ryan Grandlic and senior linebackers Wyatt Veseth and Jacob Wells all have 27 tackles apiece.

St. Norbert is averaging 29.8 points and 371.0 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 11.2 points and 309.4 yards per game. St. Norbert's scoring defense is currently 14th in Division III.

#### **About the Red Hawks:**

Ripon enters the game 4-1 overall and is also 1-0 in the Midwest Conference North Division. The Red Hawks blanked defending MWC champion Macalester 23-0 this past Saturday in St. Paul, Minn. Ripon is 2-0 this season against teams who played in the NCAA Division III Playoffs last season, also beating St. Scholastica 17-16 on Sept. 5. The Red Hawks have also beating Cornell 26-21 on Sept. 26 and Illinois College 37-36 in overtime on Oct. 3.

Senior running back Connor Greenwald leads the Red Hawks' option attack with 366 yards rushing on 82 carries with three touchdowns. Senior quarterback Stephen Covalt has completed 32 of 75 passes for 402 yards with two touchdowns and one interception and has also rushed 84 times for 160 yards and four touchdowns. Senior wide receiver Nathan Silloway has 15 receptions for 232 yards.

Senior linebacker Brandon Latzig leads the Red Hawks with 42 tackles, while senior linebacker Austin Schleisner has 38 tackles. Sophomore defensive back Cody Mitchell has 34 tackles with a teamhigh seven tackles-for-loss. Senior defensive back Bradley Knoblock has six interceptions to lead the Midwest Conference.

Ripon is averaging 23.2 points and 273.8 yards per game. Defensively, the Red Hawks are allowing 17.4 points and 344.0 yards per game.

#### De Pere Five-O:

St. Norbert's 5-0 start to this season is its best since opening the 2009 season with a 5-0 mark en route to a 9-1 finish.

The Green Knights have not started 6-0 since going 10-0 during the 2007 regular season.

St. Norbert does have an interesting tie-in with the Green Bay Packers, who have been a training camp tenant on the De Pere campus since 1958. This season marks the first time since 1965 that both St. Norbert and the Packers have opened 5-0 in the same season.

The Green Knights, an NAIA member who offered scholarships at the time, began the 1965 season with a win over UW-La Crosse. St.

Norbert then followed with wins over St. Thomas, Hillsdale, Ferris State and Western Illinois en route to a 6-3 season.

The Packers, of course, went on to win the 1965 NFL championship - the last title before the Super Bowl era began.

St. Norbert and the Packers also opened the 1962 season 5-0, the only other time since World War II besides 1965 and 2015 that has happened.

#### Go For It:

St. Norbert continues to lead the NCAA Division III in fourth-down conversions, improving to 12-for-12 on the season following the Carroll game.

The Green Knights converted their lone fourth-down chance this past Saturday against Carroll on a 2-yard run by Elijah Fort to convert and fourth-and-1 in the second quarter. Four plays late St. Norbert scored the game's first points.

Gustavus Adolphus is the only other Division III team in the country to be perfect on fourth-down conversions this season at 7-for-7.

#### Winning Ways:

St. Norbert is looking for its 17th consecutive winning season in 2015. The Green Knights, at 5-0, are just one win shy of matching last season's win total after a 6-4 season.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 431-281-20 in 82 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .603. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 182-38, a winning percentage of .827.

St. Norbert has won 127 of its last 141 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .901.

#### **Quick Hitters:**

- \* St. Norbert is 193-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 115-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
- \* St. Norbert is currently sixth in Division III in total interceptions with 12. The Green Knights are also seventh nationally in turnover margin at plus-2.00 per game.
