Game Overview:

St. Norbert looks to maintain its hold on first place in the Midwest Conference North Division when it travels to the state-line area to face Beloit. The Green Knights are the only unbeaten team in North Division action and in the Midwest Conference overall.

The Series:

St. Norbert leads Beloit in an all-time series 21-10 dating back to 1984, and has won 15 of the last 16 meetings. The Green Knights had won 11 straight games in the series before Beloit claimed a 34-31 win in Beloit in 2010.

Last Meeting:

St. Norbert defeated Beloit 29-14 on Oct. 25, 2014 at Schneider Stadium in De Pere. The Green Knights led 7-0 at halftime before pulling away with two third-quarter touchdowns. St. Norbert held a 350-285 advantage in total offense. James Tringali completed 16 of 23 passes for 153 yards and also had 68 yards rushing on nine carries and one touchdown. Randy Hill added three field goals of 40, 25 and 22 yards. Beloit was led by standout running back Mason Dixon, who had 135 yards rushing on 20 carries with one touchdown.

The Coaches:

St. Norbert coach Dan McCarty (UM-Duluth, 2000) is 6-0 in his first season in De Pere.

Beloit coach Seth Duerr (Wooster, 2000) is 5-11 in his second season in Beloit.

About the Green Knights:

St. Norbert enters the game 6-0 overall and 2-0 in the Midwest Conference North Division after a 48-14 win over Ripon this past Saturday at Ingalls Field in Ripon. The 6-0 start is the Green Knights' first since going 10-0 during the 2007 regular season.

Senior running back Brad Boockmeier retook the team rushing lead after a 114-yard rushing performance against Boockmeier has 426 yards on 87 carries with four touchdowns. Sophomore running back Elijah Fort has 398 yards rushing with 74 attempts and eight touchdowns. Sophomore quarterback Becker has completed 87 of 131 passes for 1,032 yards with eight touchdowns and two interceptions. Junior wide receiver Zach Reeves has 25 receptions for 261 yards and one touchdown, while sophomore wide receiver Brett Olson has 16 receptions for 288 yards and two touchdowns.

Senior linebacker R.J. Callow leads the Green Knights in tackles with 43. Senior linebacker Jacob Wells has 35 tackles, while junior defensive back Ryan Grandlic has 34 tackles and three interceptions. Senior defensive back Frank Laterza leads the secondary with five interceptions and seven passes defended.

St. Norbert is averaging 32.8 points and 391.8 yards per game. Defensively, the Green Knights are allowing 11.7 points and 293.5 yards per game. St. Norbert's scoring defense is currently 15th in Division III.

About the Buccaneers:

Beloit enters the game 2-4 overall and 1-1 in the Midwest Conference North Division. The Buccaneers, who have lost their last three games, dropped a 28-14 decision to Macalester on Saturday in St. Paul, Minn

Junior running back Mason Dixon leads Beloit with 888 yards rushing on 149 carries and nine touchdowns. Dixon's average of 148.0 rushing yards per game is currently eighth in Division III. Junior quarterback Danny May has completed 119 of 185 passes for 1,558 yards with 15 touchdowns and 12 interceptions. Junior wide receiver Kam Sallee has caught 39 passes for 462 yards and three touchdowns, while junior wide receiver Mike Nolden has 38 receptions for 597 yards and nine touchdowns.

Freshman linebacker Brenden Endrina has a team-high 49 tackles. Junior linebacker Riley Pearson has 44 tackles with 2 1/2 quarterback sacks. Junior defensive back Dewight Walker, senior defensive back Antonio Jones and freshman defensive lineman Quin Dixon all have 41 tackles apiece.

Beloit is averaging 34.8 points and 453.5 yards per game. Defensively, the Buccaneers are allowing 37.8 points and 422.5 yards per game.

Turnover Talk:

St. Norbert finished a lusty plus-5 in turnover margin in Saturday's 48-14 win over Ripon. The Green Knights scored 17 points off turnovers.

The Green Knights are second in the NCAA Division III in turnover margin at plus-2.50 per game. Only Stevenson's plus-2.67 is higher. St. Norbert is also fifth nationally in turnovers lost with four and is tenth in the country in turnovers gained with 19.

St. Norbert has lost two fumbles and thrown two interceptions this season.

Interception Info:

St. Norbert intercepted four Ripon passes this past Saturday to increase their season total to 16 after having just four all of 2014.

The Green Knights are third in Division III in interceptions. Thomas More is the national leader

Senior defensive back Frank Laterza is fourth nationally in interceptions with 1.0 per game and is fifth in passes defended at 2.4 per game.

Go For It:

St. Norbert continues to lead the NCAA Division III in fourth-down conversions, improving to 13-for-13 on the season following the Ripon game.

The Green Knights converted their lone fourth-down chance this past Saturday against Ripon. St. Norbert faced a fourth-and-goal from the Ripon 13-yard line in the first quarter. Matt Harrity's touch-down pass to Matt Freeman on a fake field goal was good to keep the Green Knights' perfect on fourth-down conversions this season.

Concordia-Moorhead is second at 93.8 percent, going 15-for-16 so far this season.

Winning Ways:

St. Norbert clinched its 17th consecutive winning season with its win over Ripon on Saturday. The Green Knights also matched last year's win total after a 6-4 showing a year ago.

The Green Knights have an all-time record of 432-281-20 in 82 years of intercollegiate football, a winning percentage of .603. In Midwest Conference play, St. Norbert has an all-time league-best record of 183-38, a winning percentage of .828.

St. Norbert has won 128 of its last 142 Midwest Conference games, a winning percentage of .901.

Quick Hitters:

- * St. Norbert is 194-12 all-time when scoring 30-or-more points and is 116-2 all-time when scoring 40-or-more points.
- * St. Norbert's 6-0 start, coupled with the 6-0 start of the Green Bay Packers, marks the first time the two teams have started 6-0 in the same season. St. Norbert, coached by Dan McCarty, has been the training camp home of the Packers, coached by Mike McCarthy, since 1958.
